PENALTIES

Authority: Provincial Offences Act, C. P.33
Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, C. M.45,
§ 320

5.1.0.0.0

Every person who contravenes the provisions of any Section of Parts 1, 2 or 4 of the Municipal Code as herein established and passed by the City, pursuant to the authority contained in the Municipal Act or any other General or Special Act, is guilty of an offence and liable upon conviction to a penalty not exceeding \$5,000.00, exclusive of costs and the provisions of the Provincial Offences Act, R.S.O. 1990, C. P.33, as amended, shall apply to the said fine.

5.1.1.0.0

Every person who contravenes any part of Section 2.3.0.0.0 of this Code, and every Director or Officer of a Corporation who concurs in such contravention by the Corporation, is guilty of an offence and upon conviction is liable to a fine not exceeding \$25,000.00 or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding one year or to both.

5.1.1.1.0

Where a Corporation is convicted of an offence under Section 5.1.1.0.0, the maximum penalty that may be imposed is \$50,000.00.

5.2.0.0.0

Every person who contravenes the provisions of Part 3 of the Municipal Code as herein established and passed by the City, is guilty of an offence punishable under the provisions of the Criminal Code of Canada, S 206 and S 207, as may be applicable.
