**BY-LAW NUMBER 2002-130**

**A By-law of The Corporation of the City of Barrie to amend Municipal Code By-law 88- 260, by adding Section 4.16.0.0.0 being a By-law to restrict lawn watering. 4.16.0.0.0 JMS**

**WHEREAS** the Public Utilities Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.P.52 authorizes the Council of a municipality the power to regulate supply and to prohibit wrongful use of water;

**AND WHEREAS** the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie adopted Municipal Code By-law 88-260 on September 27<sup>th</sup>, 1988;

**AND WHEREAS** pursuant to Resolution Numbers 02-G-242 and 02-A-194, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie deems it expedient to amend Municipal Code By-law 88-260, by adding Section 4.15.0.0.) to restrict and regulate the use of water for the purpose of lawn watering;

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie enacts as follows:

1. **THAT** By-law 88-260 be amended by adding Section **4.16.0.0.0 JMS** as follows:

**LAWN WATERING RESTRICTIONS**  
Authority: Public Utilities Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. F52

4.16.1.0.0 ~~4.15.1.0.0~~ JMS

**DEFINITIONS:**

4.16.1.1.0 ~~4.15.1.1.0~~ JMS

**CONSUMER:** shall mean the person who is using water to water lawns

4.16.1.2.0 ~~4.15.1.2.0~~ JMS

**WATER LAWNS:** shall mean the watering of any sod or grass by any means, be it mechanical or manual.

4.16.1.3.0 ~~4.15.1.3.0~~ JMS

**OWNER:** shall mean the registered owner of specific lands or property, or his authorized agent in lawful control of the lands or property.

4.16.1.4.0 ~~4.15.1.4.0~~ JMS

**PREMISE:** shall mean a specific property, private or public under registered ownership, and includes all buildings and structures.

4.16.2.0.0 ~~4.15.2.0.0~~ JMS

**LAWN WATERING LIMITATIONS:**

4.16.2.1.0 ~~4.15.2.1.0~~ JMS

No person being a consumer or owner of a premise, with an even numbered municipal street address, within the City of Barrie, shall water lawns on odd numbered calendar days.

4.16.2.2.0 ~~4.15.2.2.0~~ JMS

No person being a consumer or owner of a premise, with an odd numbered municipal street address, within the City of Barrie, shall water lawns on even numbered calendar days.

4.16.2.3.0 ~~4.15.2.3.0~~ JMS

Notwithstanding Sections 4.15.2.1.0 and 4.15.2.2.0 no person being a consumer or owner of a premise within the City of Barrie, shall water lawns between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. of any day.

4.16.3.0.0 ~~4.15.3.0.0~~ JMS

**EXEMPTIONS:**

4.16.3.1.0 ~~4.15.3.1.0~~ JMS

Any person may water their lawn from a water source other than the municipal water supply system at anytime.

4.16.3.2.0 ~~4.15.3.2.0~~ JMS

Any person may water newly laid sod may at any time for a period not to exceed fourteen (14) days from the date the sod was installed."


2. **THAT** this by-law come into force immediately on the day of passing.

READ a first and second time this 27th day of May, 2002.


READ a third time and finally passed this 27th day of May, 2002.
