

Provide distance from property lines to all structures, septic systems, and wells located on the property.

## **Inspections**

Article 1.3.5.3. of Division C of the Ontario Building Code requires a site inspection within 2 business days (5 days for septic related inspections) of receipt of notification.

Notification is required for all mandatory stages of construction or demolition as prescribed in the Ontario Building Code. Please call (705) 739-4231 (24/7, recording line only) or email ServiceBarrie@barrie.ca to request an inspection once the stage of construction is completed and ready to be inspected. All work must remain exposed until inspected and approved. Plans must be available on site for the inspectors. The permit holder must ensure safe access is provided for the inspector (stairs and ramps with handrails, no ladders).

Site cleaning / clear of debris / backfill excavations Capping of water service and sanitary service (if on municipal servicing) Septic pump-out and filling-in of septic (if applicable) Commitment of General Review Report from a Professional Engineer (when required)
