**Accessibility Advisory Committee** – This is a statutory committee, under *the Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act (AODA), 2005*. The Committee provides advice to Council about the requirements and implementation of accessibility standards and the preparation of accessibility reports and such other matters for which the council may seek its advice, reviews site plans and drawings described in section 41 of the Planning Act that the committee selects; and performs all other functions that are specified in the regulations. The term of office for this Committee ends November 14, 2022.

As defined in the AODA, Section 2 (a) "disability" means:

- a) any degree of physical disability, infirmity, malformation or disfigurement that is caused by bodily injury, birth defect or illness and, without limiting the generality of the foregoing, includes diabetes mellitus, epilepsy, a brain injury, and degree of paralysis, amputation, lack of physical co-ordination, blindness or visual impairment, deafness or hearing impediment, muteness or speech impediment, or physical reliance on a guide dog or other animal or on a wheelchair or other remedial appliance or device;
- b) a condition of mental impairment or a development disability;
- c) a learning disability, or a dysfunction in one or more of the processes involved in understanding or using symbols or spoken language;
- d) a mental disorder, or
- e) an injury or disability for which benefits were claimed or received under the insurance plan established under the *Workplace Safety and Insurance Act, 1997*; ("handicap").
