

**FOSTER DRIVE AREA  
SANITARY SERVICING AND STORMWATER MANAGEMENT  
MUNICIPAL CLASS ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT  
(PHASES 1 & 2)****NOTICE OF COMPLETION**

The Corporation of the City of Barrie has completed a Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (Class EA) to determine the Preferred Alternative Solution to provide sanitary servicing and stormwater management improvements in the Foster Drive area (includes Foster Drive, Merrett Drive, Yeates Avenue, Garson Street and MacLaren Avenue between Foster Drive and Little Avenue).

The Preferred Alternative Solution was derived from the evaluation of alternatives and criteria established in the Class EA document. The various alternatives have been evaluated, based on the physical, social, cultural and economic environments. The details of the Preferred Alternative Solution are contained in the Draft Final Class EA Report and are briefly described as follows:

**Sanitary Servicing**

Alternative 2 – Deep Sewer Alignment. This solution consists of sewers installed at a depth sufficient to provide basement sanitary servicing via gravity to the majority of homes within the study area. Property will be acquired from 223 Foster Drive to provide connectivity for the sanitary sewer between the west terminus of Merrett Drive and Foster Drive.

**Stormwater Management Improvements**

Alternative 3 – Low Impact Development. This solution consists of utilizing natural processes to infiltrate and clean stormwater within the road right-of-way.

The Class EA has been completed as a Schedule B Municipal Class Environmental Assessment, in compliance with the Municipal Engineers Association document, Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (dated October 2000 and as amended in 2007 and 2011). Previous public comments have been received and have been incorporated into the Preferred Alternative Solution. The City of Barrie intends to proceed with the implementation of this project subject to available funding.

If concerns are raised, which cannot be resolved in discussion with the Corporation of the City of Barrie, the Minister of the Environment and Climate Change may be requested, subsequent to the filing of a Notice of Completion by the City of Barrie, to make an order for the project to comply with Part II of the Environmental Assessment Act (referred to as a Part II Order), which addresses Individual Environmental Assessments. Requests for a Part II Order must be received by the Minister at the address below within thirty (30) calendar days of this Notice. A copy of the request should also be sent to the City of Barrie's Engineering Department. If there are no requests received by **May 2, 2016**, the Engineering Department intends to proceed with the design phase of this project to implement the Preferred Alternative Solution.
