



HERITAGE AWARDS 2021 Nomination Package

The Heritage Barrie Committee is seeking nominations for *2021 Annual Barrie Heritage Awards!* The Barrie Heritage Awards recognize property owners, businesses and individuals that have made strides in fostering local identity through heritage preservation and awareness within the City of Barrie.

All Barrie residents and businesses are invited to nominate a property or person from any of the following categories:

- **Residential Buildings**
- **Commercial Buildings** (such as an office, restaurant or store)
- **Institutional Buildings** (such as a church, school, or public facility)
- **Individual or Group** (those who stand out in terms of their heritage contribution to the community)

Nominations for buildings with at least two of the following attributes will be considered:

- Are at least one hundred years old
- The property and buildings are well maintained
- Are sensitive to the heritage features of the property, especially if the property has been restored, rehabilitated or adaptively re-used
- Enhances the streetscape
- Assists in revitalizing the community through heritage conservation

Nominations for an Individual or Group with the following attributes will be considered:

- Demonstrate a commitment to heritage preservation
- Built awareness and understanding of local history and heritage
- Help revitalize the community through building local heritage awareness

Award Selection Process

Heritage Award Winner selection will take place at the regular Heritage Barrie Committee meeting by the Heritage Barrie committee members. Decisions made of the Committee are final. The Committee reserves the right to not give awards in any or all of the categories.

Steps to Announcing the 2021 Heritage Awards

1. Barrie citizens, property owners and ratepayers send in Nominations for Awards by November 26.
2. Heritage Barrie will review the Nominations for Heritage Barrie 2021 Awards at its regular meeting in November 2021 and will use the criteria in the table below to assist in the decision making.
3. Heritage Barrie will approach the selected award winners and confirm acceptance.
4. A photographer will contact the award winner to obtain a photograph of the property.
5. Awards will be presented at a Barrie City Council meeting in early 2022 (which will include a framed professional photograph of the building, or individual /group.)
6. Photos of the Heritage Barrie 2021 awards winning properties, individual or group will be posted at barrie.ca/heritage.

Award Evaluation Criteria

Residential Two Properties	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Designated or listed • Included in walking tours • Landscaped with well-maintained property and buildings on the property • Adds to the street value in neighborhood • Retains original features of homes (inside and out) • Architectural style is notable/of value/rare
Commercial /Private or Business <i>e.g. shops, restaurants, offices, banks, or combination of these</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Owners stabilized the condition of the heritage fabric with minimal intervention • sensitive and adaptive re-use of the structure to provide long-term protection • encourages economic stimulation in an area or neighborhood because of restoration, reuse or preservation actions
Institutional <i>e.g. schools, churches, museums, art gallery, other than City projects</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use of surrounding public space is preserved/adapted for new usage opportunities • Owners stabilized the condition of the heritage fabric with minimal intervention • sensitive and adaptive re-use of the structure to provide long-term protection • Serves as a culturally significant landmark to the public • Multi use building, encourages community use • Adds to the cultural landscape of an area
An Individual or Group	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Inspired leadership, initiative and commitment has resulted in increased awareness of the importance of community heritage in Barrie. • Shown vision and a tangible commitment to preserving heritage, demonstrating leadership, furthering heritage values and fostering a sense of place and pride in the greater community or a specific neighborhood of Barrie. • Initiated or completed a project individually or as part of a group/association or activities that have resulted in outstanding contributions to the celebration of heritage in Barrie • Significantly dedicated to the restoration of a home, building or historical cultural project, as demonstrated through a commitment of time, energy and resources.

- Although these evaluation criteria include listed or designated buildings, this is not a pre-requisite for nominations
- Receiving an award does not mean that the property will be listed or designated.
- Properties, Individuals or Groups that have received awards in the past will not be considered a second time for at least five (5) years.
