

- 1. ALL CONIFEROUS TREE PLANTING SHALL HAVE A MINIMUM 600mm DIAMETER ROOT BALL.
- CUT AND REMOVE ALL WIRE, ROPE AND BURLAP FROM THE TOP 150mm OF THE ROOT BALL AT THE TIME OF PLANTING.
- FOR POORLY DRAINED OR COMPACTED SOILS THE ROOT BALL SHALL BE PLACED SO
  THAT THE ROOT COLLAR IS A MAXIMUM OF 100mm ABOVE THE FINISHED GRADE. FOR ALL
  OTHER INSTALLATIONS THE ROOT COLLAR SHALL BE AT OR 50mm ABOVE FINISHED
  GRADE.
- 4. ALL TWINE AND BURLAP MUST BE BIODEGRADABLE (UNTREATED).
- 5. ALL DIMENSIONS ARE IN MILLIMETRES UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED.
