



In June of 2005, City of Barrie Council approved the *City of Barrie Water Conservation Master Plan*. Contained within this document are a number of projects aimed at reducing water consumption within City residences. This program will provide water bill credits in the amount of \$50.00 as an incentive for residents to replace high flow toilets with low flow toilets (6 litres or less).

1. This program is only open to owners of residences located within the City of Barrie limits.
2. This program is eligible only for homes built before 1996.
3. The City of Barrie will provide a maximum of one (1) credit per dwelling.
4. The toilet rebate water bill credit is established at a level of \$50.00 for 2019.
5. The water bill credit is only available to residents who replace high flow fixtures (greater than 6 litres per flush) with low flow fixtures (6 litres or less). Please note that this rebate does not apply to toilets installed as a result of new construction or additions.
6. The applicant will be required to sign a form indicating that he/she has replaced a high flow fixture with a low flow fixture and has **disposed of the old toilet at the City of Barrie's landfill** (all fees are to be paid by the applicant at the time of disposal).
7. In order to receive a rebate you will be required to provide:
 - A completed Toilet Rebate Application Form (**available on the 1st Floor, City Hall**);
 - A receipt for the purchase of a new low flow toilet (6 litres or less);
 - Proof of toilet purchase receipt; and
 - Water billing account number.
8. Once all documentation is received and verified, a copy of the Toilet Rebate Application will be processed for a credit on your water bill and a copy will be provided for your records.
9. A credit of \$50.00 will be applied to the water bill of the municipal address indicated on the toilet rebate application form.
