

Licence 2 Ride Conditions of Use

- Licence 2 Ride applications and *Rider's Ed* registration will only be accepted starting May 9th on a **first come first serve** basis until June 30th.
- To be eligible for the *Licence 2 Ride* program the applicant's date of birth **must** be between January 1st 2007 and December 31st 2010 (12-15 years of age).
- Applicants must provide one piece of identification to verify their year of birth when registering.
- Applicants must have their photograph taken to produce their *Licence 2 Ride* pass and taken at time of registration.
- Applications are accepted at: Allandale RC, Peggy Hill Team CC, East Bayfield CC.
- *The Licence 2 Ride* card is valid from June 30th- September 5th, 2022.
- Applicants who are not familiar with Barrie Transit and/or Recreation facilities are encouraged to attend a free *Rider's Ed* information session (see dates & times below).
- The *Licence 2 Ride* pass permits free unlimited use on Barrie Transit and access to drop-in recreation programs at any of the three main recreation centers.
- The *Licence 2 Ride* pass is not transferable and may be confiscated by the City or Transit if used fraudulently.
- The *Licence 2 Ride* pass must be clearly displayed to transit and recreation staff at time of use and shall be surrendered for inspection upon request.
- The *Licence 2 Ride* program is for City of Barrie residents only.

Terms and Conditions of the *Licence 2 Ride*

- The *Licence 2 Ride* program is for City of Barrie residents only.
- The *Licence 2 Ride* applicant's date of birth must be January 1st 2007 - December 31st 2010.
- Applications can be dropped off at Allandale RC, Peggy Hill Team CC, or East Bayfield CC.
- Applicants must provide one piece of identification to verify their year of birth and have their photograph taken to produce the pass.
- Applications & *Rider's Ed* registration will be accepted starting May 9th through June 30th.
- The *Licence 2 Ride* pass is valid from June 30th to September 5th, 2022.
- All pool and drop-in safety admission guidelines apply (barrie.ca for details).
- *Licence 2 Ride* passes are non-transferable and may be confiscated by City Staff or Transit Staff if used fraudulently or reproduced illegally.
- Applicants agree to abide by all facility rules and regulations and understand that failure to do so may result in suspension of pass or admittance privileges.
- Loss of card is to be reported immediately. A replacement fee of \$5.00 will be charged for replacing lost cards.
- *Email addresses collected will be used primarily for the purpose of communicating updates and information about the *Licence 2 Ride* program. Please note applicants may receive other correspondence from the city from time to time.

Waiver of Liability

I hereby release the City of Barrie from all claims for damages arising from any accidents or injuries which are caused by or arise from participation of the applicant(s) named on this form during any drop-in program in any facility or at any location where a program is being held. Unless the participant or guardian so indicates in writing, the Recreation Services Department will assume permission has been given for any pictures taken during any department drop-in program can be used to promote recreation.
