Mapleview Drive East Improvements - Country Lane to Madelaine Drive

The City of Barrie has awarded the Contract 2018-033T for the reconstruction of Mapleview Drive East – Country Lane to Madelaine Drive to Primrose Contracting (Ontario) Inc.

The work is reconstruction, urbanization and widening of Mapleview Drive East from Country Lane to Madelaine Drive to five lanes and includes the following:

- Reconstruction and widening of Mapleview Drive East to five lanes including: new road granular, sub-drain, concrete curb and gutter, and hot mix asphalt
- Storm sewers
- Sanitary trunk sewer
- Watermain
- Concrete sidewalk
- Streetlights
- Traffic signals

The project is expected to start in July 2018 and is scheduled to be completed by November 30, 2018, which will include the described works from Country Lane to Madelaine Drive.

Why Is This Work Being Undertaken?

This reconstruction project replaces aging infrastructure. The sanitary sewer, watermain, and roadways require upgrading to meet today's standards, and minimize long term maintenance costs.

Will My Services Be Affected?

Your water, sanitary sewer, hydro, telephone, cable TV, and gas services should not be affected by the construction, barring any unforeseen circumstances.

Access to Properties

Vehicle access to properties within the construction limits will be provided at almost all times during construction periods. On several occasions, however, direct access to driveways will be interrupted, due to driveway culvert replacement, watermain and sanitary sewer works.

The Contractor must give prior notice of any imminent access restrictions to the businesses.

During the construction, some short delays (e.g. a few minutes) while driving through the construction area can be expected while equipment is maneuvering, trucks are dumping, etc. We ask for your patience in such instances.

A minimum of two lanes of traffic will be open to traffic at all times during construction.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during construction.

Special Needs

If you have any special needs, or if wheelchair access is required, please advise the Senior Construction Engineer (see below).

Emergency Services

Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.

Garbage Collection

On the normal collection day, place all garbage / organics / recyclable and yardwaste materials at the front of your property by 7:00 a.m. (morning).

The construction contractor will remove these items and take them outside the construction zone, for pick up by the collection contractor. Emptied containers will be returned to the

appropriate driveway. Please mark your address on all of your containers, with a black marker.

Safety

The Contractor is required to conduct his work in a safe manner, including fencing of deep excavations, etc. We ask that you take extra caution during the construction period to ensure everyone's safety.
