Mapleview Drive East Improvements - Country Lane to Madelaine Drive

NOTICE: TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE OF MADELAINE DRIVE AT MAPLEVIEW DRIVE EAST

Primrose Contracting Inc., on behalf of the City of Barrie, has scheduled the installation of watermain and appurtenances at the intersection of Madelaine Drive and Mapleview Drive East.

There will be a temporary road closure of Madelaine Drive at Mapleview Drive East on the following dates:

- Monday, January 21st to Friday, January 25th - Madelaine Drive reopened to traffic by 5:00 p.m. on Friday and over the weekend.
- Monday, January 28th to Friday, February 1st - Madelaine Drive reopened to traffic by 5:00 p.m. on Friday and over the weekend.
- Monday, February 4th to Friday, February 8th - Madelaine Drive reopened to traffic by 5:00 p.m. on Friday and over the weekend.

Traffic along Mapleview Drive East will remain uninterrupted throughout the temporary closure duration.

Detour routes surrounding the site will be posted to direct motorists appropriately. Access to Madelaine Drive will be from Country Lane while the intersection of Mapleview Drive East and Madelaine Drive is temporarily closed.

Access to Properties

Vehicle access to properties on Madelaine Drive during the temporary closure will be via Country Lane.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during construction.

Special Needs

If you have any special needs, or if wheelchair access is required, please advise the Engineering Site Inspector (see below).

Emergency Services

Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.

Garbage Collection

On the normal collection day, place all garbage / organics / recyclable and yardwaste materials at the front of your property by 7:00 a.m. (morning).

The construction contractor will remove these items and take them outside the construction zone, for pick up by the collection contractor. Emptied containers will be returned to the appropriate driveway. Please mark your address on all of your containers, with a black marker.

Safety

The Contractor is required to conduct his work in a safe manner, including fencing of deep excavations, etc. We ask that you take extra caution during the construction period to ensure everyone's safety.
