



Free Public Wi-Fi Internet Access

To connect:

1. On your device, connect to the “BarriePublic” Wi-Fi network.
2. Open your browser. You will be redirected to the Wi-Fi Acceptable Use Policy web page (If not redirected automatically, refresh your browser).
3. Review the Policy and, if you agree to the Terms of Use, click “Log-in”.
Please note, you must agree to the Terms of Use to access the Wi-Fi network.
