## Bayview Drive Road Expansion (Little Avenue to Big Bay Point Road)

**Pre-Construction Work Starting: March 2023**

**Road Reconstruction Starting: May 2024**

**Reconstruction Completed: Summer 2027**

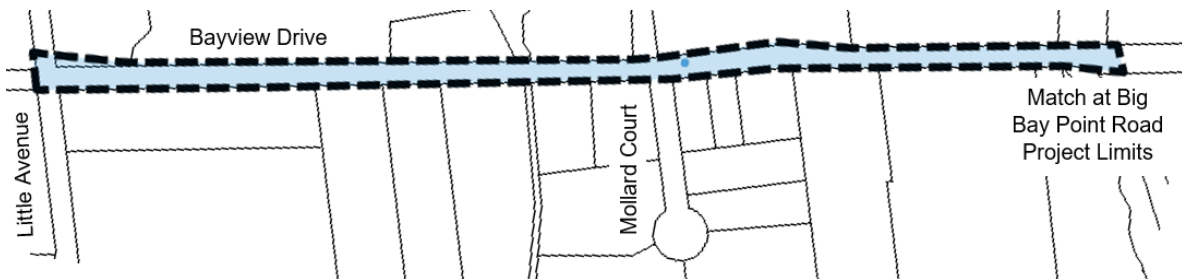
The City of Barrie is beginning preliminary work for the road expansion of Bayview Drive (from Little Avenue to Big Bay Point Road) in 2024. Tree Clearing will be occurring this month, preparing the area for utility relocations.

Project highlights include:

- Widening of the existing road from two (2) lanes to include a third centre turning lane
- Dedicated off road northbound and southbound cycling lanes
- Installation of a new transmission watermain
- Installation of a new storm sewer and three (3) new crossing culverts
- A new sidewalk on the west side of Bayview Drive

This work is part of Council's approved 2023 Capital Plan to renew aging City roadways, sidewalks, watermains, and stormwater infrastructure.

### WORK DETAILS

This preliminary work includes a tree removal contract to remove trees, bushes, and shrubs within the Bayview Drive project limits. Kodiak Tree Services has been awarded this contract.

### WHAT TO EXPECT DURING TREE CLEARING

You may experience noise, traffic delays, and other minor inconveniences. The City will make every effort to reduce any impacts, and your patience is appreciated.

	<p><b>Special Considerations:</b></p> <p>If you have special considerations to be addressed during construction, please contact the Project Manager below.</p>
	<p><b>Road and Sidewalk Access:</b></p> <p>Pedestrian access will be maintained during tree clearing with posted signage for temporary closures.</p>
	<p><b>Driveway Access:</b></p> <p>Driveway access will be maintained throughout tree clearing.</p> <p>Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p> <p><b>Services:</b></p> <p>Hydro, telephone, cable TV, and gas services will not be affected during tree clearing forgoing unforeseen circumstances.</p>
	<p><b>Accessibility:</b></p> <p>If you have any accessibility requirements, or if wheelchair access is required, please contact the City representatives listed below to arrange for access during construction.</p>
	<p><b>Traffic Management:</b></p> <p>Please follow all posted signage and flag persons during tree clearing.</p>
	<p><b>Transit Service:</b></p> <p>Transit services will be operating, as normal, throughout this work.</p>
	<p><b>Garbage and Recycling:</b></p> <p>Garbage, recycling, and yard waste will still be picked up on their regular scheduled collection day. Please place everything curbside by 7:00 a.m.</p>
	<p><b>Safety:</b></p> <p>The Contractor is required to conduct work in a safe manner. We ask that you take extra caution during the construction period to ensure everyone's safety.</p>
