

SUNNIDALE ROAD NEW TRANSMISSION WATERMAIN AND LOCAL SEWER & WATERMAIN RELOCATIONS (Letitia Street to Wellington Street)

Start Date: June 1, 2023

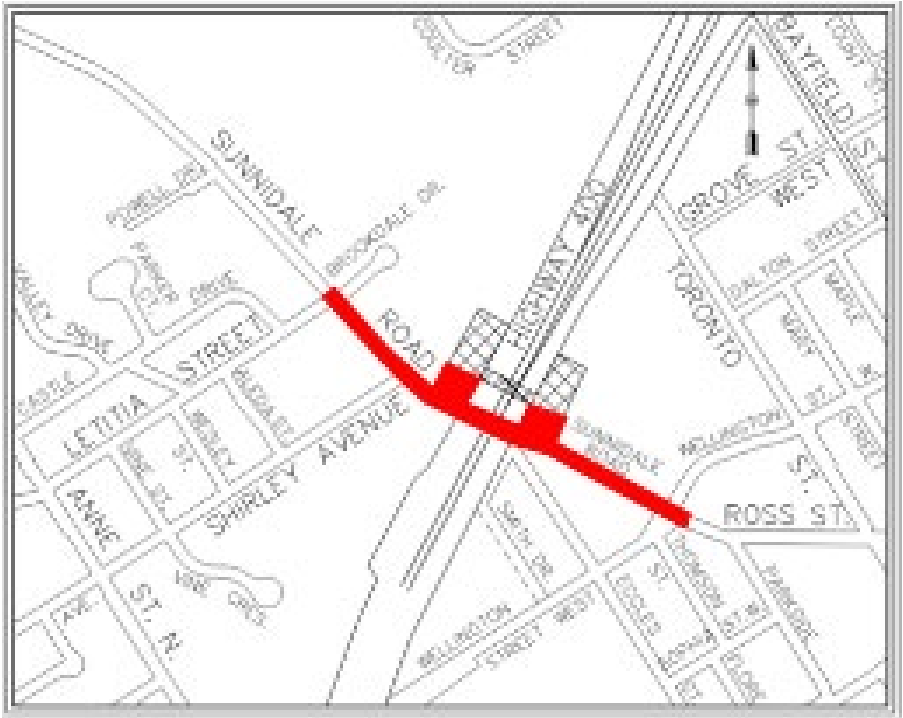
End Date: July 28, 2023

The City of Barrie is resuming work on the new transmission watermain along Sunnisdale Road, between Letitia Street and Wellington Street. North Rock Group Limited (North Rock) will be starting June 1, 2023.

This work is part of City Council's approved Capital Works Program.

WORK DETAILS

North Rock will:

- Install a new transmission watermain from Highway 400 to Letitia Street and from Highway 400 to Wellington Street.
- Restore all landscape areas impacted during the work conducted.
- Decommission all City infrastructure (watermains, storm and sanitary sewers) found within the Sunnisdale Road Highway 400 bridge for demolition. The Ministry of Transportation (MTO) will be replacing the Sunnisdale bridge and communication on these details will be provided at a later date.

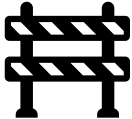
WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

You may experience inconveniences such as, dust, noise, and short delays. The City will make efforts to reduce impacts, and your patience is appreciated.

The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items on City property, including sprinkler systems.



The Contractor has retained the services of OZA Inspections Limited (OZA) to complete a precondition survey of the exterior and interior of your home. Communication from The City and OZA will be sent to book a pre-condition survey appointment.

	Road and Sidewalk Access: Pedestrian access will be maintained during construction. Sunnidale Road will only be accessible to local residence traffic and emergency vehicles and closed to through traffic during the construction. Sunnidale Road will NOT be closed until Anne Street is reopened to traffic.
	Driveway Access: Vehicle entry to properties within the construction limits will be available. At times, direct access to driveways will be interrupted for watermain work. Access for emergency vehicles will always be maintained. Services: Hydro, sanitary sewer services, water services, telephone, cable TV, and gas services should not be affected by the construction, barring any unforeseen circumstances.
	Accessibility: If you have any accessibility requirements, such as wheelchair access, please contact one of the City representatives listed below.
	Traffic Management: The Contractor will use traffic control measures to close Sunnidale Road at Wellington Street and Letitia Street. At this time, access across Highway 400 remains open. Upon completion of the work detailed, the MTO will begin the Sunnidale Road Bridge Replacement Project, which will inhibit access across Highway 400 on Sunnidale Road. Further information regarding that project will be shared through a separate bulletin.
	Transit Service: The proposed construction will not affect Barrie transit routes, and schedules.
	Parking: Parking on roadways in an active construction area is not permitted. Vehicles parked in the construction area will be ticketed and towed. Please do not park on Sunnidale Road unless requested by a member of the City's Engineering Inspection team.
	Garbage and Recycling: Garbage, recycling, and yard waste will be collected on the regular collection day during construction. Ensure everything for pick up is curbside by 7:00 a.m. on the collection day.
	Safety: The Contractor is required to conduct work in a safe manner, such as using traffic cones, and fencing off excavations. Please use extra caution in the construction zone to ensure everyone's safety.
