

Big Bay Point Road – Painswick Bridge ‘B’ Rehabilitation – Construction Update

Start Date: June 2023

End Date: August 2023

**Timeline is subject to change.*

The City of Barrie is continuing its rehabilitation of Painswick Bridge B. The next portion of this project includes work along the underside of the bridge, directly above the rail tracks.

To accommodate train schedules and safety protocols the work will also take place at night between 7:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. Noise will include sandblasting, equipment maneuvering, and air chisels, similar to noise already heard during work to this point.

MAP OF THE WORK AREA









WORK DETAILS

The contractor, Clearwater Structures Incorporated will:

- Remove and replace the concrete on the underside of the bridge, above the rail tracks; and,
- Sandblast steel reinforcements.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

	<p>Night and Weekend Work:</p> <p>Work for this portion of the project will occur nightly between 7 p.m. and 7 a.m. Weekend work may occur if required.</p>
	<p>Noise Bylaw 2006-140 – As Amended:</p> <p>This project is exempt from the Noise Bylaw as per Schedule 2 Permanent Exemptions Section 3: “The operation of equipment in conjunction with City projects or reconstruction projects, general maintenance and emergency maintenance projects.”</p>
	<p>Road and Sidewalk Access:</p> <p>Pedestrian access will be maintained during construction on the south sidewalk. The north sidewalk will remain closed.</p>
	<p>Accessibility:</p> <p>If you have any accessibility requirements, such as wheelchair access, please contact the City representatives listed below.</p>
	<p>Traffic Management:</p> <p>The contractor will use traffic control measures, such as traffic cones to steer traffic around the work zone. The construction zone will remain the same.</p>
	<p>Safety:</p> <p>The contractor is required to conduct work in a safe manner, such as using traffic cones and fencing off the work area. Please use extra caution while going through the construction zone.</p>
