The City of Barrie will be demolishing the building at 93 Bradford Street to accommodate the Bunkers Creek improvements. The property has been acquired to accommodate the creek improvements.

WORK DETAILS

The City's contractor will primarily be working within the noted property limits. The Contractor will:

- Remove 93 Bradford Street building, post signs, wooden light post, etc.;
- Remove and dispose all underground and above ground services from the building to the property line;
- Restore the disturbed area with gravel and graded to maintain existing drainage.








WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce impacts. Your patience is appreciated.



Road and Sidewalk Access: Pedestrian access will be maintained during construction.

During the construction, some short delays (e.g., a few minutes) while driving through the construction area can be expected while equipment is maneuvering, trucks are dumping, etc. We ask for your patience in such instances.

	<p>Emergency Vehicle Access: Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p> <p>Services: Your sanitary sewer, hydro, telephone, cable TV, and gas services should not be affected by the construction, barring any unforeseen circumstances.</p>
	<p>Accessibility: If you have any accessibility requirements, or if wheelchair access is required, please contact the City representatives listed below to arrange for access during construction.</p>
	<p>Traffic Management: Bradford Street will remain open to traffic during construction. Occasionally, flag persons will be required to assist with traffic control while construction vehicles are accessing the site.</p>
	<p>Transit Service: The proposed construction will not affect Barrie Transit routes or their schedules as full road closures are not anticipated. However, in the event that any changes are required on certain bus routes, Barrie Transit will post notices of these changes in advance. If you have any questions regarding public transit, please call Barrie Transit Customer Services at (705) 739-4209.</p>
	<p>Parking: Parking in the active work zone is not permitted due to space requirements for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects the construction work, it will be re-located with no charge to the owner.</p>
	<p>Garbage and Recycling: Garbage, recycling and yard waste will still be collected during construction on the regular scheduled collection day. Collection times may change, please ensure waste is at the curb by 7:00 a.m.</p>
	<p>Safety: The Contractor is required to conduct their work in a safe manner, including fencing of deep excavations, etc. We ask that you take extra caution during the construction period to ensure everyone's safety.</p>
