## Barrie Reeves and Mayors

### (1853 to 2006) and Municipal History

In 1838, Barrie officials on the Vespra Township Board of Commissioners were:

Robert Ross, Francis Martin, and John Bingham as fence viewers  
 Thrift Meldrum as poundkeeper  
 William Graham as overseer for the east division of Barrie  
 and Francis Martin overseer for the west division of Barrie

In 1849, Barrie was listed as unincorporated and under the jurisdiction of Vespra Township. In 1851 the citizens of Barrie numbered over 1,000 and they petitioned to separate from Vespra to become a town. This gave them “village” status with a reeve, not a mayor. This change was proclaimed on September 23, 1853, and became effective on January 1, 1854.

The first municipal election was held on Monday, January 2, 1854. Jonathan Lane was elected the first Reeve to lead a small Council of local merchants, professionals and tradesmen. On December 9, 1856 the record books containing minutes and bylaws of Town Council were burned in a fire that destroyed the residence of Town Clerk George Lane (brother to Jonathan Lane, first Reeve).

On January 1, 1871 Barrie became an incorporated town. On January 2, 1871 elections were held and brewer Robert Simpson was elected the first mayor of Barrie. The town was divided into three wards, being St. George's, St. Andrew's and St. Patrick's.

In 1887 electoral wards were increased from three to five: St. Patrick, St. Andrew, Victoria, St. David and St. George.

William Peter Soules was the first Reeve for the hamlet of Allandale. Allandale applied for incorporation as a “village”, and on December 15, 1896 Barrie was successful in annexing the Village of Allandale. Allandale then became the Town of Barrie's Sixth Ward.

On January 11, 1900 the *Northern Advance* (local newspaper) reported that Barrie councillors are now to be called aldermen.

On December 3, 1928, the Barrie municipal election was held in December for the first time, instead of the first Monday in January.

On September 22, 1958, the Town of Barrie passed By-law 2349 which authorized an application by the town to the Ontario Municipal Board to “erect The Corporation of the Town of Barrie into a City”. On January 1, 1959 Barrie was incorporated as a City (Simcoe County's first city). On becoming a city, the offices of reeve and deputy reeve were eliminated, and the city divided into 4 wards, down from the longstanding six, with three representatives in each. Annual municipal elections were dispensed with in favour of bi-annual elections. The City of Barrie became a “separated city”, formally separating from Simcoe County on December 17, 1959.
