# NIGHT WORK – GROVE STREET EAST WATERMAIN REPLACEMENT – NELSON STREET TO JOHNSON STREET

Start Date: September 14<sup>th</sup>, 2023 End Date: September 15<sup>th</sup>, 2023 \*Timeline is subject to change.

To date, Drainstar Contracting has completed the watermain installation and base course asphalt paving.

Work remaining includes:

- Final watermain connections;
- Water service connections;
- · Localized curb and sidewalk repair;
- Surface course asphalt; and,
- Final restoration.

#### **WORK DETAILS - NIGHT WORK**

Drainstar Contracting will be completing the following work from 7:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m.

- Water service connection for Eastview Arena; and,
- Water service connection to 477 Grove Street (plaza at Grove Street and Johnson Street).

#### WHAT TO EXPECT DURING NIGHTWORK CONSTRUCTION

Unfortunately, you may experience noise from 7:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m starting on September 14<sup>th</sup> and into the morning of September 15<sup>th</sup>. Every effort will be made to minimize the noise and we thank you for your cooperation and understanding.



#### Accessibility:

If you have any accessibility requirements, such as wheelchair access, please contact the City representatives listed below.




#### **Watermain Connection and Water Service Connection:**

Water usage will be interrupted in order to connect the new main to the old main, and your water service from property line to the new main. The City will deliver a water interruption notice 48 hours in advance of all planned interruptions.

Prior to an interruption the City recommends filling water jugs for drinking water, filling the bathtub to flush toilets, and shutting off water softeners.



#### **Road and Sidewalk Access:**



Pedestrian access will be maintained during construction, limited to one side of Grove Street East.

During this time, some short delays might be experienced while driving through the construction zones. These delays should be minimal while equipment is maneuvering. We ask for your patience in such instances.



Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.

Please take your time while driving through construction zone to help promote your safety as well as the safety of the construction team.



#### **Driveway Access:**

Vehicle access to properties within the construction limits will be provided during construction periods. On occasion, direct access to driveways will be interrupted due to watermain works, and curb/sidewalk replacement.

The Contractor will deliver a driveway interruption notice 1 day prior to the interruption stating date and duration of driveway interruption.



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	<b>Services:</b> Your sanitary sewer, hydro, telephone, cable TV, and gas services should not be affected by the construction, barring any unforeseen circumstances.
	Transit Service:
	Transit routes 100 A and 100 B will continue to be detoured to Steel Street.
Ш	Bus stops on Johnson Street will remain operational.

	Parking:
	Parking in the active work zone is not permitted.
	Garbage and Recycling:
	Garbage, recycling and yard waste will be collected during construction on the regular scheduled collection day. Collection times may change, please ensure waste is <b>at the curb by 7:00 a.m.</b>
	Please label garbage containers with a black marker with your house number, if garbage is required to be relocated the contractor will move your garbage and return your empty containers.

	The Contractor is required to conduct their work in a safe manner. We ask that you use extra caution when driving or walking through the construction zone to ensure everyone's safety.
