

Water Service and Backflow Prevention Upgrades for Parks and Open Spaces

Start Date: October 3rd, 2023

End Date: October 17th, 2023

Timeline is subject to change.

The City of Barrie is decommissioning water services at multiple park locations within the City, and has awarded the Contract to Yorkton Contracting Ltd.

The water services that will be decommissioned are at the following locations:

- Blair Park (24 Marcus Street)
- Leacock Park (280 Leacock Drive)
- Lions Park (30 Sophia Street East)
- Scott Park (95 Scott Crescent)

WORK DETAILS

Yorkton Contracting Ltd will:

- Excavate to locate the existing watermain.
- Remove the water service in park space.
- Restore the excavated area.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

You may experience inconveniences such as, dust, noise and slight delays. The City will make efforts to reduce impacts, and your patience is appreciated.

If there are impacts to your property or directly in front of your property further notice will be provided to those property owners.



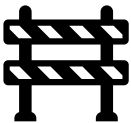
Road and Sidewalk Access:

Pedestrian access will be maintained during construction.

During the construction, some short delays (e.g. a few minutes) while driving through the construction area can be expected while equipment is maneuvering, trucks are dumping, etc.

During the construction, there may be reduced sidewalk access though the construction area while the crew completes their work. We will make efforts to reduce these impacts.

We ask for your patience in such instances.

	Driveway Access: Vehicle entry to properties within the construction limits will be available. Access for emergency vehicles will always be maintained. Services: Hydro, sanitary sewer services, water services, telephone, cable TV, and gas services should not be affected by the construction, barring any unforeseen circumstances.
	Accessibility: If you have any accessibility requirements, such as wheelchair access, please contact the City representatives listed below.
	Traffic Management: The Contractor will use traffic control measures, such as traffic cones to steer through traffic around contractor equipment and vehicles, within the construction site. Flag persons will assist with traffic control, if required.
	Parking: Parking on roadways in an active construction area is not permitted. Vehicles parked in the construction area will be ticketed and towed.
	Garbage and Recycling: Garbage, recycling, and yard waste will be collected on the regular collection day during construction. Ensure everything for pick up is curbside by 7:00 a.m. on the collection day.
	Safety: The Contractor is required to conduct work in a safe manner, such as using traffic cones and fencing off excavations. Please use extra caution in the construction zone to ensure everyone's safety.
