The City of Barrie (the 'City') Phase-One Reconstruction of the Brock Park Neighbourhood is being performed by North Rock Group. The construction activities for the 2023 season are now completed. The City would like to provide the residents affected by the construction activities with an update on the progress of this project.

WORK COMPLETED IN 2023

During the 2023 construction season, North Rock Group has:

- Replaced road infrastructure on:
 - John Street (from Bradford Street to Innisfil Street)
 - Innisfil Street (from John Street to Dyments Creek)
 - Frederick Street
 - Robert Street (from Frederick Street to John Street)
- Infrastructure replacement work included road reconstruction, watermain replacement, sanitary sewer replacement, storm sewer replacement, new curb installation and a new sidewalk on Innisfil Street.

PRIOR TO WINTER

The following restoration works have been completed:

- The road has been paved with base course asphalt;
- New curbs were poured;
- A new sidewalk has been placed on Innisfil Street;
- Sidewalk on John Street has been restored with temporary asphalt;
- The driveways have been restored with temporary asphalt; and,
- Any impacted grass has been roughly graded.

WHAT TO EXPECT IN 2024

The City is anticipating construction for 2024 to begin in April (weather pending). An information bulletin will be issued in the spring when the construction start date is anticipated.

Construction in 2024 will include:

- Replace the existing sidewalks on John Street;
- Install new sidewalk on Frederick Street;
- Install new sidewalk on Robert Street;
- Remove existing street lights and install new light standards and street lights;
- Restore impacted driveways;
- Restore topsoil and sod; and
- Place surface asphalt throughout

The City would like to thank all residents for their support and cooperation experienced throughout the duration of this project. The City understands this work is intrusive to your daily lives and appreciate your understanding and patience throughout the project.
