

Notice of Study Commencement: 2051 Water Master Plan


Laying the Foundation for Tomorrow's Infrastructure

The Study

The 2019 provincial Growth Plan for the Greater Golden Horseshoe has forecasted that the City of Barrie will grow to 298,000 people and 150,000 jobs by 2051. The City of Barrie ("City") is updating its Water Master Plan to determine the drinking water servicing requirements to accommodate that growth. The study area encompasses the entire city boundary, shown on the map.

This study will:

- Assess the existing drinking water system including surface water treatment plant, groundwater wells, reservoirs, elevated tanks, booster pump stations and watermains to identify existing capacity constraints and opportunities for improvement;
- Ensure water services meet the current and future community needs by providing long-term and integrated water servicing strategies to 2051 and beyond; and
- Recommend future infrastructure projects that will provide the required water service.



The Process

The Water Master Plan study is being undertaken in accordance with Approach #1 of the master planning process to address the requirements of Phases 1 and 2 of the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment process.

GHD Limited has been retained by the City to prepare the updated Water Master Plan. The study duration is approximately two years.
