

Bayview Drive Improvements (Little Avenue to Big Bay Point Road)

Start Date: Summer 2024

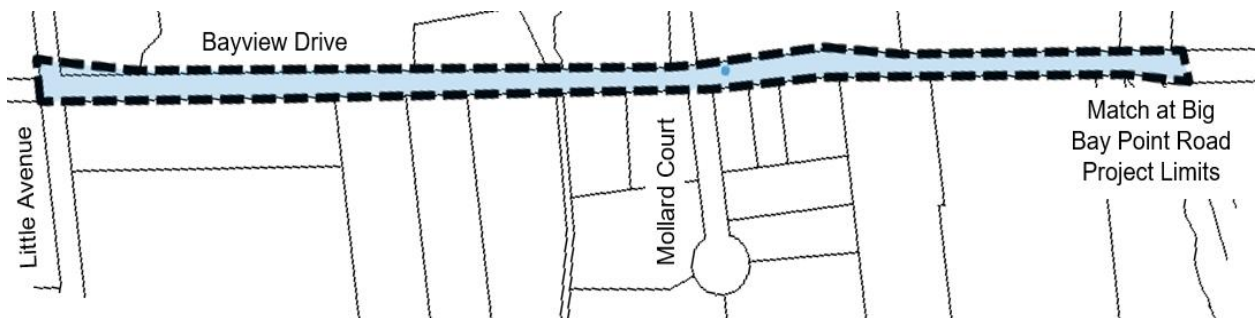
End Date: Spring 2026

The City of Barrie (City) is expanding Bayview Drive, from Little Avenue to Big Bay Point Road and has awarded the construction contract to Primrose Contractors (Ontario) Incorporated (Primrose). The first phase of this project, utility relocations by service providers, will be ongoing during this next phase which is expected to commence June 2024.

This work is part of Barrie City Council's approved 2024 Capital Plan to renew aging City roadways, sidewalks, watermains and stormwater infrastructure.

WORK DETAILS

Primrose will:

- Widen the existing road from two (2) lanes to three (3) lanes (adding a centre turning lane);
- Install cycle tracks on both sides of the road, and a sidewalk on the west side of the road;
- Install a new watermain, storm sewer and, three (3) crossing culverts.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION








You may experience inconveniences such as, dust, noise, short delays, and a road closure. The City will make efforts to reduce impacts, and your patience is appreciated.

Further notice will be provided to property owners and businesses when there are road closures, disruptions to water services and driveway access. If you have a sprinkler system within the boulevard portion of your property, please contact a representative identified below.

The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items on City property, including the sprinkler system.

Access to businesses will be maintained at all times.

	<p>The Contractor has retained the services of GPM Environmental to complete a precondition survey of the exterior of your home or business. Separate letters will be sent from the City and the survey company to book an appointment.</p>
	<p>Road and Sidewalk Access: Pedestrian access will be maintained during construction, however there will be no through access available during the road closure.</p>

	<p>Bayview Drive will be closed to through traffic, with access to business' being maintained. The City will post signage, as required, on how to access businesses.</p>
	<p>Driveway Access:</p> <p>Driveway access will be maintained throughout construction.</p> <p>Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p> <p>Services:</p> <p>Water services will be shut off for short durations of the construction to allow for connection to the new watermain. At least 48-hours notice will be provided to property owners and businesses prior to any water shutoffs.</p>
	<p>Accessibility:</p> <p>If you have any accessibility requirements, such as wheelchair access, please contact the City representatives listed below.</p>
	<p>Traffic Management:</p> <p>Traffic control measures, such as traffic barrels to steer through traffic around contractor equipment and vehicles, signage, and flag persons will assist with traffic control as required.</p>
	<p>Transit Service:</p> <p>The proposed construction will affect Barrie Transit routes, and schedules. Changes to bus routes in the construction area will be posted in advance.</p>
	<p>Parking:</p> <p>Parking on roadways in an active construction area is not permitted. Vehicles parked in the construction area will be ticketed and towed.</p>
	<p>Garbage and Recycling:</p> <p>Garbage, recycling, and yard waste will be collected on the regular collection day during construction. Ensure everything for pick up is curbside by 7:00 a.m. on the collection day so Primrose can bring items to the designated collection location.</p> <p>Please label recycling and garbage containers clearly so the contractor can return them.</p>
	<p>Safety:</p> <p>The contractors are required to conduct work in a safe manner, such as using traffic barrels and fencing off excavations. Please use extra caution in the construction zone to ensure everyone's safety.</p>
