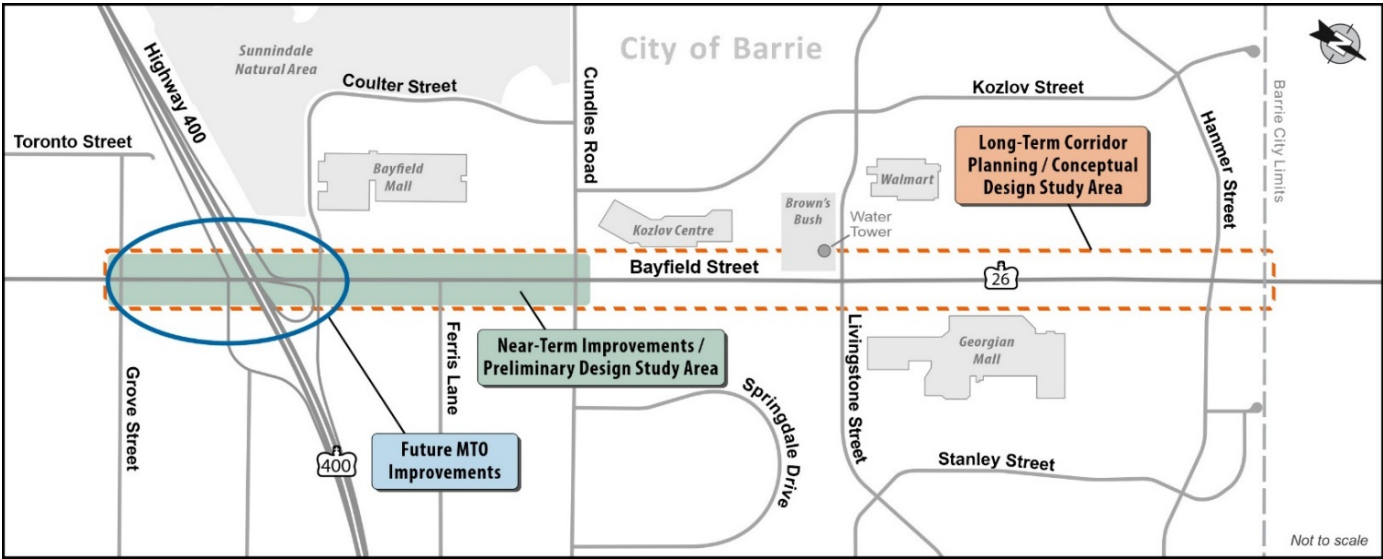


Notice of Public Information Centre No. 2
Bayfield Street Transportation Improvements, City of Barrie
Municipal Class Environmental Assessment Study

THE STUDY

The City of Barrie has retained WSP Canada Inc. (WSP) to complete a Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (MCEA) Study for transportation improvements on Bayfield Street from Grove Street to the City of Barrie limits. The location of the work to be completed is shown on the enclosed key map.



THE PROCESS

This MCEA Study will follow the planning and design process following the Municipal Engineers Association’s MCEA process for a Schedule ‘C’ undertaking (October 2000, as amended in 2007, 2011, 2015 and 2023), which is an approved process under the Ontario Environmental Assessment Act. Once the study is complete and recommendations are approved by Council, an Environmental Study Report (ESR) will be prepared and filed for a 30-day public review period. Pending completion of the MCEA and subject to budget approval, the City intends to proceed to the detailed design phase of the project.
