

## Notice of Public Information Centre #1 2051 Transportation Master Plan

Laying the Foundation for Tomorrow's Infrastructure

### The Study

The 2019 provincial Growth Plan for the Greater Golden Horseshoe has identified that the City of Barrie (the "City") will grow to 298,000 people and 150,000 jobs by 2051. The City is updating its Transportation Master Plan (TMP) to determine multi-modal infrastructure requirements to support this growth.

This study will:

- Review the existing TMP and current network conditions to identify existing capacity constraints;
- Ensure the transportation network and services meet the current and future community needs by providing long-term and integrated transportation planning strategies to the 2051 planning horizon; and
- Recommend future transportation projects to support planned growth to 2051.

- Provide an overview of the TMP study process and project tasks to date;
