**Re: Wellington D2 Neighbourhood Reconstruction – Detailed Design and Field Investigations**

The City of Barrie (City) Infrastructure Department is continuing with the detailed design for the reconstruction of Wellington D2 Neighbourhood, which includes the following streets:

- Amelia Street, from Dundonald Street to Duckworth Street.
- Dundonald Street, from Collier Street to Eugenia Street.
- Project limits have been extended to include Duckworth Street from Eugenia Street to Amelia Street.

The City will complete several investigations and studies during detailed design phase to gather site conditions and background information on the existing conditions. These include; topographic and legal Surveys, geotechnical (soils) investigations, and utility investigations. Note, this work **will not** require entrance into your residence unless contacted directly by a member of the City project team.

The City has retained the services of various consultants to complete the work noted above. All individuals will wear protective vests and carry identification showing who they work for during the investigations. City Staff and Consultants are required to conduct work in a safe manner. We ask that you take extra caution during the investigations to ensure everyone's safety.

During the investigations sanitary sewers, water service, hydro, telephone, cable TV, and gas services should not be affected, barring any unforeseen circumstances. Driveway and sidewalk access within the project limits will be available at almost all times.

Project features of the reconstruction include:

- Roadway reconstruction
- Watermain, sanitary sewer and laterals, and storm sewer replacements

- Sidewalk installation and replacement
- Street lighting replacement

The expected project schedule is:

- 2025 – 2026: Detailed design completion
- 2026 – 2027: Utility relocations
- 2026 – 2027: Construction completion
