Dear Resident,

Re: Marta Crescent & Kierland Road Backyard Flooding – Detailed Design

The City of Barrie's (City) Infrastructure Department is preparing the detailed design for the backyard regrading project on Marta Crescent and Kierland Road. This initiative aims to address ongoing backyard flooding issues and will involve the following properties:

- Marta Crescent: #21, #23, #25, #27, #29, #31, #33, #35, #37, #39, #41
- Kierland Road: #51, #53, #55, #57

The City will be reaching out to homeowners individually this spring to provide further details and discuss the project. This will be an opportunity for residents to ask questions, share any concerns, and learn more about the planned improvements.

Additional field investigations, such as drone photos or additional topographic survey work may be required as part of this project. If a topographic survey is required, the City will retain a surveying consultant to complete the work and schedule with affected homeowners individually.

During field investigations and construction, sanitary sewers, water service, hydro, telephone, cable TV, and gas services should not be affected, barring any unforeseen circumstances. Driveway and sidewalk access within the project limits will be available at all times.

Project features include:

- Backyard regrading (fill) to address flooding issues.
- Chain link fence replacement.
- Side yard fence removal and replacement as required.
- Rear yard features removal and reinstatement as required.
- Topsoil and sod placement.

The expected project schedule is:

- 2025: Detailed design and access agreements
- 2026: Construction
