Licence 2 Ride Conditions of Use

- Licence 2 Ride applications will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis.
- To be eligible for the *Licence 2 Ride* program, the applicant's date of birth must be between **January 1, 2009, and December 31, 2014 (12-17 years of age)**.
- Applicants must provide one piece of identification to verify their year of birth when registering.
- The *Licence 2 Ride* program is for City of Barrie residents only.
- Applicants **must have their photograph taken at the time of registration** to produce their *Licence 2 Ride* pass.
- Applications are accepted at Allandale RC, Peggy Hill Team CC, and East Bayfield CC or online (visit play.barrie.ca).
- **The *Licence 2 Ride* card is valid from July 1- September 7, 2026.**
- Applicants who are not familiar with Barrie Transit and/or recreation facilities are encouraged to attend a free virtual *Rider's Ed* information session (visit barrie.ca/licence2ride for more information).
- The *Licence 2 Ride* pass allows for free unlimited use on Barrie Transit and access to drop-in recreation programs at any of the three main recreation centres.
- The *Licence 2 Ride* pass is not transferable and may be confiscated by the City of Barrie or Transit if used fraudulently.
- The *Licence 2 Ride* pass must be clearly displayed to transit and recreation staff at time of use and shall be surrendered for inspection upon request.

Terms and Conditions of the *Licence 2 Ride*

- The *Licence 2 Ride* program is for City of Barrie residents only.
- The *Licence 2 Ride* applicant's date of birth must be **January 1, 2009 - December 31, 2014**.
- Applicants must provide one piece of identification to verify their year of birth and have their photograph taken to produce the pass.
- Applications can be submitted online at play.barrie.ca, by a parent/guardian. To finalize your registration and receive your *Licence 2 Ride* card, visit one of the Recreation Centres in person and show your proof of age.
- Applications are available on a first-come, first-served basis, while quantities last.
- The *Licence 2 Ride* pass is valid from **July 1 to September 7, 2026**.
- All pool and drop-in safety admission guidelines apply.
- *Licence 2 Ride* passes are non-transferable and may be confiscated by City or Transit Staff if used fraudulently or reproduced illegally.
- Applicants agree to abide by all facility rules and regulations and understand that failure to do so may result in suspension of pass or admittance privileges.
- Loss of card is to be reported immediately.
- Email addresses collected will be used primarily for communicating updates and information about the *Licence 2 Ride* program. Please note applicants may receive other correspondence from the city from time to time.

Waiver of Liability

I hereby release the City of Barrie from all claims for damages arising from any accidents or injuries which are caused by or arise from participation of the applicant(s) named on this form during any drop-in program in any facility or at any location where a program is being held.

Unless the participant or guardian so indicates in writing, the City of Barrie will assume permission has been given for any pictures/video footage taken during any department drop-in program can be used to promote the City's recreation or transit programs.

I agree to abide by the City of Barrie's rules, regulations, policies and procedures (as amended from time to time) relating to use of its recreation programs and facilities, recognizing that failure to do so may result in the City revoking my privileges.
