

PURPOSE

Purpose of the Project

The Corporation of the City of Barrie is undertaking the design of transportation improvements on Yonge Street; Huronia Road; and McKay Road East, as recommended in the City's Multi-Modal Active Transportation Master Plan (MMATMP).

 To present the proposed improvements, answer any questions, and seek community feedback to help guide the finalization of the design.



YONGE STREET

Yonge Street (Mapleview Drive to approx. 250 m south of Lockhart Road)

The road reconstruction design includes:


- Widening to a four-lane cross-section;
- 1.2 m to 4.2 m median (raised or painted depending on adjacent land use);
- 1.5 m bike lanes with 0.5 m buffer on both sides of the street;
- 2.0 m sidewalks and 2.9 m boulevards on both sides of the street;
- Local watermain and sanitary services;
- Storm sewer and appurtenances; and
- Low Impact Development (LID) stormwater management strategy, where possible.

HURONIA ROAD

Huronia Road (Lockhart Road to South City Limit, approx. 650 m south of McKay Road East)

The road will be reconstructed in stages, over time:

INTERIM – Addresses Growth to 2031	ULTIMATE – Required Beyond 2031
A rural corridor with two vehicular travel lanes;	An urban, multi-modal corridor with two vehicular travel lanes and a centre lane ranging from 1.2 m to 4.2 m in width;
2.0m shoulder and 0.6 m rounding on both sides;	1.5 m bike lanes with 0.5 m buffer on both sides of the street;
New trunk sanitary sewer, watermain, and local water services;	2.0 m sidewalks and 2.9 m boulevards on both sides of the street;
Open ditches, LID stormwater management practices, where possible;	New storm sewer and LID stormwater management practices, where possible;
Three major watercourse crossings.	Three major watercourse crossings.



Interim Cross-Section



MCKAY ROAD EAST

McKay Road East (Huronia Road to Highway 400)

The road will be reconstructed in stages, over time:

INTERIM – Addresses Growth to 2031	ULTIMATE – Required Beyond 2031
A rural corridor with four vehicular travel lanes;	An urban, multi-modal corridor with four vehicular travel lanes and a centre lane ranging from 1.2 m to 4.2 m in width;
2.0m shoulder and 0.6 m rounding on both sides;	1.5 m bike lanes with 0.5 m buffer on both sides of the street;
New trunk sanitary sewer, watermain, and local water services;	2.0 m sidewalks and 2.9 m boulevards on both sides of the street;
Open ditches, LID stormwater management practices, where possible;	New storm sewer and LID stormwater management practices, where possible;
Railway and major utility crossings.	Railway and major utility crossings.



Interim Cross-Section






MCKAY ROAD EAST
