


**BAYVIEW DRIVE IMPROVEMENTS (Little Avenue to Big Bay Point Road)****ONGOING SINCE SUMMER 2024****END DATE: SPRING 2026***\*Timeline is subject to change.*

The City of Barrie's (City) reconstruction of Bayview Drive Improvements being performed by Primrose Contracting Inc. (Primrose) and is actively progressing. To date the subsurface work has been completed, including watermain replacement and installation of a new storm sewer and crossing culverts.

**MAP OF THE WORK AREA****WORK UPDATE**

Primrose will continue progress by:


- Widening the existing road from two (2) lanes to three (3) lanes (adding a centre turning lane);
- Installing cycle lanes on both sides of the roadway, and a sidewalk on the west side;
- Continuing one-way access for vehicles driving southbound on Bayview Drive until two lanes can be safely opened.

More construction activity in the construction zone will occur as operation of the above work continues. Heavy equipment and construction machinery will be present and vehicles driving in the southbound direction are asked to exercise caution and be aware of surroundings while travelling through the construction zone.

**WHAT TO EXPECT**

You may experience inconveniences such as, dust, noise, and short delays. The City will make efforts to reduce impacts, and your patience is appreciated.

	<b>Road and Sidewalk Access:</b> Pedestrian access will be maintained during construction.  The southbound lane will be open to traffic at all times, barring any unforeseen circumstances.  Access for emergency vehicles will always be maintained.
	<b>Driveway Access:</b> Vehicle entry to properties within the construction limits will be available. At times, direct access to driveways and parking lots will be interrupted to facilitate the road construction while maintaining worker and public safety.

	<b>Accessibility:</b> If you have any accessibility requirements, such as wheelchair access or home care, please contact the City representatives listed below.
	<b>Traffic Management:</b> The Contractor will use traffic control measures, such as traffic cones to steer through traffic around contractor equipment and vehicles, within the construction site. Flag persons will assist with traffic control, if required.
	<b>Transit Service:</b> Changes to Barrie Transit routes and schedules in the construction area will continue to be posted.
	<b>Parking:</b> Parking on roadways in an active construction area is not permitted. Vehicles parked in the construction zone will be ticketed and towed.
	<b>Garbage and Recycling:</b> Garbage, recycling, and yard waste will be collected on the regular collection day during construction. Primrose may need to move items to a designated area for pickup City's waste contractor. Garbage cans, organics bins, and recycling boxes will be returned to your property later the same day. <b>Clearly mark your address on all containers.</b>  Ensure everything for pick up is curbside by <b>7:00 a.m. on the collection day or it may not be picked up.</b>
	<b>Safety:</b> The Contractor is required to conduct work in a safe manner, such as using traffic cones and fencing off excavations. Please use extra caution in the construction zone to ensure everyone's safety.

The City would like to thank all residents for their support and cooperation throughout this project. They City recognizes the impact this work may have on your daily routines and appreciates your understanding and patience throughout the project.
