

2025 SANITARY SEWER RENEWAL PROGRAM

START DATE: JUNE 2025

END DATE: AUGUST 2025

Timeline is subject to change.

The City of Barrie (City) has retained services of GFL Utility Inc. (GFL) to complete sanitary sewer lining at various locations within the City.

This work will extend the life of aging infrastructure and will minimize long-term maintenance costs. GFL will use a trenchless sewer lining method, and the City does not anticipate excavation of the roadway, barring any unforeseen issues.

SELECTED STREETS

Street Locations and Limits for 2025 Sanitary Sewer Renewal:

- Sunnidale Road from Powell Drive to Brookdale Drive;
- Brookdale Drive from Sunnidale Road to End;
- Rose Street from Peel Street to east of Davidson Street;
- Newton Street from south of Rose Street to Grove Street East;
- Bothwell Crescent from Davidson Street to Grove Street East;
- Jonathan Court from Bothwell Crescent to End;
- Lay Street from Highview Road to Wellington Street East.

WHAT DO I HAVE TO DO

If you are located **inside** the construction zone:

- Sanitary services will be directly affected by the lining while work takes place.
 - A service disruption notice will be provided to residences at least twenty-four (24) hours before the work starts.
- During the work, if you reside inside the service disruption area:
 - Minimize water usage by avoiding the use of showers, baths, sinks, dishwashers, and washing machines during the sewer lining.
 - Close toilet lids during times when they are not being used and keep toilet flushing to a minimum.
 - To prevent odours, pour two (2) liters of water into frequently used plumbing fixtures (sinks, drains, etc.) to ensure the trap is full.
 - Place a damp towel over any floor drains to restrict odours from the sewer main from entering the house (If you experience a glue type smell while the work is occurring, open windows in the home for an hour to air out the space).

During the work, If you are located **outside** the service disruption area:

- To prevent odours, pour two (2) liters of water into frequently used plumbing fixtures (sinks, drains, etc.) to ensure the trap is full.
- Place a damp towel over any floor drains to restrict odours from the sewer main from entering the house (If you experience a glue type smell while the work is occurring, open windows in the home for an hour to air out the space).


WORK DETAILS

GFL will:

- Clean the sanitary sewer main and conduct closed circuit television inspection (CCTV) on each pipe segment to be lined
- Install the sanitary sewer lining and apply heat to it so the material cures,
- Cutout service connections in the cured liner to restore sanitary sewer access into homes,
- Complete a final CCTV inspection,
- Complete repairs to any required maintenance hole structures.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

You may experience inconveniences such as, noise, odours, and short delays. The City will make efforts to reduce impacts, and your patience is appreciated.

	Road and Sidewalk Access: Pedestrian access will be maintained during construction. Roads will be open to traffic at all times, barring any unforeseen circumstances. Access for emergency vehicles will always be maintained.
	Driveway Access: Vehicle entry to properties within the construction limits will be available. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained.
	Accessibility: If you have any accessibility requirements, such as wheelchair access or home care, please contact the City representatives listed below.
	Traffic Management: The Contractor will use traffic control measures, such as traffic cones to steer through traffic around contractor equipment and vehicles, within the construction site. Flag persons will assist with traffic control, if required.
	Transit Service: The proposed construction will not affect Barrie Transit routes, and schedules.
	Parking: Parking on roadways in an active construction area is not permitted. Vehicles parked in the construction zone will be ticketed and towed.
	Garbage and Recycling: Garbage, recycling, and yard waste will be collected on the regular collection day during construction. GFL may need to move items to a designated area for pickup by the City's waste contractor. Garbage cans, organics bins, and recycling boxes will be returned to your property later the same day. Clearly mark your address on all containers. Ensure everything for pick up is curbside by 7:00 a.m. on the collection day or it may not be picked up.
	Safety: The Contractor is required to conduct work in a safe manner, such as using traffic cones and fencing off excavations. Please use extra caution in the construction zone to ensure everyone's safety.
