

**Notice of the Passing of By-law 2025-070, being a by-law of The Corporation of the City of Barrie to provide for the alteration of the ward boundaries for the City of Barrie commencing for the 2026 to 2030 term of Council.**

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie passed By-law 2025-070, being a By-law of The Corporation of the City of Barrie to provide for the alteration of the ward boundaries for the City of Barrie on the **18th day of June 2025**, pursuant to Section 222 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, as amended.

AND TAKE NOTICE that the Minister or any other person or agency may appeal to the Ontario Land Tribunal (OLT) by filing a notice of appeal with the City Clerk of The Corporation of the City of Barrie **NO LATER THAN 4:30 PM on Monday, August 4<sup>th</sup>, 2025**. The notice of appeal must set out the objections to the By-law and the reasons in support of the objections and must be accompanied by the \$1,100.00 fee prescribed under the *Ontario Land Tribunal Act, 2021*, in the form of a certified cheque or money order payable to the Minister of Finance.
