

Bayview Drive Improvements (Little Avenue to Big Bay Point Road)

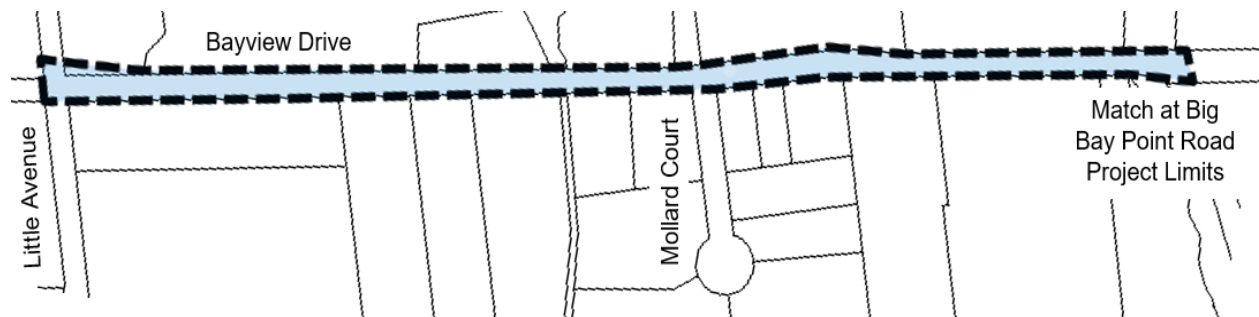
Ongoing Since: Summer 2024

The City of Barrie's (City) reconstruction of Bayview Drive, from Little Avenue to Big Bay Point Road, being performed by Primrose Contracting Inc. (Primrose) is actively progressing. To date, subsurface work including watermain installation, new storm sewer, and crossing culverts has been completed, and sidewalk installation is also progressing. With continued progress on the road work, Primrose has put their plan in place for the upcoming asphalt paving of the southbound (west) lane.

MAP OF THE WORK AREA







WORK DETAILS

The workplan is as follows:

- Friday, July 4 (evening): Prepare for paving operations
- Saturday, July 5 (full day): Asphalt road installation on the southbound lane
- Sunday, July 6: Southbound one-way traffic reconfigured to the newly installed asphalt
- In the case of a significant weather event, the paving schedule will be moved to the following weekend (July 11-13)
- One-way southbound traffic will continue in the short-term on the southbound (west) lane until the lane can be safely opened to allow two-way traffic.

WHAT TO EXPECT

	<p>Road and Sidewalk Access: Pedestrian access will be maintained during paving.</p>
	<p>Driveway Access: Vehicle entry to properties within the construction limits will be available. At times, direct access to driveways and parking lots will be interrupted to facilitate the paving while maintaining worker and public safety.</p>
	<p>Accessibility: If you have any accessibility requirements, such as wheelchair access, please contact the City representatives listed below.</p>

	<p>Traffic Management:</p> <p>The Contractor will use traffic control measures, such as traffic cones, to steer through traffic around contractor equipment and vehicles within the construction site. Flag persons will assist with traffic control, if required.</p>
	<p>Transit Service:</p> <p>Changes to Barrie Transit routes and schedules in the construction area will continue to be posted.</p>
	<p>Parking:</p> <p>Parking on roadways in an active construction area is not permitted. Vehicles parked in the construction area will be ticketed and towed.</p>
	<p>Safety:</p> <p>The contractors are required to conduct work in a safe manner. Please use extra caution in the construction zone to ensure everyone's safety.</p>

The City would like to thank all residents and business owners for their support and cooperation throughout this project. The City recognizes the impact this work may have on your daily routines and appreciates your understanding and patience throughout the project.
