

### MARY STREET ROAD MAINTENANCE

**START/END DATE: SEPTEMBER 2025**

**APPROXIMATE DURATION: 5 DAYS**

*Timeline is subject to change.*

The City of Barrie (City) will be repairing an approximately 200-metre stretch of Mary Street (extending from approximately 60 – 94 Mary Street). This work will be carried out by Kon-Strutt Construction.

This work is part of City Council's approved 2025 operating budget and aligns with the goal from Council's strategic priorities to fix roads that need attention throughout the City.

### WORK DETAILS









Kon-Strutt Construction will:

- Remove old road asphalt and pave new asphalt,
- Reinstate line painting for roadside parking.

### WHAT TO EXPECT DURING THE WORK

You may experience inconveniences such as, dust, noise, and short delays. The City will make efforts to reduce impacts, and your patience is appreciated.

All **local businesses remain open and accessible** throughout the duration of the work.

	<p><b>Road and Sidewalk Access:</b></p> <p>Pedestrian access will be maintained during the work.</p> <p>The Contractor will close active construction areas to through traffic with access to residences being maintained.</p> <p>Access for emergency vehicles will always be maintained.</p>
	<p><b>Driveway Access:</b></p> <p>Access to driveways will be accommodated while the work is being carried out.</p> <p><b>Services:</b></p> <p>Hydro, sanitary sewer services, water services, telephone, cable TV, and gas services should not be affected by the construction, barring any unforeseen circumstances.</p>
	<p><b>Accessibility:</b></p> <p>If you have any accessibility requirements, such as wheelchair access or home care, please contact the City representatives at Service Barrie (listed below).</p>
	<p><b>Traffic Management:</b></p> <p>The Contractor will use traffic control measures, such as traffic cones to steer through traffic around contractor equipment and vehicles, within the work site. Flag persons will assist with traffic control, if required.</p>
	<p><b>Transit Service:</b></p> <p>The proposed work will not affect Barrie Transit routes, and schedules.</p>
	<p><b>Parking:</b></p> <p>During the work, the roadside parking stalls will be out-of-order. Parking on roadways in an active construction area is not permitted. Vehicles parked in the work zone will be ticketed and towed.</p>
	<p><b>Garbage and Recycling:</b></p> <p>Garbage, recycling, and yard waste will be collected on the regular collection day. Kon-Strutt Construction may need to move items to a designated area for pickup by the City's waste contractor. Garbage cans, organics bins, and recycling boxes will be returned to your property later the same day. <b>Clearly mark your address on all containers.</b></p> <p>Ensure everything for pick up is curbside by <b>7:00 a.m. on the collection day or it may not be picked up.</b></p>
	<p><b>Safety:</b></p> <p>The Contractor is required to conduct work in a safe manner, such as using traffic cones. Please use extra caution in the work zone to ensure everyone's safety.</p>
