CUNDLES NEIGHBOURHOOD RESURFACING


START DATE: OCTOBER 14, 2025 END DATE: NOVEMBER 15, 2025

The City of Barrie (City) will be completing upgrades within Mapleton Park as part of the Cundles Neighbourhood Resurfacing Project and has awarded the contract to Lisbon Paving Co. Limited (Lisbon Paving).

This work is part of City Council's approved 2025 budget and aligns with the Council's strategic plan to update and improve City Infrastructure.

WORK DETAILS

Lisbon Paving's work includes:

- Removal of the existing asphalt pathway and interlocking brick;
- Installation of a new, widened asphalt pathway;
- Removal and localized repairs of the existing concrete playground curb; and
- Installation of new, concrete sidewalk ramps and tactile plates.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

You may experience inconveniences such as, dust, noise, and short delays. The City will make efforts to reduce impacts, and your patience is appreciated.

Road and Sidewalk Access:



Pedestrian access along local roads, adjacent to the park, will be maintained during construction.

Mapleton Park will be closed October 14, 2025, to November 15, 2025.

Local roads will be open to traffic at all times, barring any unforeseen circumstances.

Access for emergency vehicles will always be maintained.



Safety:

The Contractor is required to conduct work in a safe manner, such as using traffic cones and fencing off excavations. Please use extra caution around the construction zone to ensure everyone's safety.
