

NOTICE OF PASSING OF A HERITAGE DESIGNATION BY-LAW BY THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BARRIE PURSUANT TO SECTION 29 OF THE ONTARIO HERITAGE ACT, R.S.O. 1990, c. O.18

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the City of Barrie has passed **By-law Number 2025-098** on Wednesday, September 17, 2025 pursuant to the provision of *Section 29 of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990 c. O.18*.

THE PURPOSE AND EFFECT of By-law Number 2025-098 is to designate lands described as: PART LOT 26, S/S CUMBERLAND ST, ON PLAN 40, BEING PTS 2 AND 3 ON PLAN 51R-32166; S/T RIGHT-OF-WAY OVER PART 3 ON PLAN 51R-32166 IN FAVOUR OF PART LOT 26, S/S CUMBERLAND ST ON PLAN 40, AS IN RO1305360; CITY OF BARRIE, and municipally known as: 88 Cumberland Street, Barrie, as being of cultural heritage value or interest.

A copy of the By-law is available for viewing in the office of the City Clerk between 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. Monday to Friday.

IF YOU WISH TO APPEAL the By-law of the City of Barrie to the Ontario Land Tribunal (OLT), you may do so within thirty (30) days of the issuance of this notice by filing a Notice of Appeal via the OLT e-file at https://olt.gov.on.ca/e-file-service/ by selecting [*City of Barrie*] as the Approval Authority or by mail to the City Clerk – City of Barrie, no later than 4:30 p.m. on or before **Sunday, October 26, 2025**. The filing of an appeal after 4:30 p.m., in person or electronically, will be deemed to have been received the next business day. If the e-file portal is down, you can submit your appeal to: OLT.submissions@barrie.ca. Please consult the Ontario Land Tribunal's website (https://olt.gov.on.ca/) or call 1-866-448-2248 for further information regarding how to file an appeal.

WHO CAN FILE AN APPEAL

Pursuant to Section 29(11) of the *Ontario Heritage Act R.S.O. 1990, c. O.18*, a Notice of Appeal may be filed to the OLT by the following parties:

 Any persons who object to the designation by-law may appeal to the Ontario Land Tribunal.

The Notice of Appeal must:

- i) set out reasons for the objection to the designation by-law;
- ii) set out the reasons in support of the adoption
- iii) be accompanied by the fee of \$1,100.00 (or as otherwise prescribed by the OLT) per application, payable online though OLT e-file or by certified cheque or money order to the Minister of Finance, Province of Ontario.
