

**NOTICE OF PASSING OF A HERITAGE DESIGNATION BY-LAW
BY THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BARRIE
PURSUANT TO
SECTION 29 OF THE ONTARIO HERITAGE ACT, R.S.O. 1990, c. O.18**

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the City of Barrie has passed **By-law Number 2025-100** on Wednesday, September 17, 2025 pursuant to the provision of *Section 29 of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990 c. O.18*.

THE PURPOSE AND EFFECT of By-law Number 2025-100 is to designate lands described as: PART LOT 20, N/S ELIZABETH ST ON PLAN 27 (NOW DUNLOP ST) AS IN RO1396105; CITY OF BARRIE, and municipally known as: 250 Dunlop Street West, Barrie, as being of cultural heritage value or interest.

A copy of the By-law is available for viewing in the office of the City Clerk between 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. Monday to Friday.

IF YOU WISH TO APPEAL the By-law of the City of Barrie to the Ontario Land Tribunal (OLT), you may do so within thirty (30) days of the issuance of this notice by filing a Notice of Appeal via the OLT e-file at <https://olt.gov.on.ca/e-file-service/> by selecting [City of Barrie] as the Approval Authority or by mail to the City Clerk – City of Barrie, no later than 4:30 p.m. on or before **Sunday, October 26, 2025**. The filing of an appeal after 4:30 p.m., in person or electronically, will be deemed to have been received the next business day. If the e-file portal is down, you can submit your appeal to: OLT.submissions@barrie.ca. WHO CAN FILE AN APPEAL

Pursuant to Section 29(11) of the *Ontario Heritage Act R.S.O. 1990, c. O.18*, a Notice of Appeal may be filed to the OLT by the following parties:

- Any persons who object to the designation by-law may appeal to the Ontario Land Tribunal.

The Notice of Appeal must:

- i) set out reasons for the objection to the designation by-law;
- ii) set out the reasons in support of the adoption
- iii) be accompanied by the fee of \$1,100.00 (or as otherwise prescribed by the OLT) per application, payable online through OLT e-file or by certified cheque or money order to the Minister of Finance, Province of Ontario.
