

2026 PAVEMENT MANAGEMENT PROGRAM CONTRACT 1

START DATE: MAY 2026
END DATE: NOVEMBER 2026

**Timeline is subject to change.*

The City of Barrie (City) is undertaking its annual Pavement Management Program for the 2026 season, which includes road resurfacing and pavement defect repairs such as roadway cracking and rutting, and has awarded the contract to GIP Paving Incorporated (Contractor).

This work is part of City Council's approved 2026 budget and aligns with the Infrastructure Investments from their strategic direction.

WORK AREA

Contract 1 includes work on the following roadways:

- Bayfield Street, from Simcoe Street to Sophia Street
- Belcourt Avenue, from Davies Crescent to Davies Crescent
- Clapperton Street, from Dunlop Street East to Collier Street
- Collier Street, from Bayfield Street to Mulcaster Street
- Cundles Road East, from St Vincent Street to Bayfield Street
- Davies Crescent, from Duckworth Street to Grove Street East
- Livingstone Street West, from Bayfield Street to Sunnidale Road
- Milne Court, Livingstone Street West to End
- Ross Street, from Bayfield Street to Sophia Street

WORK DETAILS

GIP Paving Incorporated will:

- Remove and replace localized sections of concrete curbs and sidewalks, as required.
- Remove and replace the asphalt roadway.
- Complete localized driveway and boulevard restorations when impacted by the curb and sidewalk replacement works.

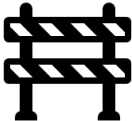
WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

You may experience inconveniences such as, dust, noise, and short delays. The City will make efforts to reduce impacts, and your patience is appreciated.

Further notice will be provided to property owners who are required to remove items such as decorative objects, located within City property limits (boulevard).

If you have a sprinkler system within the boulevard portion of your property, please contact the City representatives identified below. The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items on City property, including sprinkler system.

	The Contractor has retained the services of GPM Environmental to complete a precondition survey of the exterior of your home. Separate letters will be sent from GPM Environmental to book an appointment.
	Road and Sidewalk Access: Pedestrian access will be maintained during construction. The Contractor will intermittently close active construction areas to through traffic, with access to residences and businesses being maintained. The Contractor will post signage, as required, for detour routes. Bayfield Street, Clapperton Street and Collier Street will be closed for asphalt removal and replacement. This work will be completed between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 7:00 a.m. Access for emergency vehicles will always be maintained.

	Driveway Access: Vehicle entry to properties within the construction limits will be available. At times, direct access to driveways will be interrupted. Services: Hydro, sanitary sewer services, water services, telephone, cable TV, and gas services should not be affected by the construction, barring any unforeseen circumstances.
	Accessibility: If you have any accessibility requirements, such as wheelchair access or home care, please contact the City representatives listed below.
	Traffic Management: The Contractor will use traffic control measures, such as traffic cones to steer through traffic around contractor equipment and vehicles, within the construction site. Flag persons will assist with traffic control, if required.
	Transit Service: The proposed construction will affect Barrie Transit routes, and schedules. Changes to bus routes in the construction area will be posted in advance.
	Parking: Parking on roadways in an active construction area is not permitted. Vehicles parked in the construction zone will be ticketed and towed. Localized street parking closures will occur on Bayfield Street, Clapperton Street and Collier Street during the concrete curb and sidewalk work.
	Garbage and Recycling: Garbage, recycling, and yard waste will be collected on the regular collection day during construction. The Contractor may need to move items to a designated area for pickup by the City's waste contractor. Garbage cans, organics bins, and recycling boxes will be returned to your property later the same day. Clearly mark your address on all containers. Ensure everything for pick up is curbside by 7:00 a.m. (4:30 a.m. in the downtown BIA) on the collection day or it may not be picked up.
	Safety: The Contractor is required to conduct work in a safe manner, such as using traffic cones and fencing off excavations. Please use extra caution in the construction zone to ensure everyone's safety.
