**Re: Queens B Neighbourhood Reconstruction: Park St (Eccles St N to Toronto St), Parkside Dr (Ross St to Dunlop St W), High St (Park St to Dunlop St W), Florence St (Sophia St W to Park St), Sophia St W (Eccles St N to Parkside Dr), Eccles St N (Henry St to Park St) and Thomson St (Sophia St W to Wellington St W)**

The City of Barrie (the City) Infrastructure Department has initiated the detailed design for the Queens Park B Neighbourhood Reconstruction project which includes the above noted streets.

Per the project schedule below, the City will be completing several investigations and studies during detailed design to gather site conditions and background information for existing conditions to support the detailed design. These include:

- Topographical and legal surveys
- Geotechnical (soils) investigations
- Utility investigations
- Street lighting surveys
- Culvert/creek investigations

As part of these investigations, the City has retained several consultants to complete the work. You may see individuals on your street or in your neighborhood completing these investigations. All individuals will be wearing protective vests and will carry identification indicating whom they work for.

**Please note that this work will not require entrance into your residence unless contacted directly by a City of Barrie Project team member.**

**Project Features:**

- Road reconstruction
- Watermain and service replacement within the road right of way
- Sanitary sewer and lateral replacement within the road right of way
- Storm sewer replacement Sidewalk installation / replacement
- Culvert replacements

- Street lighting replacement

2030–2032	Construction

### **Will My Services Be Affected?**

Your sanitary sewer, water service, hydro, telephone, cable TV, and gas services should not be affected by the design investigations, barring any unforeseen circumstances.

### **Access to Properties**

Vehicle access to properties within the project limits will be provided at almost all times during the investigations.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the investigations.

### **Safety**

City Staff and Consultants are required to conduct work in a safe manner. We ask that you take extra caution during the investigations to ensure everyone's safety.
