

FERNDALE WATERMAIN REPAIR (Harvie Road to Tiffin Street)

START DATE: AUGUST 2026

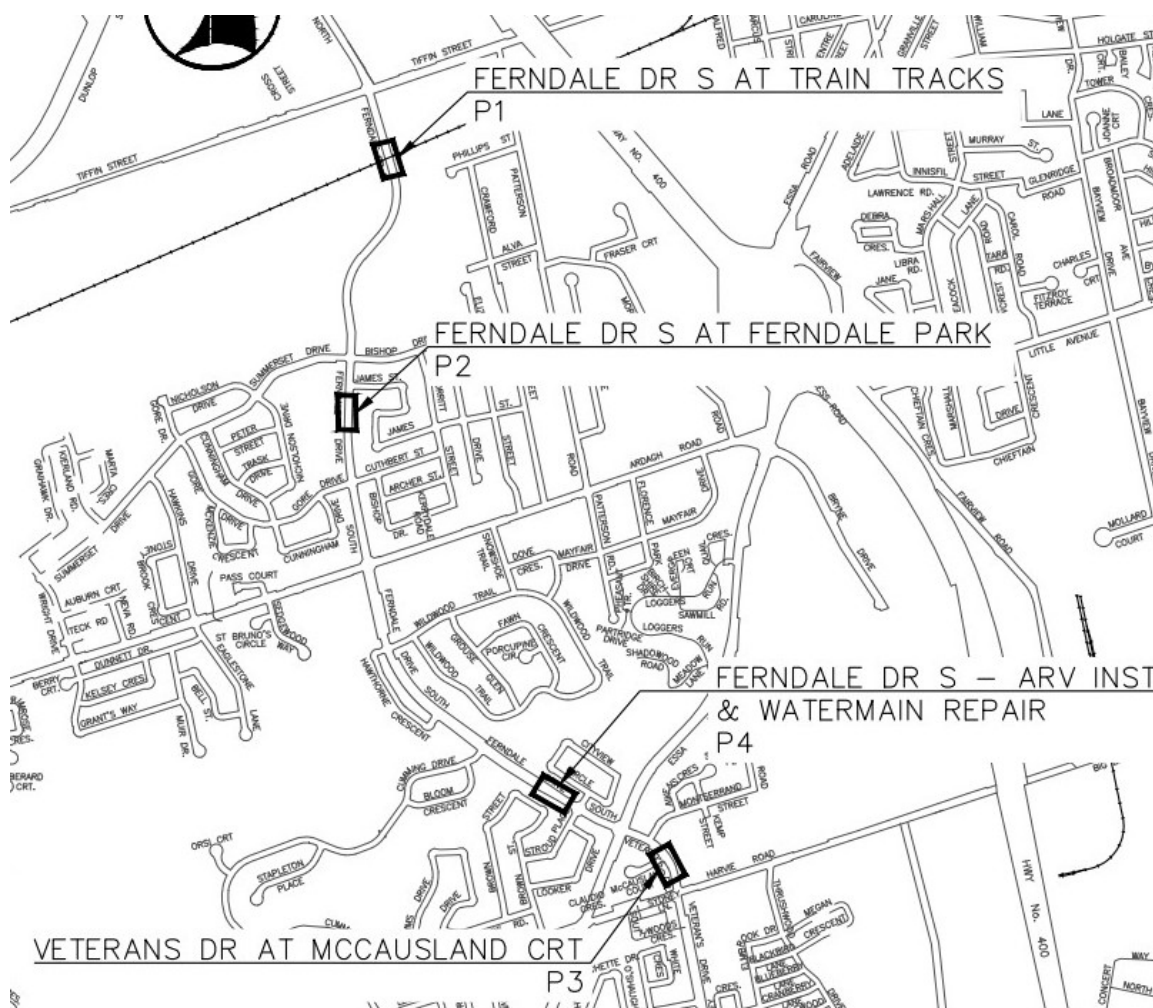
END DATE: NOVEMBER 2026

The City of Barrie (City) is repairing the leaks on an inactive watermain on Ferndale Drive and has awarded the contract to Orin Civil Inc. (Contractor). Work includes excavation and repair of the watermain at four (4) locations, installation of a watermain air release chamber and restoration of the curb, sidewalk, and road as necessary.

This work is part of City Council's approved 2026 budget and aligns with the Infrastructure Investments from their strategic direction.

WORK DETAILS

The Contractor will:

- Dig up the roadway;
- Excavate a trench;
- Install a watermain air release chamber;
- Replace watermain; and
- Restore roadway, sidewalk boulevards and curbs impacted by work.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

You may experience inconveniences such as dust, noise, and short delays. The City will make efforts to reduce impacts, and your patience is appreciated.

	Road and Sidewalk Access: Pedestrian access will be maintained during construction. Sidewalk closures will be in effect, and the Contractor will post signs to detour pedestrians around the work zone. Lane restrictions will be in place during construction. Two-way traffic will be maintained at all times. Access for emergency vehicles will always be maintained.
	Driveway Access: Vehicle entry to properties within the construction limits will be available. Services: Hydro, sanitary sewer services, water services, telephone, cable TV, and gas services should not be affected by the construction, barring any unforeseen circumstances.
	Accessibility: If you have any accessibility requirements, such as wheelchair access or home care, please contact the City representatives listed below.
	Traffic Management: The Contractor will use traffic control measures, such as traffic cones to steer through traffic around contractor equipment and vehicles, within the construction site. Flag persons will assist with traffic control, if required.
	Transit Service: The proposed construction will not affect Barrie Transit routes, and schedules.
	Parking: Parking on roadways in an active construction area is not permitted. Vehicles parked in the construction zone may be ticketed and towed.
	Waste Collection: Garbage, recycling, organics, and yard waste will be collected on your regular collection day during construction. The Contractor may need to move items to a designated area for pick-up by the waste collection contractor. Carts and recycling boxes will be returned to your property later the same day. Clearly mark your address on all containers and, ensure everything for pick-up is curbside by 7:00 a.m. on the collection day.
	Safety: The Contractor is required to conduct work in a safe manner, such as using traffic cones and fencing off excavations. Please use extra caution in the construction zone to ensure everyone's safety.
