Re: Public Information Meeting – Wellington D2 Neighbourhood Reconstruction

The City of Barrie ("City") Engineering Department is completing the detail design for the reconstruction of Wellington D2 Neighbourhood. This project will renew the life of the deteriorating roadway and underground infrastructure in the area as well as increase the water network capacity for the area for future growth of the city. This project will expand and upgrade the storm and sanitary sewer networks to meet City standards. The project area includes:

- Dundonald Street (Collier Street to Eugenia Street)
- Amelia Street (Dundonald Street to Duckworth Street)
- Duckworth Street (Amelia Street to Eugenia Street)

You are invited to attend an in-person Public Information Meeting (PIM) being held on:

Wednesday, August 26th, 2026, from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. at the Columbus Hall (93 Berczy Street, Barrie ON, L4M 3R2).

There will be no formal presentation at this meeting and residents are encouraged to attend anytime during the two (2) hour meeting period. A slide show is posted on the City website that provides information about the project.

For those that are unable to attend in person, the project information will be available on our website at www.Barrie.ca/Roadwork within the Road Design Projects tab under "Wellington D2 Neighbourhood Reconstruction Program". A slide show and comment sheets will be provided to obtain your input.

The PIM is intended to:

- Present the project scope, schedule, and details to the public for this reconstruction project
- Describe the proposed construction
- Provide an opportunity to ask questions to City representatives
- Provide input from members of the public on the detail design
- Discuss concerns regarding construction activities

Project Highlights:

- Road reconstruction
- Watermain replacement and upgrades
- Sanitary sewer replacement and upgrading to current City standards
- Sanitary lateral replacement to property line
- Storm sewer improvements including replacement and new installation
- Sidewalk improvements including replacement and new installation, and
- Streetlight upgrades

Project Schedule

Pending budget approval, the construction schedule is as follows:

- Utility Relocations: 2026-2027
- Construction: Spring 2027 through summer 2028
