

Queens Park A1 Neighborhood Reconstruction Program

RE-START DATE: SEPTEMBER 2026

END DATE: OCTOBER 2026

**Timeline is subject to change.*

The City of Barrie (City) is continuing work on the above noted project, with work being performed by Arnott Construction Limited (Contractor). Phase II was completed in September 2025, which included the reconstruction of Maple Avenue and Wellington Street West.

A concrete material deficiency related to the aggregate used in concrete installed in 2024 has resulted in premature deterioration in some locations; therefore, select sections of curb and sidewalk will be removed and replaced, with all associated costs borne by the Contractor.

WORK UPDATE

The Contractor will continue progress by:

- Paving surface asphalt on roadway
- Completing deficiency work, including repairs to deficient sidewalk and curb
- Restore driveways and boulevards impacted by work

WHAT TO EXPECT

You may continue to experience inconveniences such as, dust, noise, and short delays. The City will make efforts to reduce impacts, and your patience is appreciated.

Further notice will be provided to property owners who are required to remove items such as decorative objects, located within City property limits (boulevard).

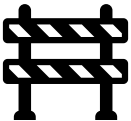
If you have a sprinkler system within the boulevard portion of your property, please contact the City representatives identified below. The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items on City property, including sprinkler systems.



Road and Sidewalk Access:

Pedestrian access will be maintained during construction.

Sections of Maple Avenue and Mary Street will be closed to through traffic for approximately four weeks starting on September 24, with access to residences being maintained. Residents may experience minor delays when travelling through the work zone.

	Sophia Street, including Ross Street and Sophia Street intersection, will remain open throughout the work. Intermittent lane shifts and closures will be required for approximately five weeks, beginning the week of September 21. Buses will be prioritized through the work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will always be maintained.
	Driveway Access: Vehicle entry to properties within the construction limits will be available. At times, direct access to driveways will be interrupted. Services: Hydro, sanitary sewer services, water services, telephone, cable TV, and gas services should not be affected by the construction, barring any unforeseen circumstances.
	Accessibility: If you have any accessibility requirements, such as wheelchair access or home care, please contact the City representatives listed below.
	Traffic Management: The Contractor will use traffic control measures, such as traffic cones to steer through traffic around contractor equipment and vehicles, within the construction site. Flag persons will assist with traffic control, if required.
	Transit Service: The proposed construction will not affect Barrie Transit routes, and schedules.
	Parking: Parking on roadways in an active construction area is not permitted. Vehicles parked in the construction zone will be ticketed and towed.
	Waste Collection Garbage, recycling, organics, and yard waste will be collected on your regular collection day during construction. The Contractor may need to move items to a designated area for pick-up by the waste collection contractor. Carts and recycling boxes will be returned to your property later the same day. Clearly mark your address on all containers and, ensure everything for pick-up is curbside by 7:00 a.m. on the collection day.
	Safety: The Contractor is required to conduct work in a safe manner, such as using traffic cones and fencing off excavations. Please use extra caution in the construction zone to ensure everyone's safety.

The City would like to thank all residents for their support and cooperation throughout this project. The City recognizes the impact this work may have on your daily routines and appreciates your understanding and patience throughout the project.
