

# Traffic Protection Plan Resources

The City of Barrie requires contractors to provide a Traffic Protection Plan to be granted a Right-of-Way Permit for many types of work.

The purpose of Traffic Protection Plans is to protect workers from traffic and provide safe routing for both vehicular and pedestrian traffic through or around the work site.

It is the Contractor's responsibility to familiarize themselves with applicable rules and regulations regarding Traffic Protection Plans. There are many paid services that will provide training for Ontario Traffic Manual (OTM) Book 7. There are also companies that will create Traffic Protection Plans for a fee.
