As part of my fire safety plan, I checked my alarms today and I found:

<input type="checkbox"/>	Carbon Monoxide Alarm is missing (Ontario Fire Code requires 1 alarm outside of sleeping areas on every storey where people are sleeping.)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Carbon Monoxide Alarm is older than 10 years and needs to be replaced.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Carbon Monoxide Alarm is not working.

As a tenant, Under the Ontario Fire Code, I am responsible to notify you that my alarm(s) is/are missing or not working. This is my official notification.
