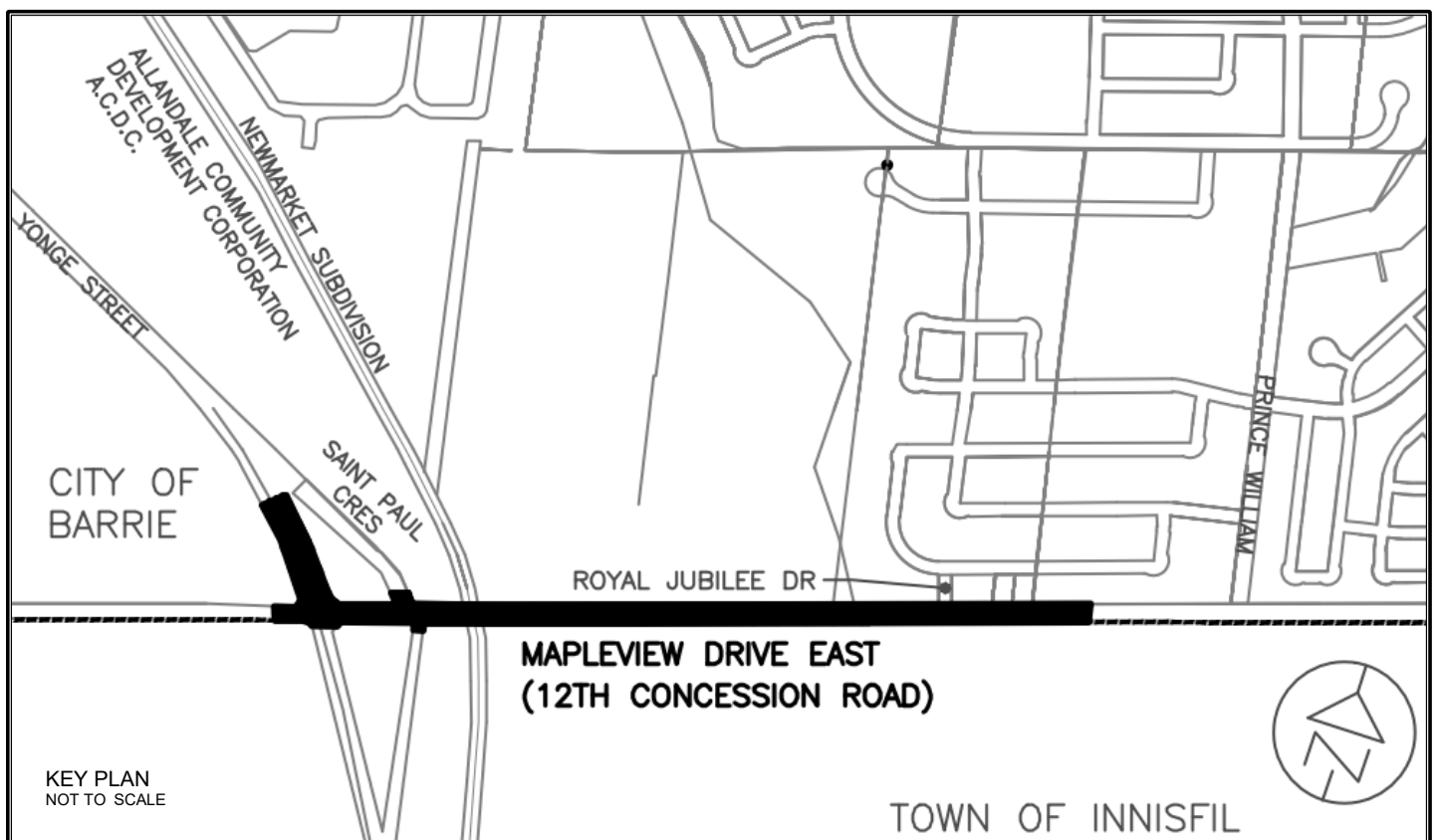
Barrie is completing a design project for infrastructure improvements that support growth and development in south-east Barrie.

This project will accommodate growth of the City's south-east end. The project limits were examined during the Class Environmental Assessment (EA) process completed in 2017. This project has advanced through the 90% design phase with **construction planned to start in Spring of 2024**.

The purpose of this Public Information Centre is to present an overview of the project to the residents directly affected or persons/groups/agencies that may be interested in the project. WORK DETAILS






The proposed infrastructure improvements include:

- Mapleview Drive East (approx. 1.2 km from Yonge Street to west of Prince William Way) expansion to four (4) lanes including raised median, a 3.0 m multi-use path on the north and south sides, and improved roadway illumination.
- Stormwater management improvements including new storm sewers, installation of Low Impact Development (LID) systems, and a stormwater management pond.
- Installation of a full traffic control signal at the future Kneeshaw Drive / Lilly Drive intersection and Intersection Pedestrian Signals (IPS) at Royal Jubilee Drive.
- Intersections at St Paul's Crescent and Royal Jubilee Drive to be right-in-right-out only.
- Enhanced at-grade rail signal crossing safety.

WHAT TO EXPECT

You may experience some noise and minor delays for short durations as the Consultants complete their work. Your patience is appreciated.

	<p>Road and Sidewalk Access: Pedestrian access will be maintained during these design investigations.</p> <p>During these investigations, some short delays (e.g. a few minutes) while driving through the area can be expected while people or equipment are maneuvering and completing the work etc. We ask for your patience in such instances.</p>
	<p>Driveway Access: Vehicle access to properties within the limits will be provided at all times.</p> <p>Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p> <p>Services: Your sanitary sewer, hydro, telephone, cable TV, and gas services should not be affected by the works, barring any unforeseen circumstances.</p>
	<p>Parking: There will be no impact to parking as part of these design investigations.</p>
	<p>Garbage and Recycling: There will be no impact to parking as part of these design investigations.</p>
	<p>Safety: The Consultants are required to conduct their work in a safe manner, including wearing personal protective equipment and visible safety vests. We ask that you take extra caution during these design investigations to ensure everyone's safety.</p>
