

TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENTS FOR YONGE STREET, HURONIA ROAD AND MCKAY ROAD EAST

Notice of Public Information Centre

The Corporation of the City of Barrie is undertaking the design of transportation improvements on Yonge Street (Mapleview Drive to Lockhart Road); Huronia Road (Lockhart Road to McKay Road East); and McKay Road East (Highway 400 to Huronia Road), as recommended in the City's Multi-Modal Active Transportation Master Plan (MMATMP).

The proposed design will include:

Yonge Street (Mapleview Drive to Lockhart Road)


- Widen to a four-lane cross-section;
- 4.2 m median (raised or painted depending on adjacent land use);
- 2 m bike lanes on both sides of the street;
- 2 m sidewalks on both sides of the street;
- · Local watermain services; and
- Low Impact Development (LID) stormwater management strategy, where possible.

Huronia Road (Lockhart Road to McKay Road East)

- A multi-modal corridor with two vehicular travel lanes and a centre lane ranging from 1.2 m to 4.2 m in width:
- 1.5 m bike lanes with 0.5 m buffer on both sides of the street:
- 2 m sidewalks on both sides of the street;
- 2.9 m boulevards on both sides of the street;
- Local watermain services:
- LID stormwater management strategy;
- Three major watercourse crossings; and
- New trunk sanitary sewer.

McKay Road East (Highway 400 to Huronia Road)

- Widen to a four-lane cross section;
- 1.2 m to 4.2 m centre lane;
- 1.5 m bike lanes with 0.5 m buffer on both sides of the street;
- 2 m sidewalks on both sides of the street;
- 2.9 m boulevards on both sides of the street;
- Local watermain services;
- LID stormwater management strategy, where possible; and
- New trunk sanitary sewer.
