Dear Mr. Finlayson:

This office has reviewed the above-mentioned report, which has been submitted to this ministry as a condition of licensing in accordance with Part VI of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990, c 0.18. This review has been carried out in order to determine whether the licensed professional consultant archaeologist has met the terms and conditions of their licence, that the licensee assessed the property and documented archaeological resources using a process that accords with the 1993 Archaeological Assessment Technical Guidelines set by the ministry, and that the archaeological fieldwork and report recommendations are consistent with the conservation, protection and preservation of the cultural heritage of Ontario.

The report documents the Stage 1-2 assessment of the study area as depicted in Figures 2 and 7 of the above titled report and recommends the following:

2.4 Stage 2 Recommendations

Recommendations are as follows:

Land that was not available and subject to archaeological assessment requires assessment when the property becomes available. Since no field level assessment has been conducted of the large tracks of land still unassessed the methods to employ these areas cannot be fully detailed. It is recommended that any further work undertaken in these areas follow the relevant survey methodologies as required and expected by the S&Gs. It is assumed that the survey work would entail 5m pedestrian survey and 5m test pit survey. Land that has been assessed and had no archaeological resources does not require further archaeological work.

Scatter 2A (BbGw-84)

This Scatter hold no further Cultural Heritage Value or Interest; no further archaeological work is recommended

Parcel 2 Findspot (BbGw-82)

This Scatter hold no further Cultural Heritage Value or Interest; no further archaeological work is recommended

Scatter 2G (BbGw-83)

This Scatter hold no further Cultural Heritage Value or Interest; no further archaeological work is recommended

Findspot Parcel 14A – (BbGw-83)

This Findspot hold no further Cultural Heritage Value or Interest; no further archaeological work is recommended

Parcel 2V - Historic 2V Site (BbGw-81)

This site has been sufficiently documented and does not hold further Cultural Heritage Value or Interest. No further archaeological work is recommended.

Parcel 2W - Parcel 2W site (BbGw-36).

Stage 3 unit excavation and in depth historical research is recommended in order to increase the artifact assemblage and to confirm the site date and purpose. As such, this site may contain further Cultural Heritage Value or Interest.

Parcel 3A - Wormwood Site (BbGw-32)

This site is recommended for Stage 3 CSP to collect all of the artifacts to have a larger artifact assemblage. This site may contain further Cultural Heritage Value or Interest. Stage 3 CSP is recommended.

Parcel 4 – Part 4C - Historic 4C site (BbGw-80)

This site is recommended for Stage 3 CSP to collect all of the artifacts to have a larger artifact assemblage. This site may contain further Cultural Heritage Value or Interest. Stage 3 CSP is recommended.

Parcel 4 - Part 4F (not bordenized)

This scatter has been sufficiently documented and does not hold further Cultural Heritage Value or Interest. No further archaeological work is recommended.

Historic Parcel 8 Site (BbGw-79)

This site has been sufficiently documented and does not hold further Cultural Heritage Value or Interest. No further archaeological work is recommended.

Parcel 12 - The Selbye Site (BbGw-35)

This site is recommended for Stage 3 controlled surface pick-up (CSP) (completed during Stage 2 assessment). As such, this site may contain further Cultural Heritage Value or Interest.

Findspot Parcel 14A – (BbGw-83)

This site has been has been sufficiently documented. It does not hold further Cultural Heritage Value or Interest. No further archaeological work is recommended.

Parcel 14B - Kloosterman 1 Site (BbGw-37)

This site is recommended for Stage 3 controlled surface pick-up (CSP) (completed during Stage 2 assessment). The site has Cultural Heritage Value and Interest and Stage 3 unit excavation and indepth archival research is recommended.

Parcel 14B - Kloosterman 2 Site (BbGw-38)

This site is recommended for Stage 3 controlled surface pick-up (CSP) (completed during Stage 2 assessment).. The site has Cultural Heritage Value and Interest and Stage 3 unit excavation and indepth archival research is recommended.

Parcel 16 Scatter (Not Bordenized)

This scatter has been sufficiently documented and does not hold further Cultural Heritage Value or Interest. No further archaeological work is recommended.

3.2 Stage 3: Recommendations

Recommendations are as follows:

Wormwood Site (BbGw-32)

o Further Stage 3 test units are recommended to cover the site extent; and in depth archival research is warranted. This will further help to determine the Cultural Heritage Value or Interest of the site and be used to make appropriate Stage 4 recommendations.

Kloosterman Site 1 (BbGw-37)

o Stage 3 test unit excavation is recommended for the site; and indepth archival research is warranted. This will further help to determine the Cultural Heritage Value or Interest of the site and be used to make appropriate Stage 4 recommendations.

Kloosterman Site 2 (BbGw-38)

o Stage 3 test unit excavation is recommended for the site; and indepth archival research is warranted. This will further help to determine the Cultural Heritage Value or Interest of the site and be used to make appropriate Stage 4 recommendations.

Selbye Site (BbGw-35)

o Stage 3 test unit excavation is recommended for the site; and in depth archival research is warranted. This will further help to determine the Cultural Heritage Value or Interest of the site and be used to make appropriate Stage 4 recommendations.

Parcel 2W - Parcel 2W site (BbGw-36).

o This scatter has been sufficiently documented and does not hold further Cultural Heritage Value or Interest. No further archaeological work is recommended.

Parcel 4 – Part 4C - Historic 4C site (BbGw-80)

o This site has been sufficiently documented and does not hold further Cultural Heritage Value or Interest. No further archaeological work is recommended.

Executive Summary

Watersand Construction Ltd. and Wormwood Development Inc. are planning to develop approximately 1,877 acres in the Town of Innisfil, Ontario. A Stage 1-2 assessment of the property was required.

The Stage 1 background assessment indicated high potential for Euro-Canadian and or Aboriginal archaeological sites using the Ministry 1993 Technical Guidelines. As such Stage 2 was recommended for the entire property excluding areas of No/Low potential such as streams, ponds, railway tracks.

Stage 2 assessments commenced in 2007 and continued into 2008 and 2009. To date, 1,465 acres of agricultural land and 53 acres of fallow land, most of which represented demolished or abandoned farmsteads have been assessed.

During the Stage 2 assessments, a total of 14 archaeological resource locations were found, and presented as a mixture of findspots, scatters, historic sites and deposits. Of these 14 resources, 8 were found to hold no further Cultural Heritage Value or Interest after being subject to survey intensification and artifact analysis. The remaining 8 archaeological resource were subject to Stage 3 assessment (either CSP and/or unit excavation).

Aboriginal finds:

- o Parcel 2 Findspot (1 Projectile Point and piece of chert) - BbGw-82;
- o Parcel 14B Findspot (1 Projectile Point) - BbGw-83;
- o Parcel 2A Scatter (2 pieces of chert) - BbGw-84;
- o Parcel 2G Scatter (3 pieces of fragmentary chert till) - BbGw-85

Euro-Canadian deposits:

- o Historic Parcel 2V Site (artifacts background noise to 20th century house demolition) - BbGw-81;
- o Parcel 4F deposit (12 artifacts- refuse from derelict house) - location not bordenized;
- o Historic Parcel 8B Site (lack of early diagnostic artifacts and continuous occupation from late 19th century to 20th century) - BbGw-79;
- o Parcel 16 deposit (lack of pre-19th century artifacts) – location not bordenized.

Of the six remaining finds identified during the Stage 2 assessment and either subjected to Stage 3 CSP immediately, or Stage 2 test pit assessment and Stage 3 unit excavation; four sites were interpreted to be mid to late 19th century Euro-Canadian finds holding Cultural Heritage Value or Interest, therefore requiring further assessment. A summary is as follows:

- o Historic 2W site (subject to Stage 2 Test Pit assessment and Stage 3 unit excavation) - BbGw-36;
- o Wormwood Site (subject to Stage 3 CSP and Stage 3 unit excavation) - BbGw-32;
- o Historic 4C Site (subject to Stage 3 CSP) - BbGw-80;

- o Selbye Site (subject to Stage 3 CSP) – BbGw-35;

- o Kloosterman 2 Site (subject to Stage 3 CSP) – BbGw-38.

Of those sites subject to Stage 3 assessment to obtain a larger sample of artifacts in order to determine the Cultural Heritage Value or Interest, four sites were found to require further assessment and documentation as they were interpreted to represent mid to late 19th century sites. The other sites were found to have been sufficiently documented requiring no further archaeological work. The sites holding further CHVI, and recommended for further assessment are as follows:

- o Wormwood Site - BbGw-32;
- o Selbye Site – BbGw-35;
- o Kloosterman 1 Site – BbGw-37;
- o Kloosterman 2 Site – BbGw-38.

Recommendations upon the conclusion of the assessment are detailed in the recommendation section of the report; and are summarized below:

- o Land that was not available and subject to archaeological assessment requires assessment when the property becomes available.
- o Land that has been assessed and had no archaeological resources does not require further archaeological work.
- o **Wormwood Site (BbGw-32)** - Further Stage 3 test units are recommended to cover the site extent; and indepth archival research is warranted.
- o **Kloosterman Site 1 (BbGw-37)**- Stage 3 test unit excavation is recommended for the site; and indepth archival research is warranted.
- o **Kloosterman Site 2 (BbGw-38)** - Stage 3 test unit excavation is recommended for the site; and indepth archival research is warranted.
- o **Selbye Site (BbGw-35)** - Stage 3 test unit excavation is recommended for the site; and indepth archival research is warranted.

It is recommended that this report be entered into the Ontario Public Register of Archaeological Reports and a letter of confirmation be issued by the Ministry of Tourism, Culture and Sport supporting these recommendations.

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1.0 Introduction and Background Research

This Land Archaeology Inc. was contracted by Watersand Construction Ltd. and Wormwood Developments Inc. to undertake Stage 1 to 3 archaeological assessments of their lands which comprise approximately 2196 acres in the Town of Innisfil, Simcoe County, Ontario (Figure 1, 2).

This assessment was required due to the proposed development of the property for industrial/commercial purposes. The contract was awarded on January 31, 2007. Background research was initiated in late March 2007 and field work was initiated on April 16, 2007 and continued intermittently in 2008 and 2009. More work will be undertaken in 2010 to complete the investigations. That work will be the subject of a separate report. Laboratory processing of the artifacts and field data was begun on April 17, 2007 and has continued as needed. Subsequently this report was prepared.

The properties are located on Concessions 8 and 9, north and south of the 9th Line and west of Highway 400. Most of these properties are currently farmed.

Archaeological assessments may involve four stages:

Stage 1 collects information on the known heritage resources of the property as well as information of the environment;

Stage 2 is field examination of the property and involves walking ploughed or planted fields or test pitting bush lots or areas in bush or lands where the ground surface cannot be examined to recover artifacts indicative of a past occupation of the land;

Stage 3 involves an examination of sites discovered in Stage 2 to determine their size, extent and significance;

Stage 4 involves mitigation of significant sites either by preservation or excavation.

Background research involved a review of the Simcoe County Historical Atlas (1878), the acquisition of known site data from Mr. Robert von Bitter of the Ontario Ministry of Culture and collection of basic information of the environment.

The Simcoe County Historical Atlas provides no information on the ownership of some of the parcels of land. The relevant section of the map is presented in Figure 3.

Data on known sites within two km of the study area are presented in Table 1.

The Stage 1 background assessment indicated high potential for Euro-Canadian and or Aboriginal archaeological sites using the Ministry 1993 Technical Guidelines.

Archaeological potential is shown in Figure 5, overall potential indicators include:

- o 5 known sites within 2 km of the Study Area;
- o The proximity to historic roads, County Road 27, County Road 53 and Innisfil Beach Road;
- o Watercourses traversing the property;
- o The identification of several circa 1928 Houses within the Study Area;

- o The location of two homesteads within the Study Area on the Simcoe County 1881 Historical Atlas Map;
- o And the location of the Hamilton and North West Railway across the southern portion of the property.

As such, Stage 2 assessment is recommended for the entire property excluding areas of low/no potential which include ponds, streams, railway tracks as illustrated on Figure 5A; and farmsteads/outbuildings as shown in Plates 14 to 17, locations shown on Figure 5A.

Surficial geology is presented in Figure 3. Most of the properties are comprised of poorly sorted materials or gravel with sand in some of the creek valleys.

2.0 Stage: Methods

This report documents the Stage 2 assessment of the entire study area, 4.37 hectares of land, as recommended at the conclusion of the Stage 1 assessment.

2.1 Stage 2: Field Methods

When work began in April 2007, all tenant farmers were contacted by the author and arrangements made to access the land (Figure 6). Further arrangements were made with all tenant farmers for the author to either be contacted by them when lands had been recently cultivated or crops newly planted. However, in most instances, lands were custom ploughed and disked to facilitate the assessment. As a result, survey conditions were always appropriate for conducting archaeological assessments.

Visual surveys of lands were always conducted with 5 m spacing between crew members. When a Euro-Canadian artifact was found, the area in the immediate vicinity was examined more closely for additional artifacts. For Native artifacts, a formal search pattern, 10 m from the find was executed and recorded using D- GPS. All artifact locations were recorded with a GeoXT D-GPS unit which is accurate to less than one metre (Figure 7).

During the Stage 2 visual survey, with the exception of collected isolated findspots, artifact scatters were immediately subjected to a Stage 3 CSP which is described in the Stage 3 section of this report.

Stage 2 test pit assessment involved digging test pits into the yellow subsoil. Test pits were about 30 cm in diameter and ranged from 20 to 30 cm in depth. Soil from test pits was screened through 6 mm mesh to recover artifacts. All test pits were backfilled. When a test pit produced significant artifacts, additional test pits were excavated in the four cardinal directions at a 1 m distance from the positive test pit. This process was continued until no further artifacts were found.

Weather varied from cool to cold to warm to hot, with clear, cloudy or overcast skies. No work was done in medium to heavy rains or when snow was partially covering the ground.

Data on the areas assessed are summarized in Table 2.

2.2 Stage 2: Archaeological Findings

The Stage 2 archaeological assessment resulted in the discovery of the following archaeological resources, summarized below with notation as to their Cultural Heritage Value or Interest (CHVI). (Results of the overall assessment are presented in Figure 7).

Archaeological Resources within Parcel 2:

The visual survey of Parcel 2A and 2G resulted in the recovery of 7 Aboriginal artifacts from three findspots (Figure 8, Plate 1). Survey intensification at 1 m intervals, 20 m from each of the finds did not result in the recovery of any further artifacts. These finds are as follows:

Scatter 2A (BbGw-84)

Listed below as Findspot 1 – was comprised of two pieces of Onondaga chert, with no diagnostic characteristics.

Parcel 2 Findspot (BbGw-82)

Listed below as Findspot 2, was an Onondaga chert Crawford Knoll point fragment. The find is interpreted to be a hunting loss, dating from 2500 to 1000 BC. Also in this location was a piece of an Onondaga chert fragment which had been modified into a knife.

Scatter 2G (BbGw-85)

Listed below as Findspot 3 was comprised of three fragmentary pieces of natural Onondaga chert till.

Note, on Parcel 14, Chert Projectile Point was found and is summarized below.

Artifact details are presented as follows:

- o Table 1 - summary of artifacts recovered;

Historic Parcel 2V site (BbGw-81).

Parcel 2V – a test pit assessment was conducted in the vicinity of a demolished homestead. The test pit assessment, included test pit intensification around positive finds. A total of 335 artifacts were found. Analysis of these artifacts indicated the absence of Refined White Earthenwares and the relatively large numbers of Vitrified White Earthenwares suggest a deposit from the late 19th century that continued into the 20th century until the farm house was demolished. Because of the mix of late 19th century to 20th century finds, this site is interpreted to be background noise attributed to the demolition of the 20th century home. This site was registered and named Historic 2V site (BbGw-81). Artifact details are presented as follows:

Parcel 2W site (BbGw-36).

Parcel 2W – a test pit assessment was conducted behind a demolished homestead. The test pit assessment, included test pit intensification around positive finds. A total of 123 artifacts were recovered. Analysis of these artifacts indicated a prevalence of Vitrified White Earthenware, these ceramic finds in tandem with a relatively large numbers of bottle fragments suggested a late 19th date for this deposit. Artifact details are presented as follows:

Archaeological Resources within Parcel 3:

Wormwood Site (BbGw-36)

During the visual survey of the northwest part of Parcel 3, a large scatter of early to middle 19th century artifacts was found. No artifacts were collected as part of the Stage 2 assessment. Given that ideal field conditions were present, the scatter was immediately subjected to a Stage 3 controlled surface pick-up (CSP); (Figure 9). The method of the CSP and results are discussed in the Stage 3 section of this report.

Archaeological Resources within Parcel 4:

Historic 4C site (BbGw-80)

The stage 2 visual survey identified a scatter of what appeared to be 19th century artifacts on Parcel 4C. Given the size of the scatter, the field director believed it prudent to conduct a Stage 3 CSP in order to determine the Cultural Heritage Value of the Site. As such, please see the Stage 3 section of this report.

Parcel 4F (Not Bordenized)

A test pit assessment was conducted behind a derelict house. The test pit assessment, included test pit intensification around positive finds. Only 12 artifacts were found.

The small size of the deposit in tandem with the presence of only Vitrified White Earthenware and a single common wire nail suggests a late 19th or 20th century deposit; the assemblage likely represents a singular act of discard related to the occupation of the extant derelict house. Due to the lack of pre 19th century artifacts, this small scatter was not registered with the Ministry or given a Borden Number. Artifact details are presented as follows:

Archaeological Resources within Parcel 8:

Historic Parcel 8B Site (BbGw-79)

A test pit assessment behind a demolished house on Parcel 8 resulted in the recovery of a collection of 157 late 19th century artifacts. The test pit assessment, included test pit intensification around positive finds. Only one piece of Refined White Earthenware (RWE) was found; the bulk of the ceramics were comprised of Vitrified White Earthenware (56 pieces); these findings along with a fragment of chimney glass from a coal oil lantern suggests a late 19th century deposit. The lack of greater quantities of RWE, and the fact that the farmhouse had been continuously occupied from the late 19th century to the late 20th century, supports the artifact dating. This site was

registered and named Historic Parcel 8B Site (BbGw-79). Artifact details are presented as follows:

Archaeological Resources within Parcel 12:

The Selbye Site (BbGw-35)

During the visual survey of parcel 12D, a scatter (137 pieces) of early to middle 19th Euro-Canadian artifacts was found. No artifacts were collected as part of the Stage 2 assessment. The scatter was immediately subjected to a Stage 3 controlled surface pick-up (CSP). The method of the CSP and results are discussed in the Stage 3 section of this report.

Archaeological Resources within Parcel 14:

Findspot Parcel 14A – (BbGw-83)

Visual survey of Parcel 14A resulted in the discovery of a chert Genesee projectile point which had been modified into a knife (Table 3, Plate 1). An intensified survey at 1 m intervals, 20 m around the find did not result in any other finds. This findspot was registered and named Findspot Parcel 14A (BbGw-83).

Archaeological Resources within Parcel 14B:

Kloosterman 1 Site (BbGw-37) and Kloosterman 2 Site (BbGw-37)

Visual survey of Parcel 14B resulted in the discovery of two scatters of Euro-Canadian artifacts. No artifacts were collected as part of the Stage 2 assessment. The scatter was immediately subjected to a Stage 3 controlled surface pick-up (CSP). The method of the CSP and results are discussed in the Stage 3 section of this report. Both sites were registered and named Kloosterman 1 Site (BbGw-37) and Kloosterman 2 Site (BbGw-37).

Archaeological Resources within Parcel 16 (Not Bordenized):

Test pit assessment with intensification near the northwestern corner of a demolished farmstead resulted in the discovery of a small scatter, (59 artifacts) of Euro-Canadian

artifacts. The absence of Refined White Earthenware suggests a deposit which dates to the late 19th century possibly into the 20th century. Due to the lack of pre 19th century artifacts, this deposit was not registered with the Ministry or given a Borden Number. Artifact details are presented as follows:

2.3 Stage 2: Analysis and Conclusions with Historical Context

Aboriginal findspots on Parcel 2A, 2G and Parcel 14A

BbGw-82 (**Parcel 2 Findspot**-Projectile Point and piece of chert); BbGw-83 (**Parcel 14** – Projectile Point); and **Parcel 2A Scatter** (2 pieces of chert) and **Parcel 2G** (3 Pieces of chert).

As the finds (including the projectile points) were fragmentary, and an intensified visual survey did not result in the recovery of additional artifacts; none of the aboriginal findspots have further Cultural Heritage Value or Interest and have been sufficiently documented.

Parcel 2V - Historic 2V Site (BbGw-81)

Analysis of these artifacts indicated the absence of Refined White Earthenwares and the relatively large numbers of Vitrified White Earthenwares suggest a deposit from the late 19th century that continued into the 20th century until the farm house was demolished. The paucity of artifacts clearly relating to an early 19th century occupation (Hand Made Nails (2) and Thin Window Glass (14)) did not appear to be spatially related in a fashion suggestive of discrete earlier occupation or activity area. Because of the mix of late 19th century to 20th century finds, this site is interpreted to be background noise attributed to the demolition of the 20th century home.

This site has been sufficiently documented and does not hold further Cultural Heritage Value or Interest.

Parcel 2W - Parcel 2W site (BbGw-36).

A total of 123 artifacts were recovered. Analysis of these artifacts indicated a prevalence of Vitrified White Earthenware, these ceramic finds in tandem with a relatively large numbers of bottle fragments suggested a late 19th date for this deposit.

However, given that this site was found via test pitting and is situated within an area surrounded by planted trees, it may represent a distinct site occupation. This site retains further Cultural Heritage Value or Interest.

Parcel 3A - Wormwood Site (BbGw-32)

In the northwest portion of Parcel 3, a large scatter of early to middle 19th century artifacts was found. Upon scatter review, the field director made the decision to subject the scatter to Stage 3 controlled surface pick-up.

This site contains further Cultural Heritage Value or Interest.

Parcel 4 – Part 4C - Historic 4C site (BbGw-80)

The visual survey identified a scatter of artifacts. Given the scatter of artifacts, in order to be prudent, the field director made the decision to immediately subject the scatter to a Stage 3 controlled surface pick-up (CSP).

This site may contain further Cultural Heritage Value or Interest.

Parcel 4 - Part 4F

Upon analysis, the small artifact assemblage was interpreted to represent an ephemeral deposit related to the historic occupation of the derelict home. This scatter has been sufficiently documented and does not hold further Cultural Heritage Value or Interest.

Historic Parcel 8 Site (BbGw-79)

The assemblage was comprised of predominantly Vitrified White Earthenware with a coal oil lantern piece of chimney glass. The site was located behind a demolished house which had been continuously occupied from the late 19th century to the late 20th century. As such, the artifacts were interpreted to represent background noise from the continuous occupation.

This site has been sufficiently documented and does not hold further Cultural Heritage Value or Interest.

Parcel 12 - The Selbye Site (BbGw-35)

Upon review of the scatter in the field, and the identification of some pieces of Pearlware, the field director made the decision to immediately subject the scatter to a Stage 3 controlled surface pick-up (CSP).

This site contains further Cultural Heritage Value or Interest.

Findspot Parcel 14A – (BbGw-83)

Described above; as this find was isolated and fragmentary in nature, it does not hold further Cultural Heritage Value or Interest and has been sufficiently documented.

Parcel 14B - Kloosterman 1 Site (BbGw-37)

Upon review of the scatter in the field, and the identification of many pieces of Refined White Earthenware, the field director made the decision to immediately subject the scatter to a Stage 3 controlled surface pick-up (CSP).

This site contains further Cultural Heritage Value or Interest.

Parcel 14B - Kloosterman 2 Site (BbGw-38)

Upon review of the scatter in the field, and the identification of some pieces of Pearlware, the field director made the decision to immediately subject the scatter to a Stage 3 controlled surface pick-up (CSP).

This site contains further Cultural Heritage Value or Interest.

Parcel 16 Scatter

Analysis of artifacts recovered near a demolished farmstead identified a lack of pre 19th century artifacts representing a late 19th century to 20th century deposit. The deposit consisted of examples of thick window glass and a machine cut nail with other examples of porcelain. This scatter was interpreted to represent background noise from the recently demolished farmstead and not a discrete 19th century site.

This scatter has been sufficiently documented and does not hold further Cultural Heritage Value or Interest.

2.4 Stage 2 Recommendations

Recommendations are as follows:

Land that was not available and subject to archaeological assessment requires assessment when the property becomes available. Since no field level assessment has been conducted of the large tracks of land still unassessed the methods to employ these areas cannot be fully detailed. It is recommended that any further work undertaken in these areas follow the relevant survey methodologies as required and expected by the S&G's. It is assumed that the survey work would entail 5m pedestrian survey and 5m test pit survey.

Land that has been assessed and had no archaeological resources does not require further archaeological work.

Scatter 2A (BbGw-84)

This Scatter hold no further Cultural Heritage Value or Interest; no further archaeological work is recommended

Parcel 2 Findspot (BbGw-82)

This Scatter hold no further Cultural Heritage Value or Interest; no further archaeological work is recommended

Scatter 2G (BbGw-83)

This Scatter hold no further Cultural Heritage Value or Interest; no further archaeological work is recommended

Findspot Parcel 14A – (BbGw-83)

This Findspot hold no further Cultural Heritage Value or Interest; no further archaeological work is recommended

Parcel 2V - Historic 2V Site (BbGw-81)

This site has been sufficiently documented and does not hold further Cultural Heritage Value or Interest. No further archaeological work is recommended.

Parcel 2W - Parcel 2W site (BbGw-36).

Stage 3 unit excavation and indepth historical research is recommended in order to increase the artifact assemblage and to confirm the site date and purpose. As such, this site may contain further Cultural Heritage Value or Interest.

Parcel 3A - Wormwood Site (BbGw-32)

This site is recommended for Stage 3 CSP to collect all of the artifacts to have a larger artifact assemblage. This site may contain further Cultural Heritage Value or Interest. Stage 3 CSP is recommended.

Parcel 4 – Part 4C - Historic 4C site (BbGw-80)

This site is recommended for Stage 3 CSP to collect all of the artifacts to have a larger artifact assemblage. This site may contain further Cultural Heritage Value or Interest. Stage 3 CSP is recommended.

Parcel 4 - Part 4F (not bordenized)

This scatter has been sufficiently documented and does not hold further Cultural Heritage Value or Interest. No further archaeological work is recommended.

Historic Parcel 8 Site (BbGw-79)

This site has been sufficiently documented and does not hold further Cultural Heritage Value or Interest. No further archaeological work is recommended.

Parcel 12 - The Selbye Site (BbGw-35)

This site is recommended for Stage 3 controlled surface pick-up (CSP) (completed during Stage 2 assessment). As such, this site may contain further Cultural Heritage Value or Interest.

Findspot Parcel 14A – (BbGw-83)

This site has been has been sufficiently documented. It does not hold further Cultural Heritage Value or Interest. No further archaeological work is recommended.

Parcel 14B - Kloosterman 1 Site (BbGw-37)

This site is recommended for Stage 3 controlled surface pick-up (CSP) (completed during Stage 2 assessment). The site has Cultural Heritage Value and Interest and Stage 3 unit excavation and indepth archival research is recommended.

Parcel 14B - Kloosterman 2 Site (BbGw-38)

This site is recommended for Stage 3 controlled surface pick-up (CSP) (completed during Stage 2 assessment).. The site has Cultural Heritage Value and Interest and Stage 3 unit excavation and indepth archival research is recommended.

Parcel 16 Scatter (Not Bordenized)

This scatter has been sufficiently documented and does not hold further Cultural Heritage Value or Interest. No further archaeological work is recommended.

3.0 Stage 3: Methods

Of the archaeological resources found during the Stage 2 assessment, 4 scatters were subject to Stage 3 Controlled Surface Pick up (CSP) as they were found in agricultural fields.

CSP's were conducted by reducing transects to 1 m between crew members, and surveying the extent of the scatter.

All artifacts found within one m of the original area were bagged and flagged. Once the entire site area had been examined in this way, bags of artifacts were collected and numbered sequentially and the location of each flag was recorded with a D-GPS accurate to less than one m. In the lab, a map of the distribution of artifacts with the number of artifacts at each location was produced.

Sites subject to Stage 3 CSP are described below:

Historic Parcel 4C Scatter - BbGw-80

This site was subject to Stage 3 CSP on September 25, 2007. The CSP resulted in the collection of 64 artifacts. Details are presented as follows:

Selbye Site - BbGw-35

Sites subject to Stage 3 Unit Excavations:

Of the Sites found in agricultural fields and subject to Stage 3 CSP; unit excavations were approved by the client and conducted on the Wormwood site as described below. Unit excavation and indepth research are recommended on the Selbye Site and Kloosterman 1 and Kloosterman 2 Sites.

Of the Sites found during a test pit assessment, unit excavation was conducted on the Historic Parcel 2W site as described below.

For the two sites subject to Stage 3 units, the one by one meter units were excavated by hand to subsoil. All soil was screened through 6 mm mesh to facilitate the recovery of artifacts. Each unit was then cleaned and examined for evidence of features. No features were found. All units were then backfilled.

Wormwood Site (BbGw-36)

Upon conclusion of the CSP at the Wormwood Site (BbGw-36), Stage 3 units were excavated in the area of highest artifact concentration. Due to a time constraint, Stage 3 unit excavation was discontinued after 20 units were excavated. More units will be recommended to cover the extent of the site as determined during the CSP. Further Stage 3 unit excavation will be required at the Wormwood Site. Details are presented as follows:

At the Wormwood Site, the average depth of units excavated was 26 cm.

Historic Parcel 2W Site (BbGw-36)

A total of 7 units were excavated on the 2W site with a focus of placing units atop the test pits with the highest artifact concentrations. While the 7 units did not extend across the entire perimeter of the site area as established by positive test pit assessment, it was clearly demonstrated by the artifact assemblage the artifacts were primarily late 19th and 20th century artifacts; the site was deemed to have been sufficiently documented and no further work was required. Units were excavated to an average depth of 23 cm. Artifact details are presented as follows:

Wormwood Site (BbGw-32)

Stage 3 investigations of the scatter of artifacts in Parcel 3 involved a controlled surface survey of the site which has been called the Wormwood Site (BbGw-35). This was found to be 0.55 acres in extent. A total of 478 artifacts were recovered (Table 7 and 8). A sample of artifacts is illustrated in Plate 4, 5 and 6. The artifact catalogue is presented in Appendix E.

A crew returned to the site and excavated 20 one m squares across the site which produced an additional 686 artifacts (Figure 11, Plates 5 and 6). The catalogue is presented in Appendix F and G.

The recovery of relatively large numbers of Refined White Earthenwares including Late Palette Painted and Banded Slipware, along with the presence of Pearlwares and the low frequencies of Vitrified Earthenwares, suggests an occupation during the early to mid-19th century.

Further Stage 3 unit excavation will be required at the Wormwood Site.

Historic Parcel 2W (BbGw-82)

A total of 7 one m squares were excavated to increase the size of the artifact sample found behind a demolished house on Parcel 2W. A close examination of the artifacts recovered in the field suggested that the deposit was from the late 19th century to 20th century and therefore test excavations were discontinued as the field director determined the site to have been sufficiently documented with no further Cultural Heritage Value or Interest. No historic research was applied to this assemblage as it

was clear from the nature of the recovered artifacts that the site was not of heritage value given the late nature of the deposit. There was no evidence of subsurface features

A summary list of artifacts recovered presented in Table 6, and a sample of artifacts collected is illustrated in Plate 13. The artifact catalogue is presented as Appendix D.

Selbye Site (BbGw-35)

This site was located in Parcel 12 and found to be 0.15 acres in size (Figures 12). This has been registered and named the Selbye Site (BbGw-36). Due to our contractual obligations with the client, Stage 3 units were not conducted at this time, but recommended to be conducted in the future.

The predominance of Refined White Earthenwares, including the presence of Green and Blue Scalloped Edgewares, the presence of Pearlware and the absence of Vitrified White Earthenwares suggests an early to mid-19th century occupation. As such this site holds further Cultural Heritage Value or Interest.

A summary list of artifacts recovered from the surface is presented in Table 12 and a sample illustrated in Plate 9. The artifact catalogue is presented in Appendix J.

In terms of historic context, the Selbye Site is located within a portion of Lot 1, Concession 8. This Lot, in 1837, the Toronto and Home District directory lists John Johnson as residing on Lot 1, Concession 8 in the Town of Innisfil (Walton, 1837). By 1871, the property had been sub-divided and the historic Tremaine map of Simcoe County indicates two individuals, Robert Gilpin and Elizabeth McCarty were residing on the property (Tremaine, 1871). No structures are shown however, George Tremaine mapped only the dwellings of land owners who paid a prime subscription rate for his mapping. Therefore, it is possible a structure existed on the lot but was excluded from the mapping as the owners did not pay a subscription fee. Census records from 1871 show Robert Gilpin living on the study area with his family in a single dwelling. Elizabeth McCarty is also shown as residing in a single dwelling on the study area with her daughter and grandson (Government of Canada, 1871). The nature of these structures is not specified. The 1872 Gazetteer of Simcoe County indicates Robert Gilpin and Elizabeth McCarty (also spelt McCartney) still own the property (Irwin, 1872). The 1881 Illustrated Atlas of the Dominion of Canada (Simcoe Supplement) does not identify an owner or illustrate a structure for Lot 1, Concession 8 (Beldon, 1881). As with the Tremaine Map however, the Simcoe Supplement atlas was recorded based on subscribers and if an individual did not subscribe, their information was not recorded. Due to a continued occupation of this lot since 1837 however, both an owner and homestead were presumably present in 1881.

Historic Parcel 4C Scatter BbGw-80

Response – all artifacts were pulled from storage, and re-analyzed. The text and the table (as appropriate) has been revised as follows: The assemblage from Parcel 4C consists of only 64 artifacts, 41 pieces of vitrified white earthenware, 5 fragments of refined white earthenware, 1 fragment of yellowware, 3 coarse earthenware and 1 unglazed buff stoneware. The assemblage also contained 1 fragment of aqua bottle glass, 1 burned bone, 7 bone fragments, 1 pipe bowl, 1 pipe stem and 1 pipe elbow.

Given the lack paucity of architectural elements within the assemblage compounded with the majority of the ceramics being vitrified, this site likely represents a small, late 19th century singular deposal area. The site has been sufficiently documented within the Stage 3 assessment.

Kloosterman 1 Site (BbGw-37) and Kloosterman 2 Site (BbGw-38)

South of the existing residence a scatter of Euro-Canadian artifacts were found covering an area of 0.57 acres (locations of finds are presented in Figures 14 and 15). This has been called the Kloosterman Site (BbGw-37). The predominance of Vitrified White Earthenwares and the low numbers of Refined White Earthenwares suggests a mid to late 19th century farmhouse. Due to our contractual obligations with the client, Stage 3 units were not conducted at this time, but recommended to be conducted in the future on both of these sites.

A list of the artifacts recovered is presented in Table 13 with a sample of artifacts recovered illustrated in Plate 10. The artifact catalogue is presented in Appendix K.

In the northwest corner of the field a smaller scatter of Euro-Canadian were recovered from an area 0.15 acres in extent (Figures 14 and 16). This has been called the Kloosterman II Site (BbGw-38). Two surface collections were made of this site. The predominance of Vitrified White Earthenwares along with the presence of low numbers of Refined White Earthenwares and Pearlwares suggests an occupation from the early to late 19th century.

Stage 3 unit excavation and indepth archival research is required on both Kloosterman 1 Site and Kloosterman 2 Site.

A summary list of artifacts recovered is presented in Table 14. A sample of artifacts collected in Plate 11; artifact catalogues are attached as Appendices L and M.

3.2 Stage 3: Recommendations

Recommendations are as follows:

Wormwood Site (BbGw-32)

- o Further Stage 3 test units are recommended to cover the site extent; and indepth archival research is warranted. This will further help to determine the Cultural Heritage Value or Interest of the site and be used to make appropriate Stage 4 recommendations.

Kloosterman Site 1 (BbGw-37)

- o Stage 3 test unit excavation is recommended for the site; and indepth archival research is warranted. This will further help to determine the Cultural Heritage Value or Interest of the site and be used to make appropriate Stage 4 recommendations.

Kloosterman Site 2 (BbGw-38)

- o Stage 3 test unit excavation is recommended for the site; and indepth archival research is warranted. This will further help to determine the Cultural Heritage Value or Interest of the site and be used to make appropriate Stage 4 recommendations.

Selbye Site (BbGw-35)

- o Stage 3 test unit excavation is recommended for the site; and indepth archival research is warranted. This will further help to determine the Cultural Heritage Value or Interest of the site and be used to make appropriate Stage 4 recommendations.

Parcel 2W - Parcel 2W site (BbGw-36).

- o This scatter has been sufficiently documented and does not hold further Cultural Heritage Value or Interest. No further archaeological work is recommended.

Parcel 4 – Part 4C - Historic 4C site (BbGw-80)

- o This site has been sufficiently documented and does not hold further Cultural Heritage Value or Interest. No further archaeological work is recommended.

4.0 Buried Archaeological Deposits

The Ontario Ministry of Culture requires the following statements to be included in every assessment report:

- Should deeply buried archaeological remains be found on the property during construction activities, MCTR (now the Ministry of Culture) should be notified immediately.
- In the event that human remains are encountered during construction, the proponent should immediately contact both the MCTR (now the Ministry of Culture) and the Registrar or Deputy Registrar of the Cemeteries Regulation Units of the Ministry of Consumer and Commercial Relations (now Ministry of Government Services) (416) 326-8392 (Archaeological Assessment Technical Guidelines 1993:12).

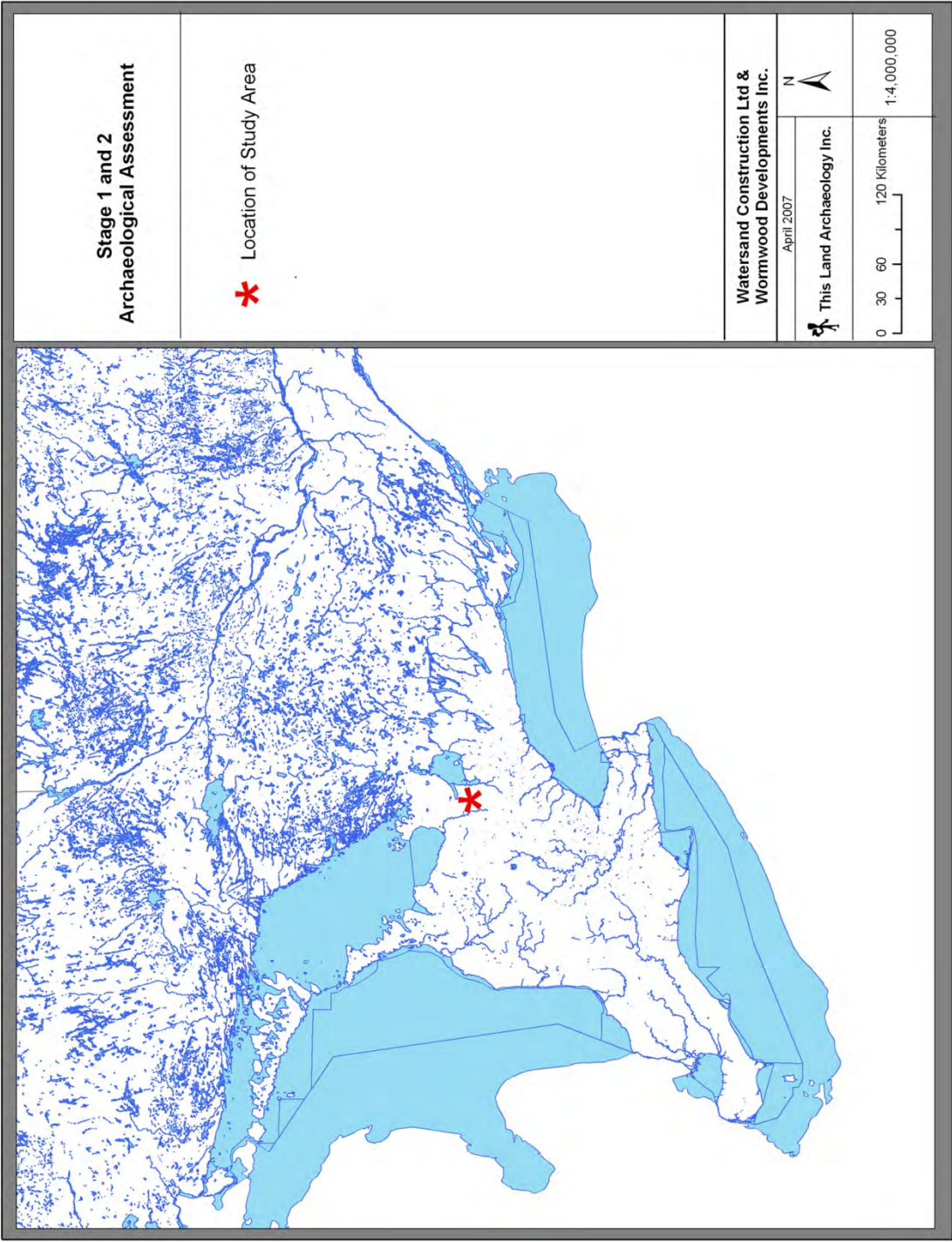


Figure 1: General Location of the Study Area

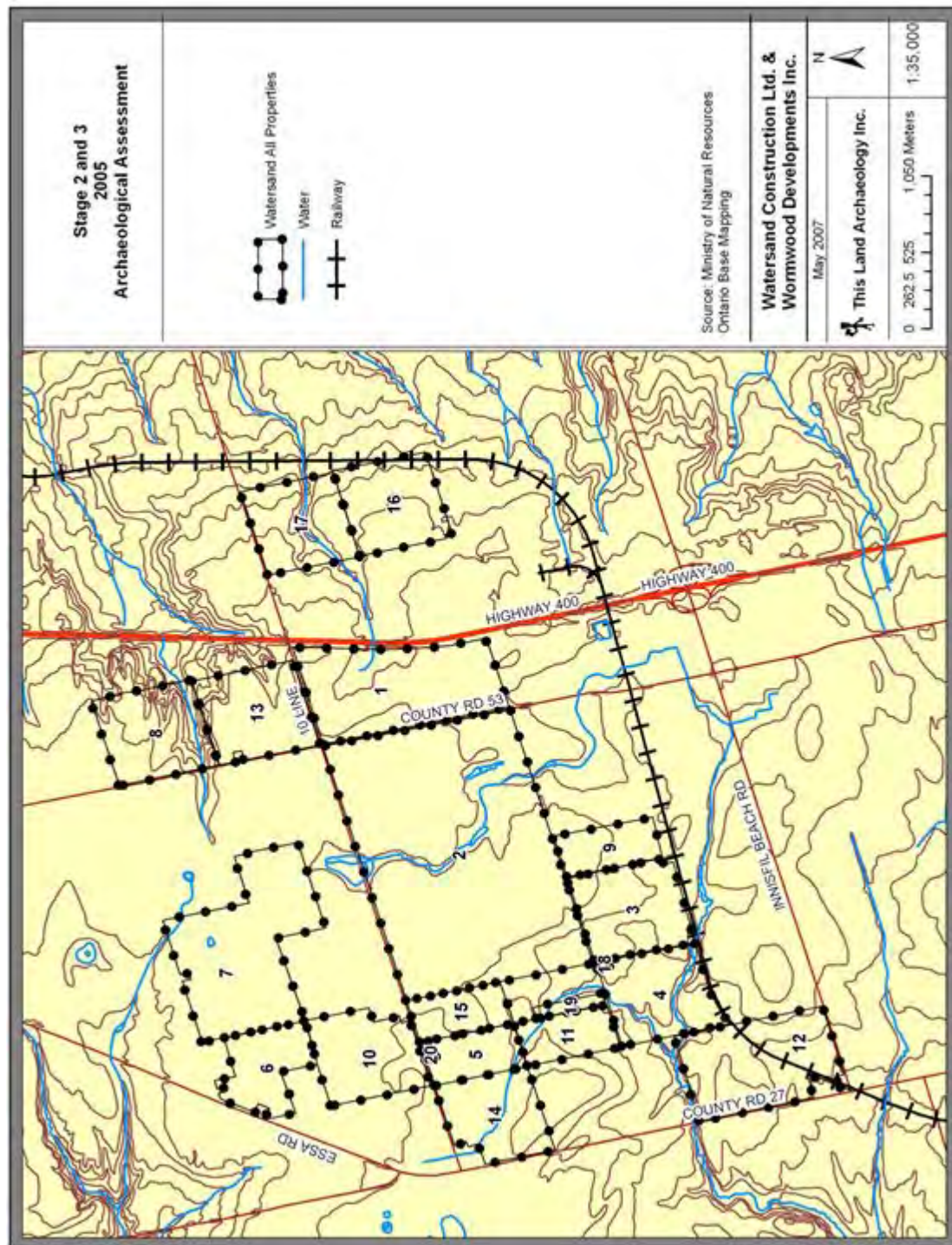


Figure 2: Location of Parcels 1 to 20

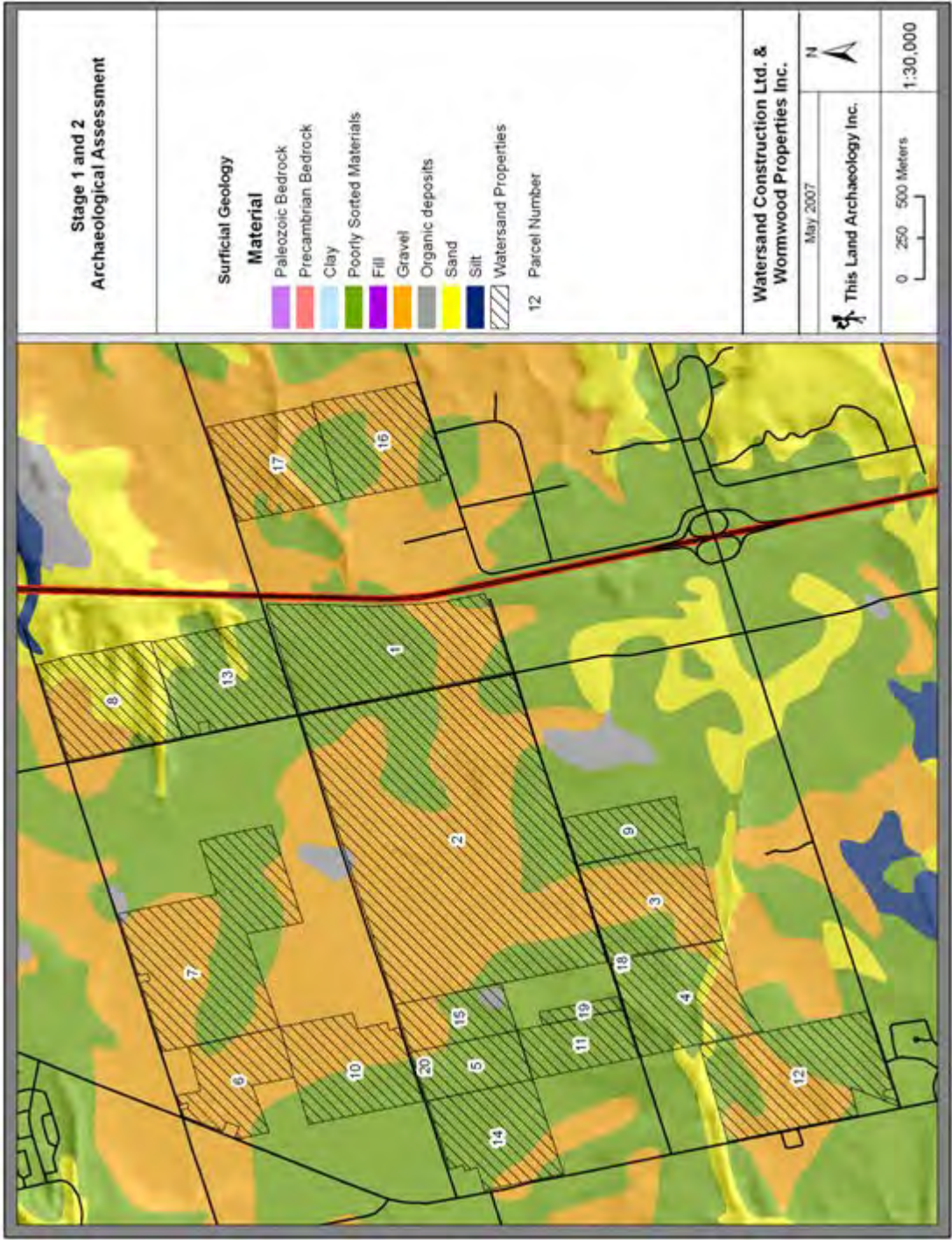


Figure 4: Surficial Geology of the Study Area

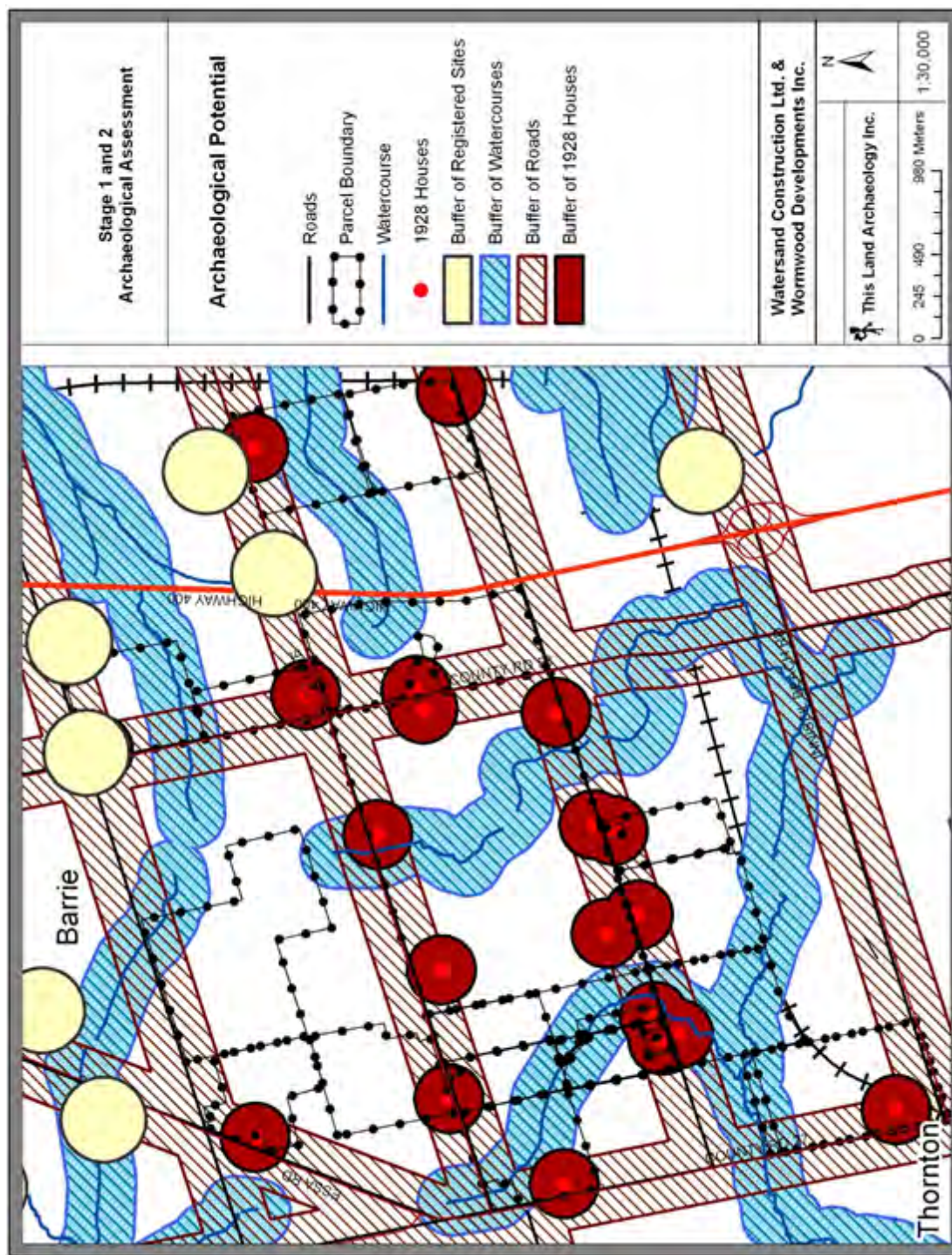


Figure 5: Map of Archaeological Potential of the Study Area

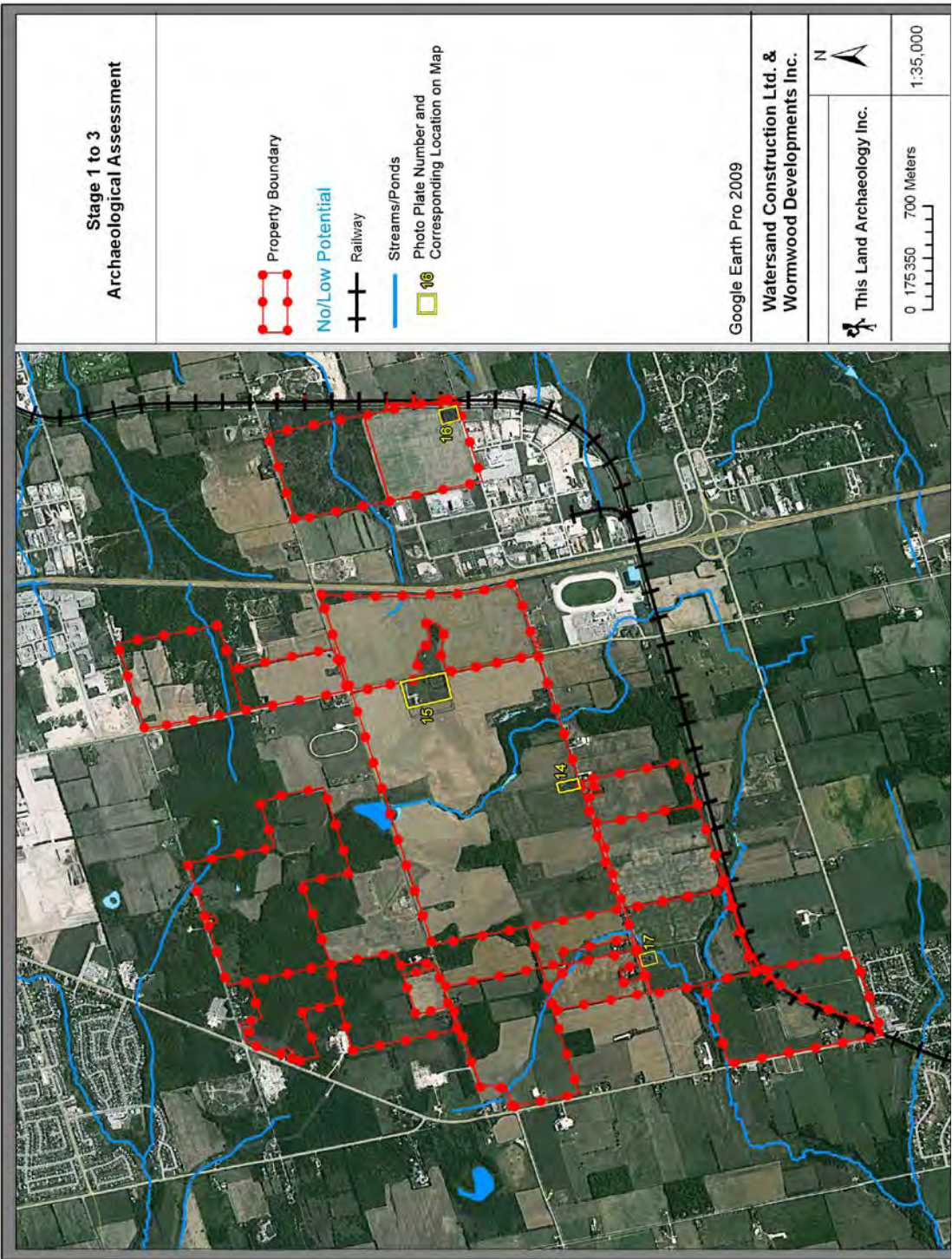


Figure 5A: Map of No/Low Potential showing the location of Photo
Plates 14 to 17 showing no/low potential

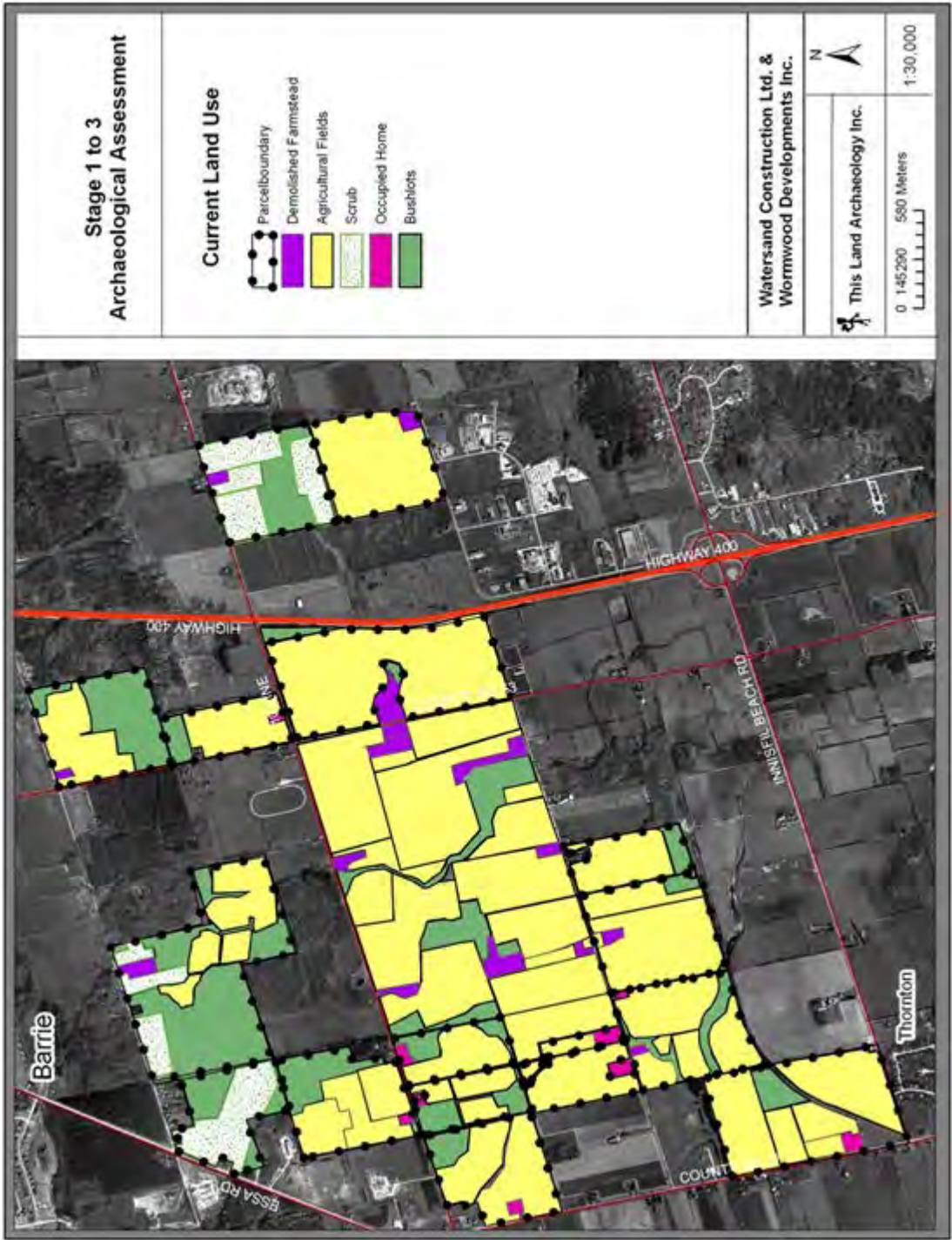


Figure 6: Current Land Use

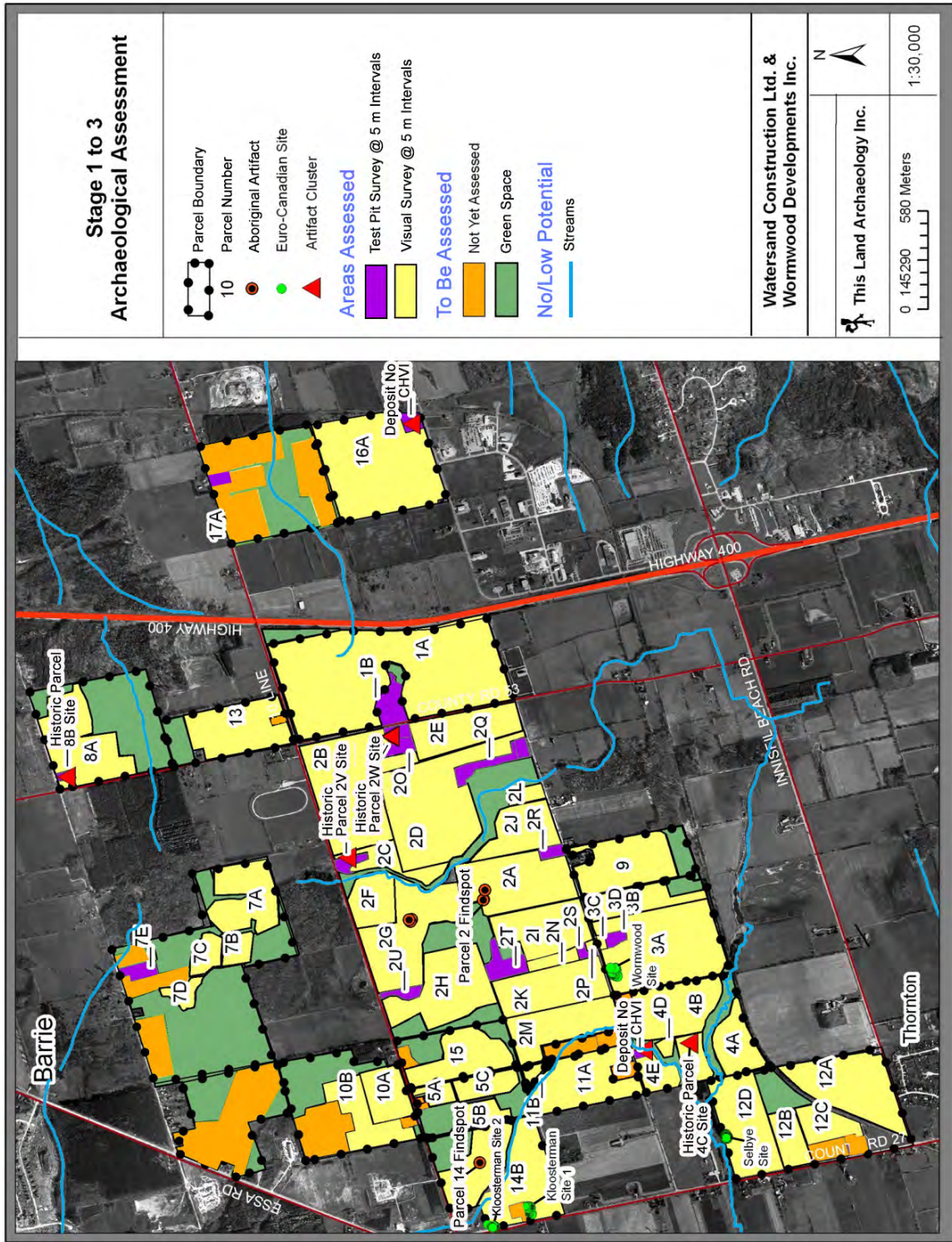


Figure 7: Overall Results of Stage 2 Assessment

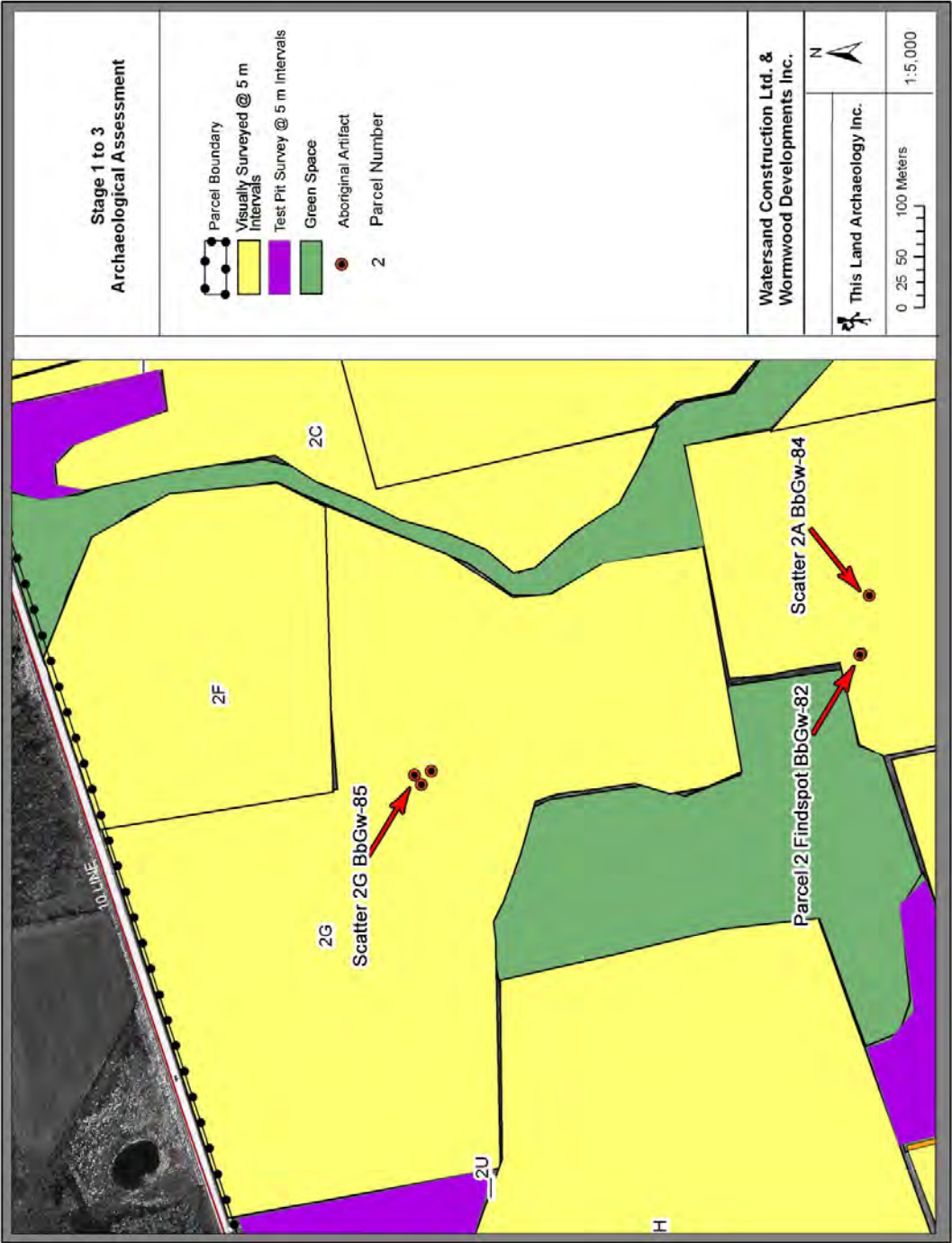


Figure 8: Location of Findspots found during the Stage 2 Visual Survey of Parcels 2A & 2G

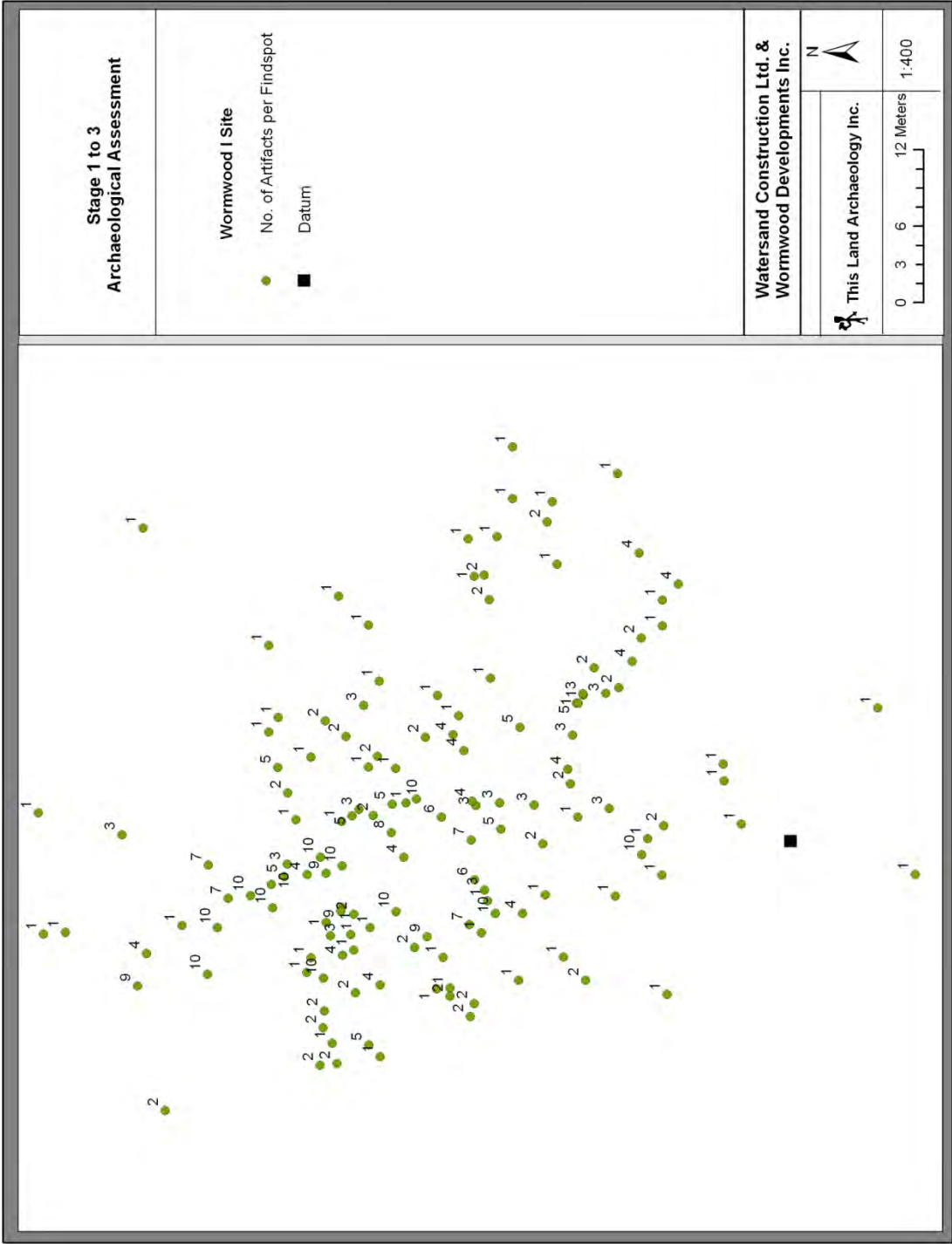


Figure 10: Close up Distribution of Artifacts found during the Stage 3 CSP of
Wormwood Site

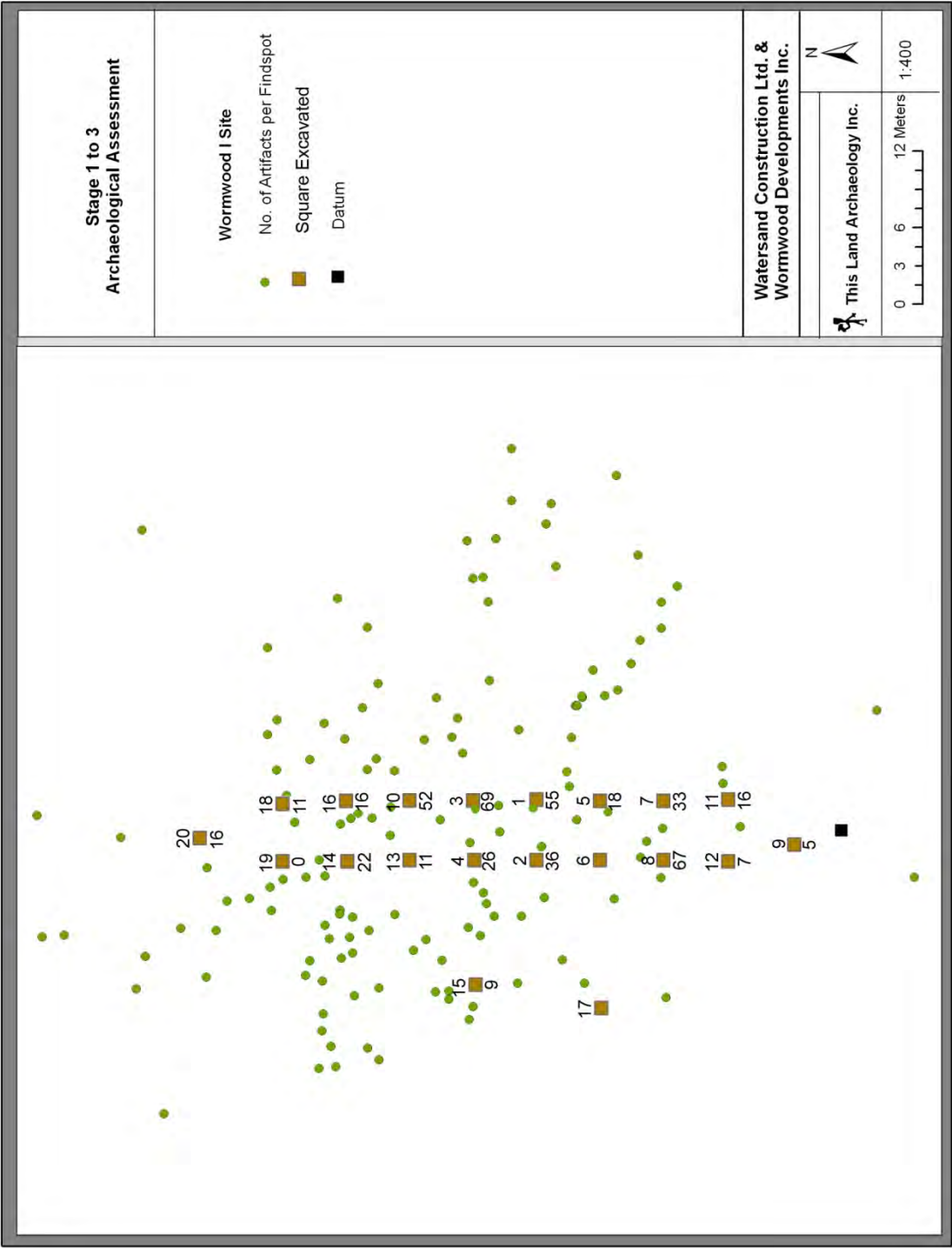


Figure 11: Location of Stage 3 CSP Findspots; and location of Unit excavation with unit number and number of artifacts found on the Wormwood Site

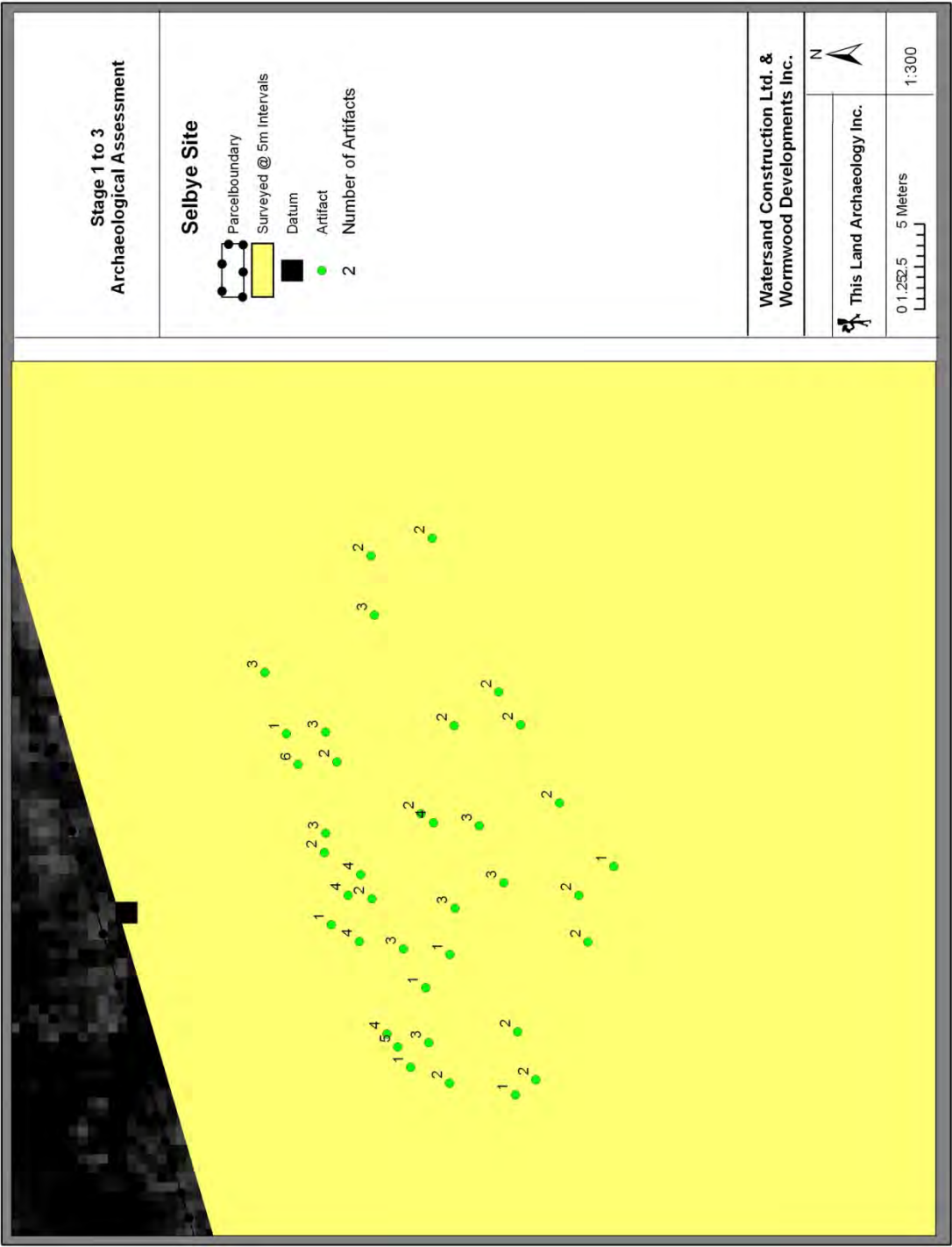


Figure 13: Location of Stage 3 CSP Findspots at the Selbye Site

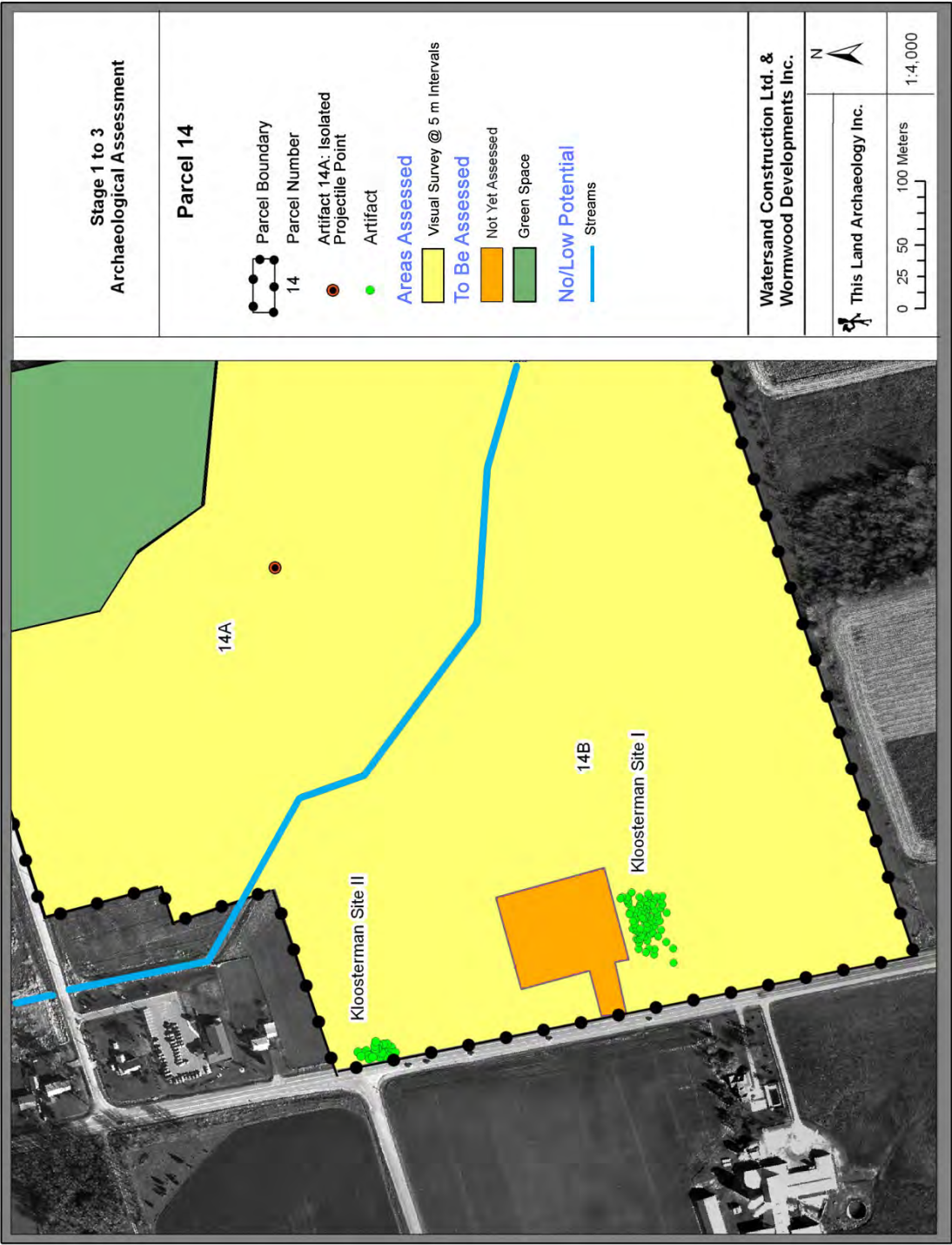


Figure 14: Location of Kloosterman Sites and Aboriginal Findspot on Parcel 14A and 14B

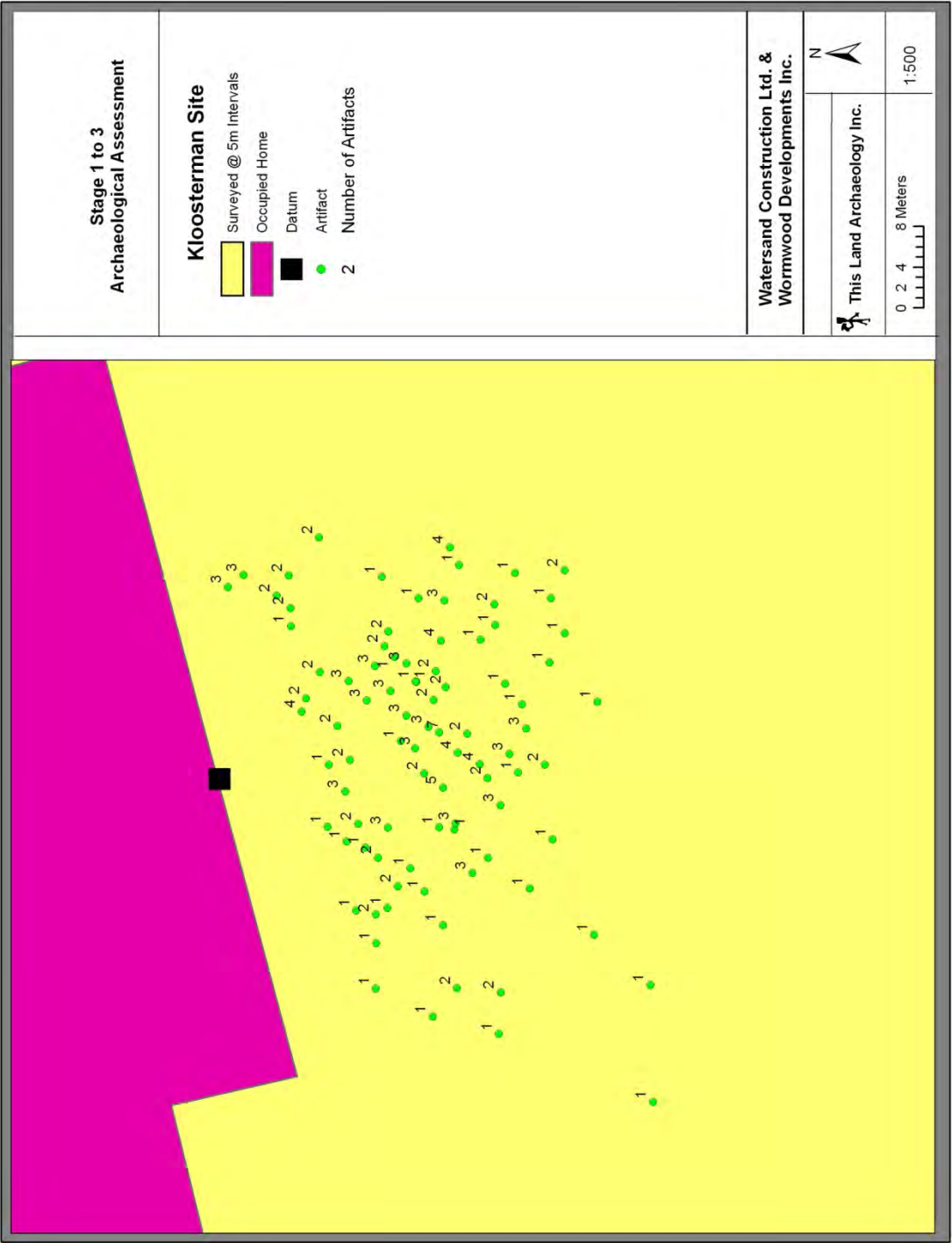


Figure 15: Location of Stage 3 CSP Findspots at the Kloosterman 1 Site

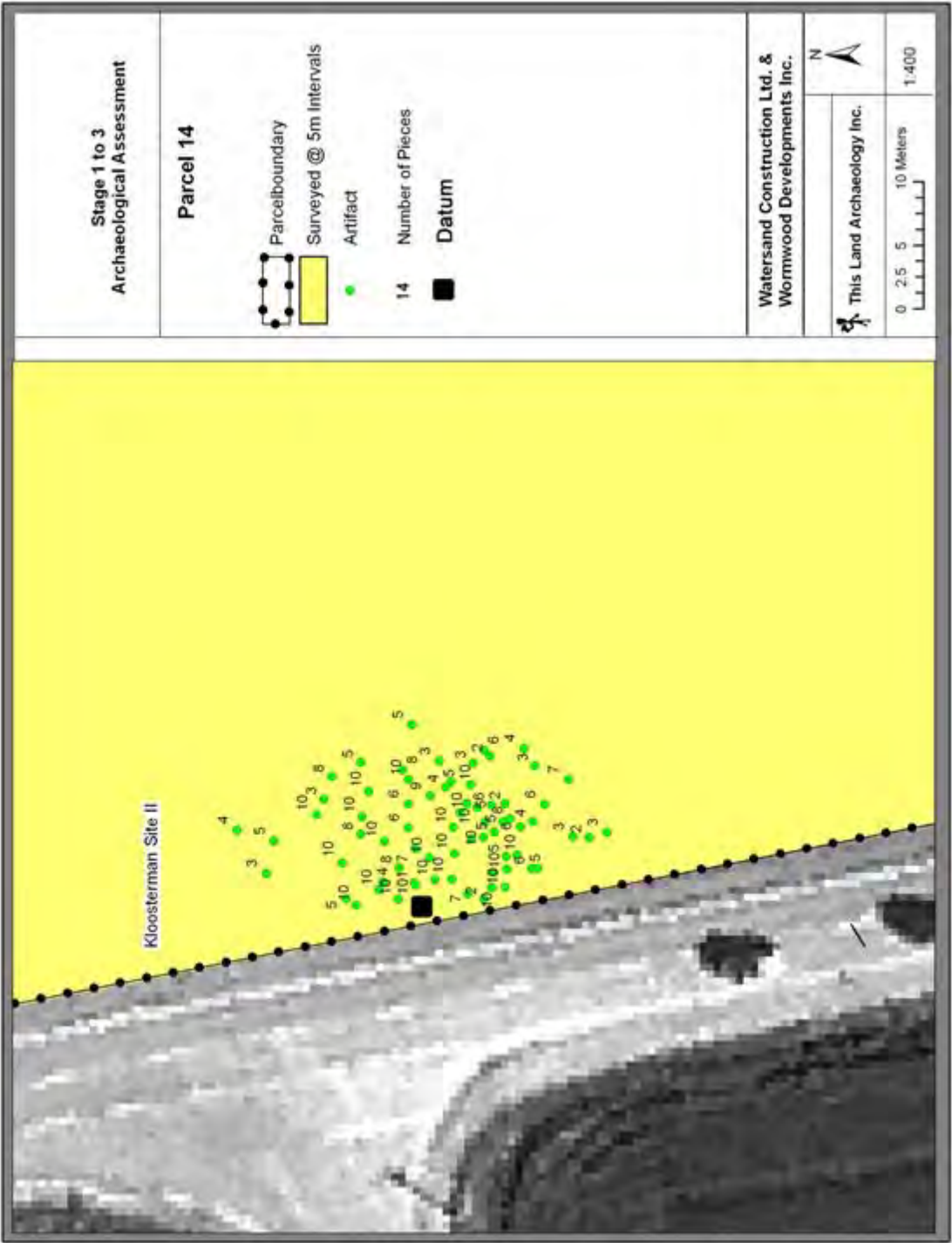


Figure 16: Location of Stage 3 CSP Findspots at the Kloosterman 2 Site

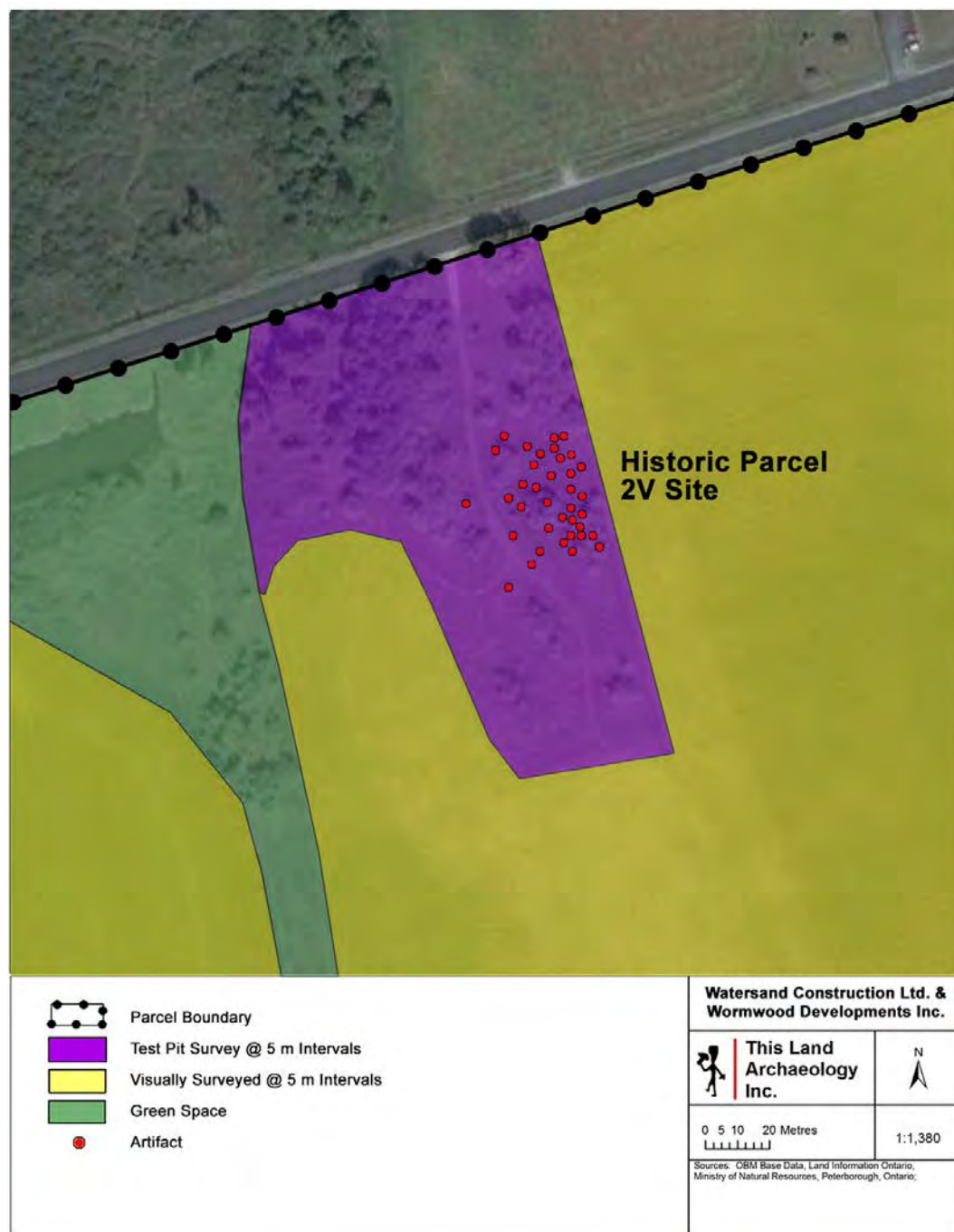


Figure 17: Location of Positive Test Pits on Parcel 2V (Historic Parcel 2V Site)

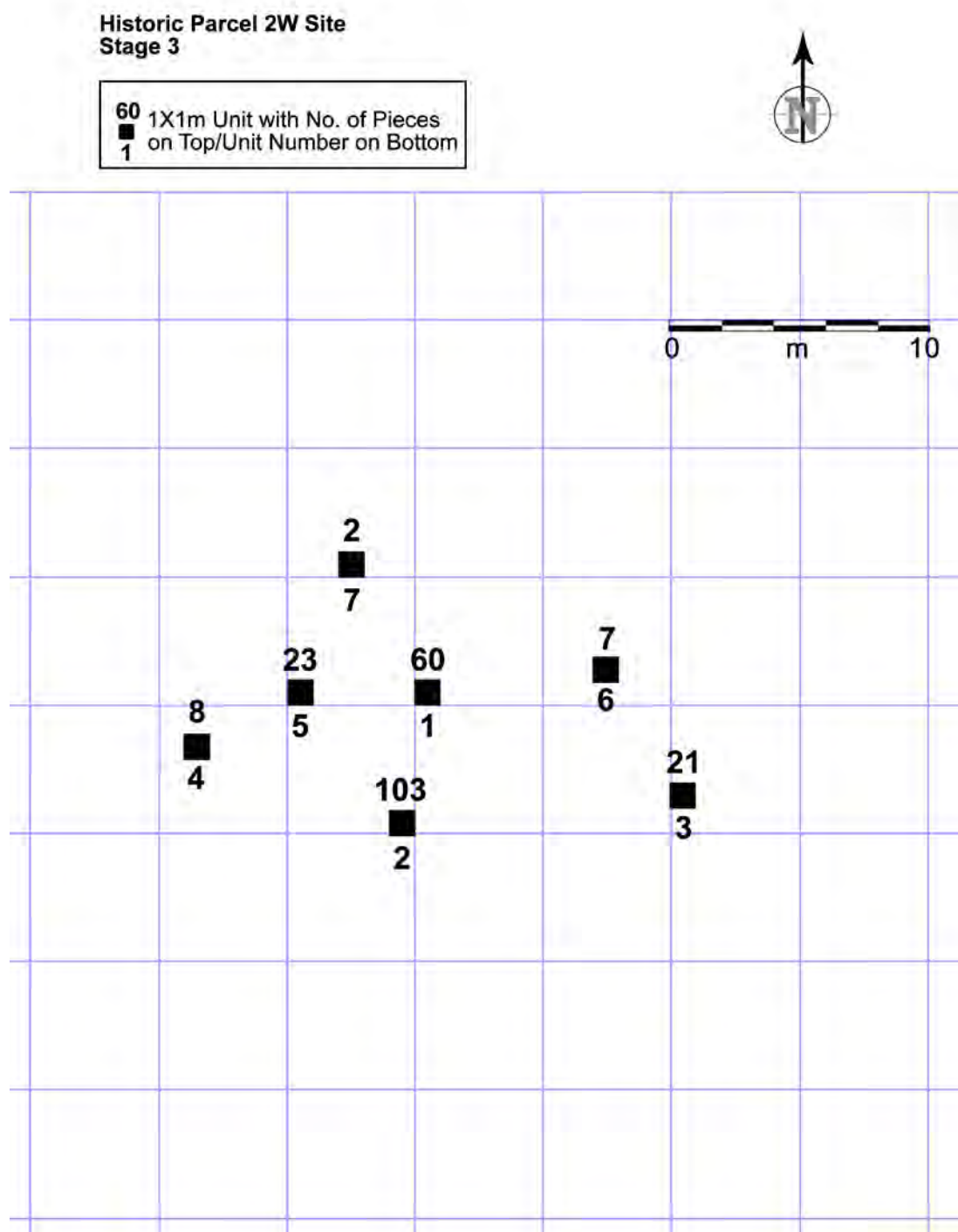


Figure 19: Location of Stage 3 Units with Number of Artifacts

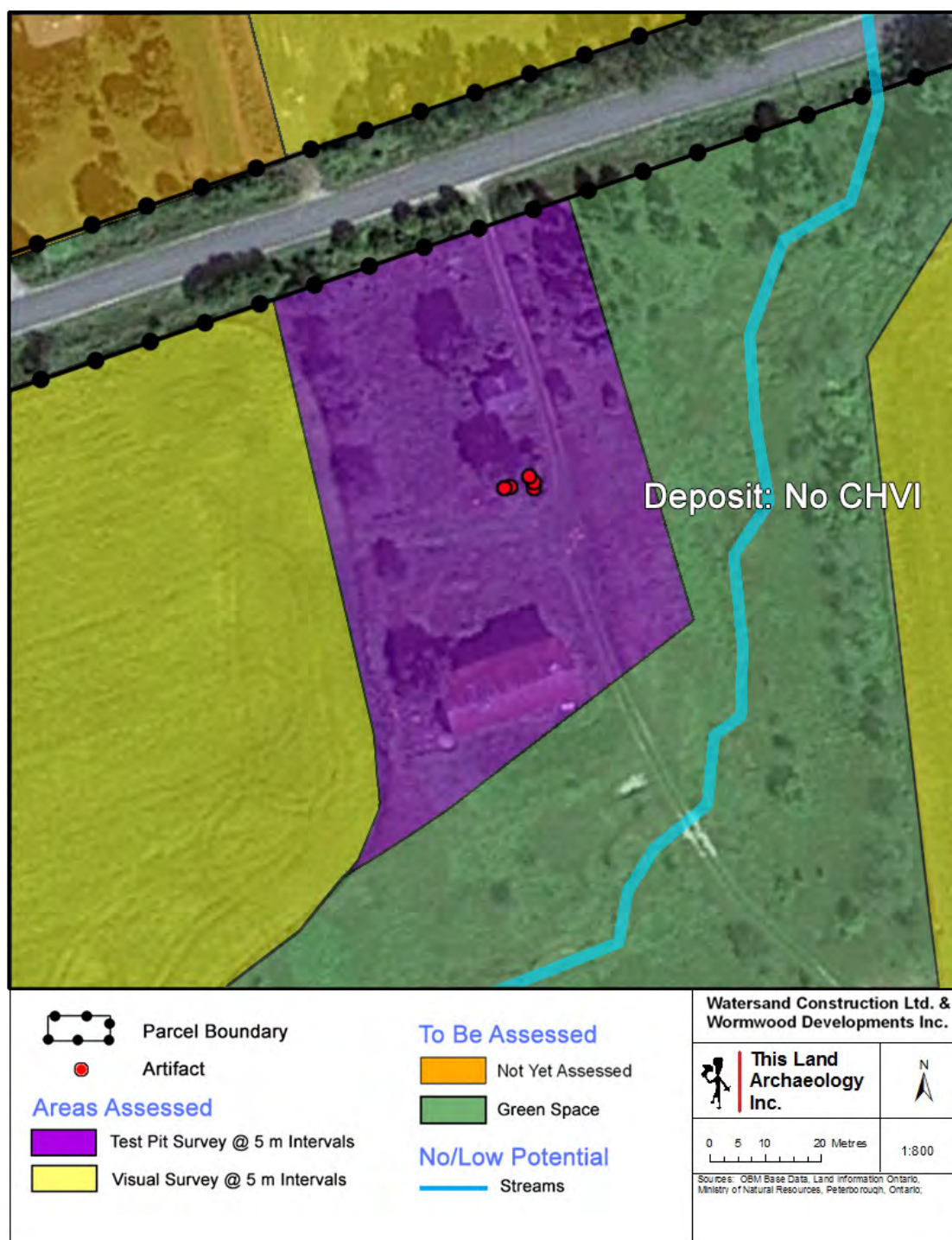


Figure 21: Location of Positive Test Pits on Parcel 4F

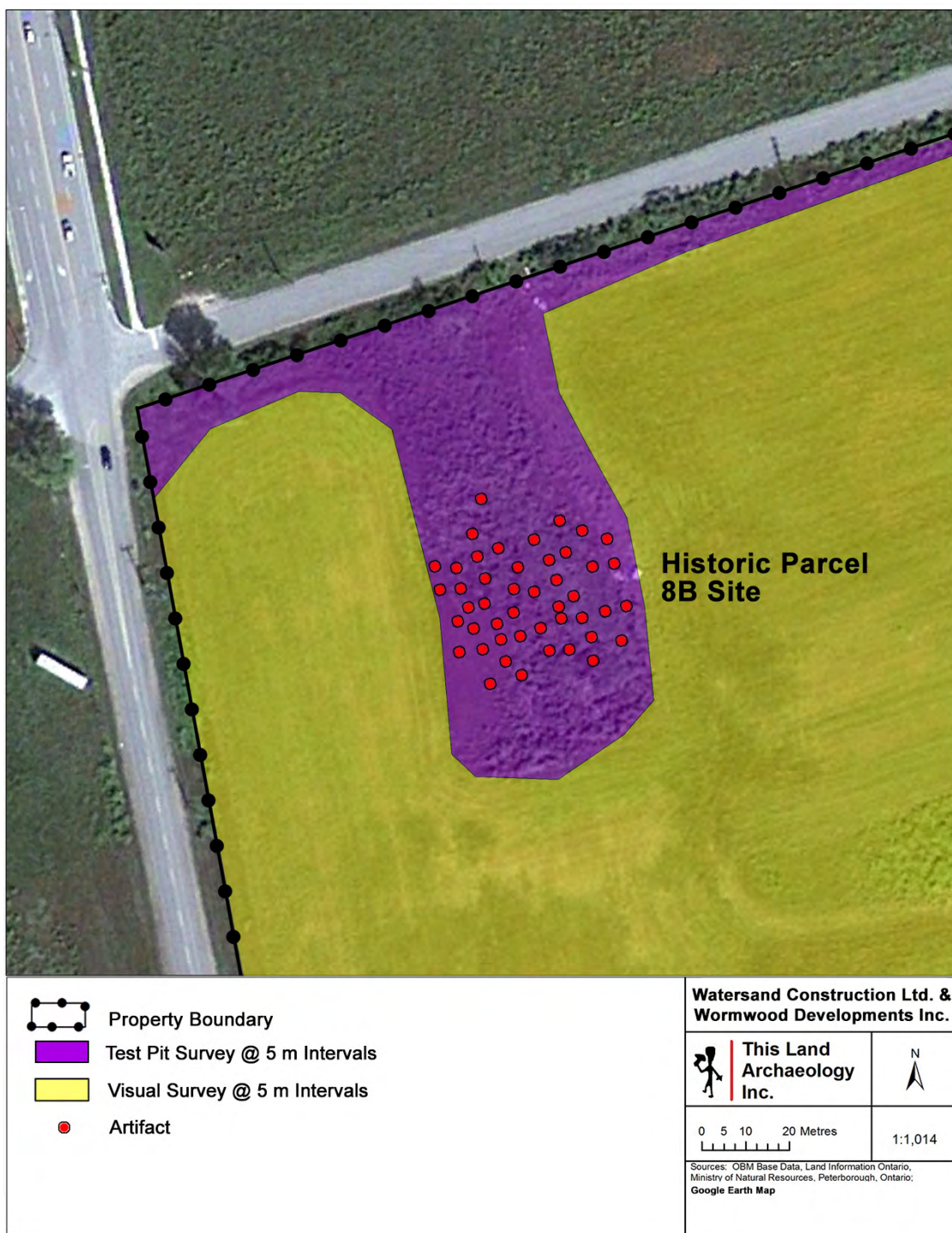


Figure 22: Location of Positive Test Pits on the Historic Parcel 8B Site

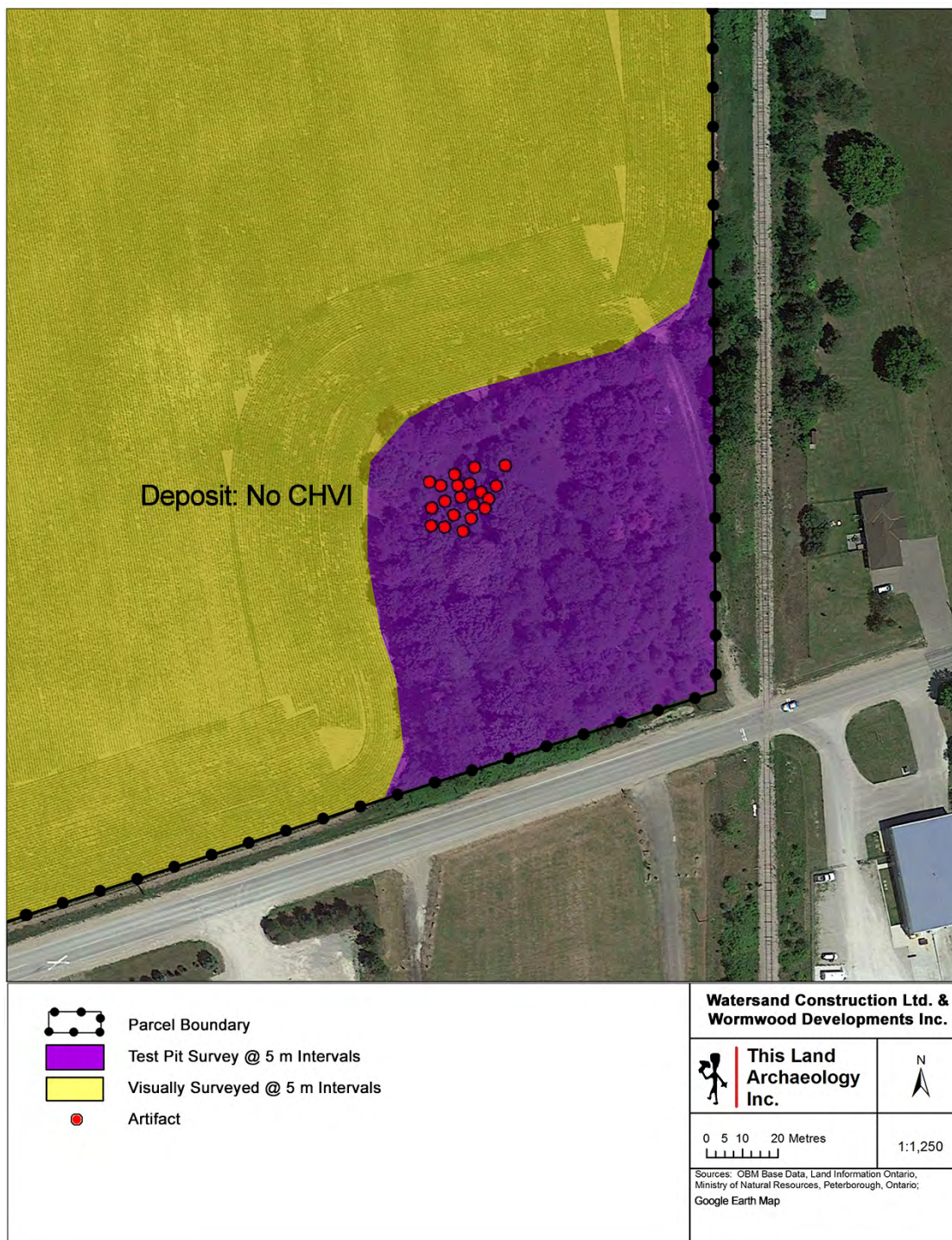


Figure 23: Location of Positive Test Pits on Parcel 16B

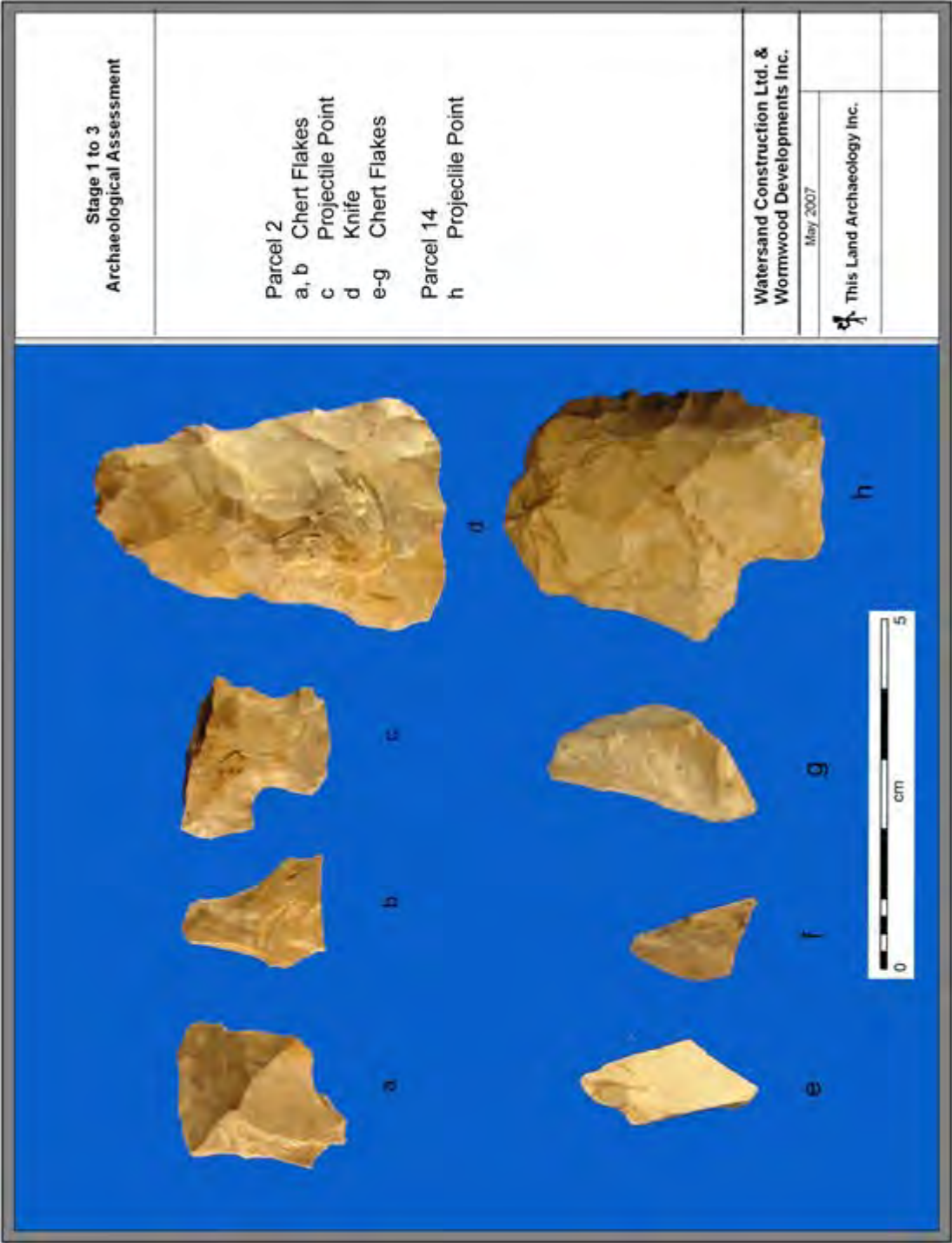


Plate 1: Aboriginal Artifacts found on Parcels 2 and 14

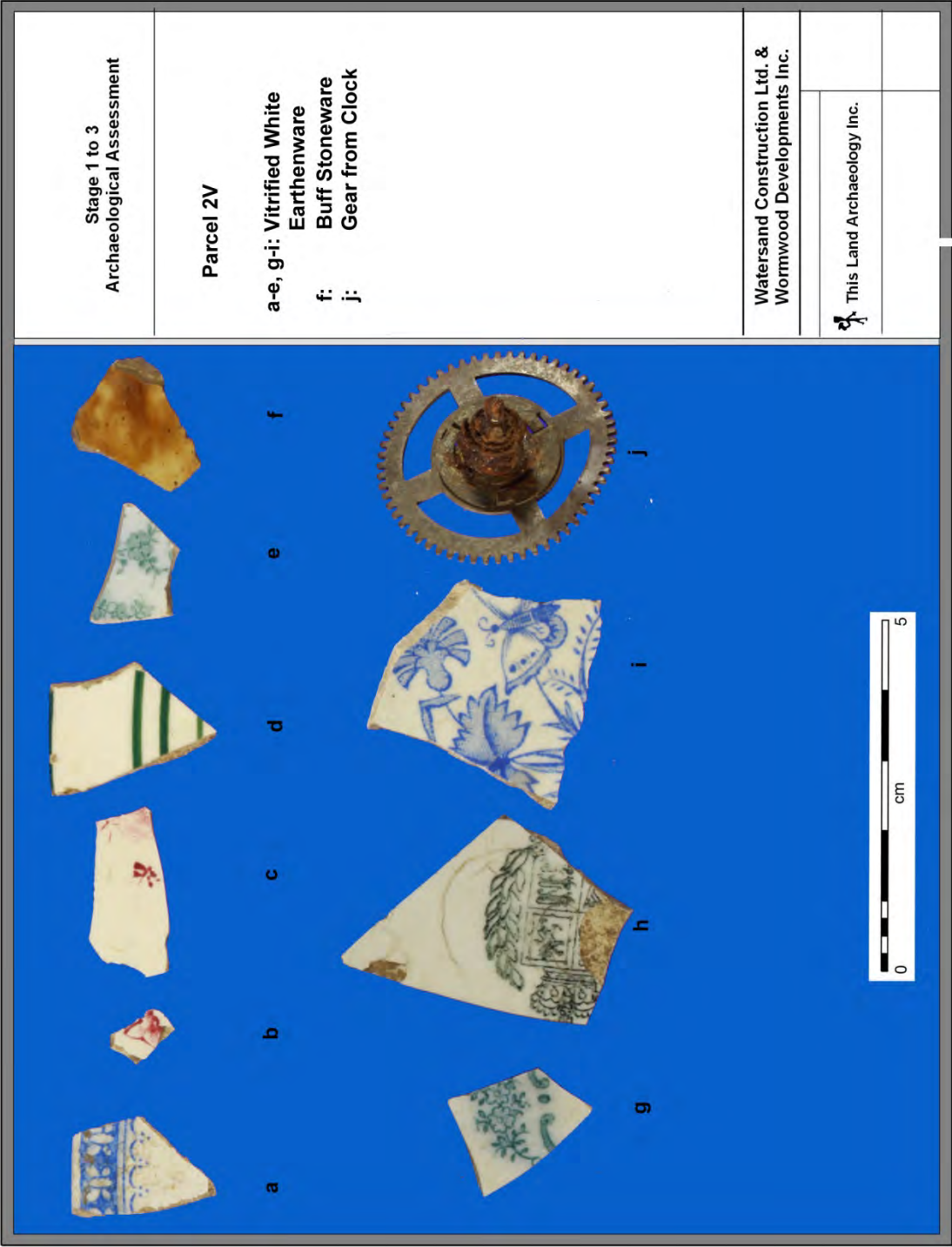


Plate 2: Sample of Artifact recovered from the Test Pit Assessment on Parcel 2V

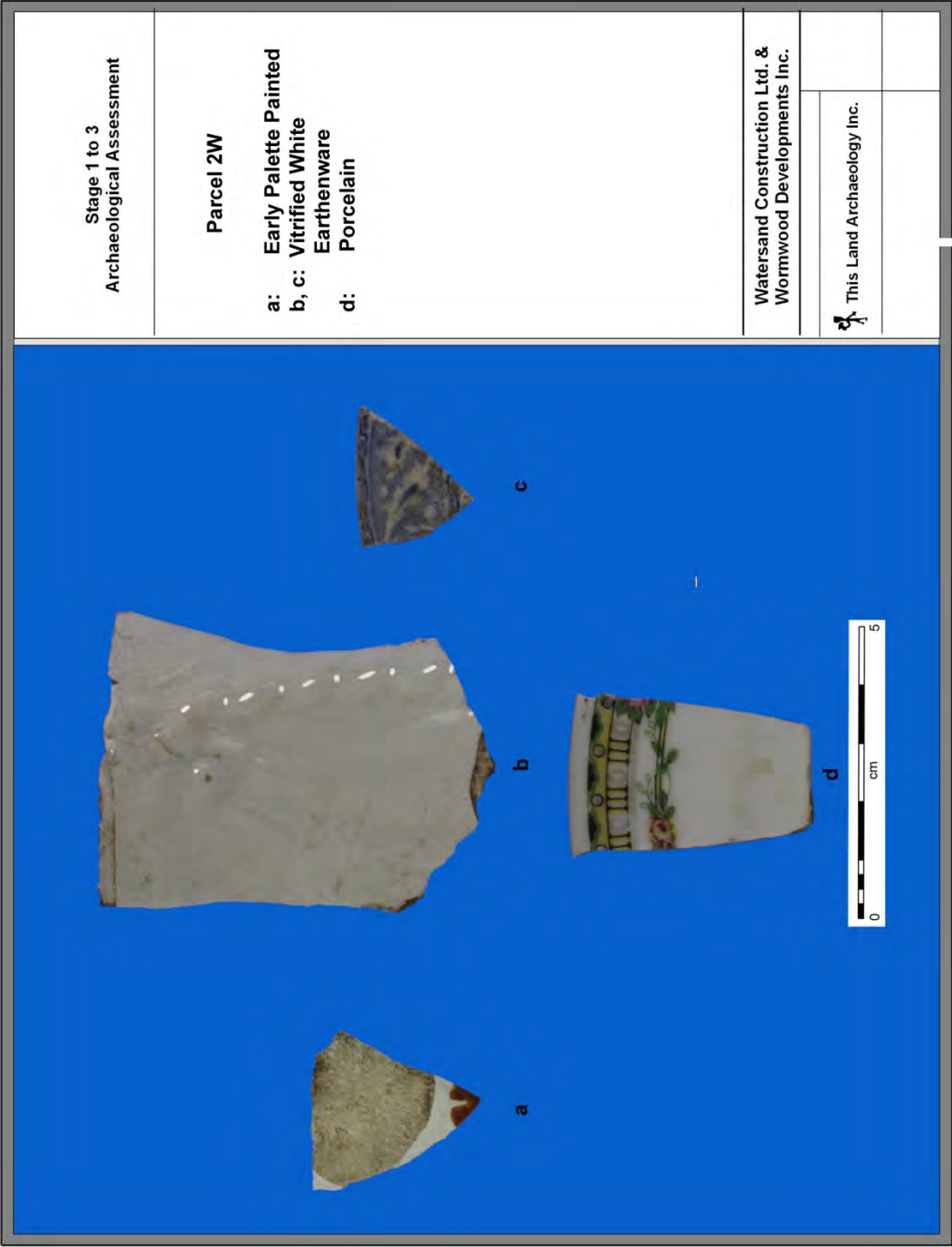


Plate 3: Sample of Artifacts recovered from Test Pit Assessment of Parcel 2W

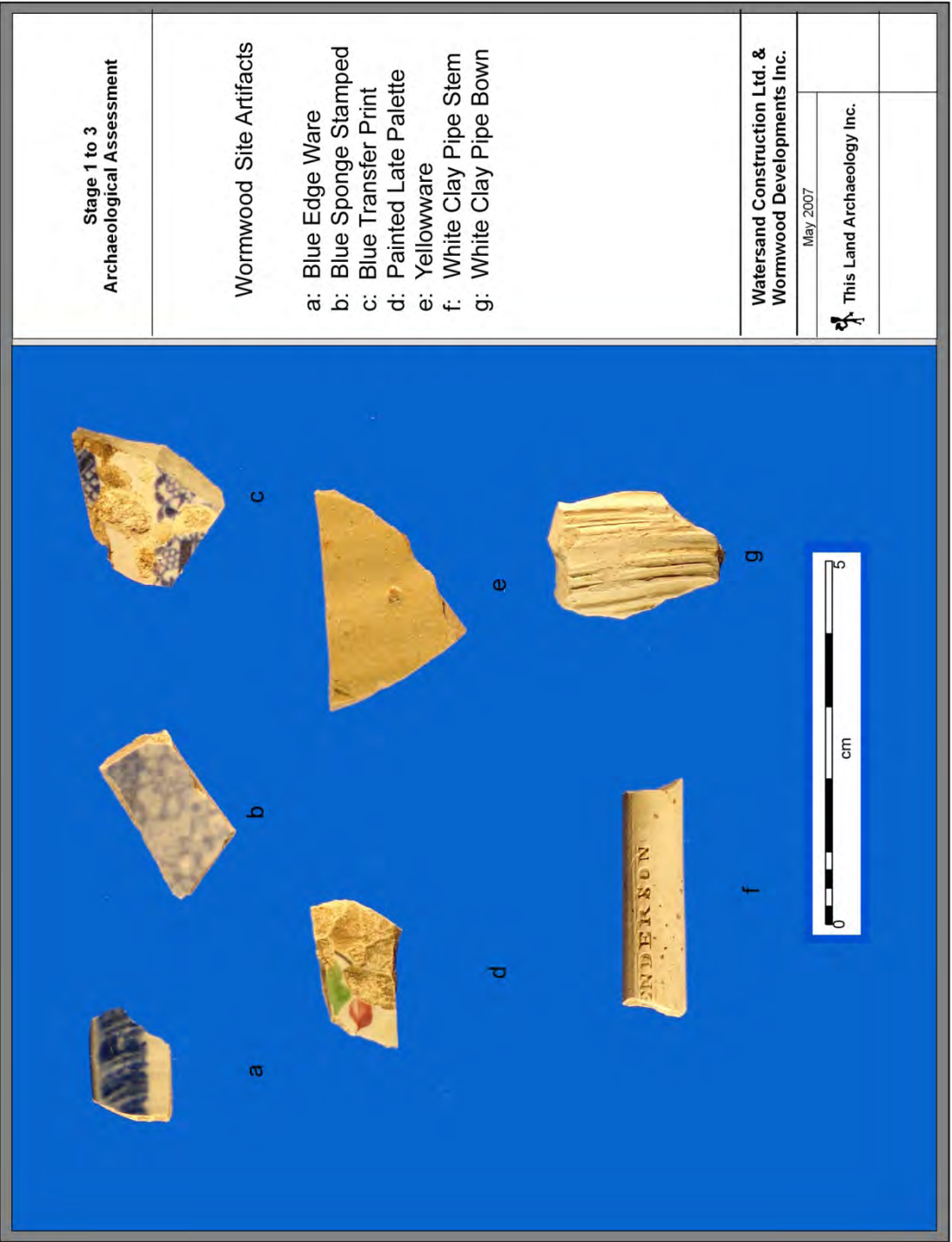


Plate 4: Sample of Artifacts recovered from the Controlled Surface Collection of
the Wormwood Site

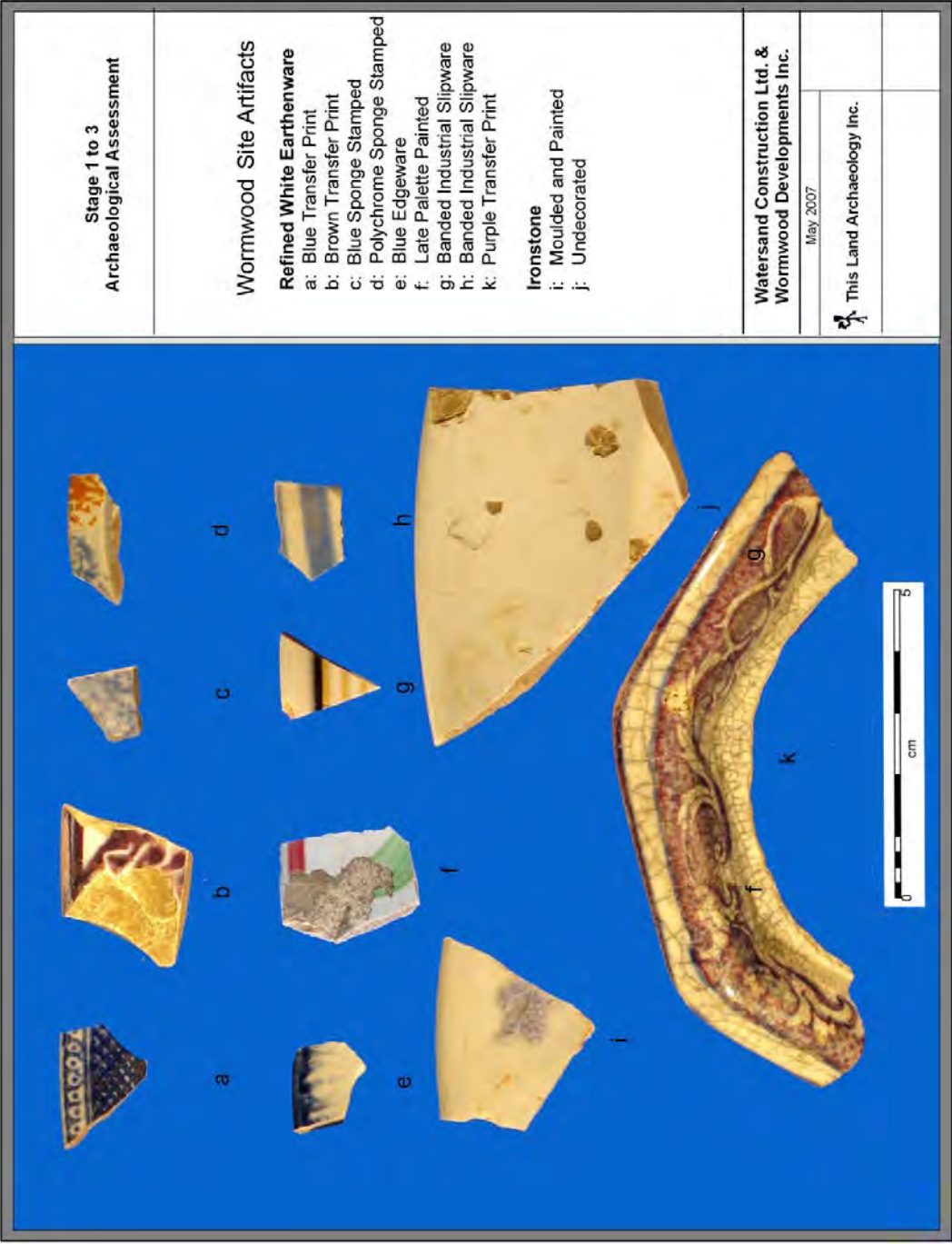


Plate 5: Sample of Ceramic Artifacts recovered from the Stage 3 Unit

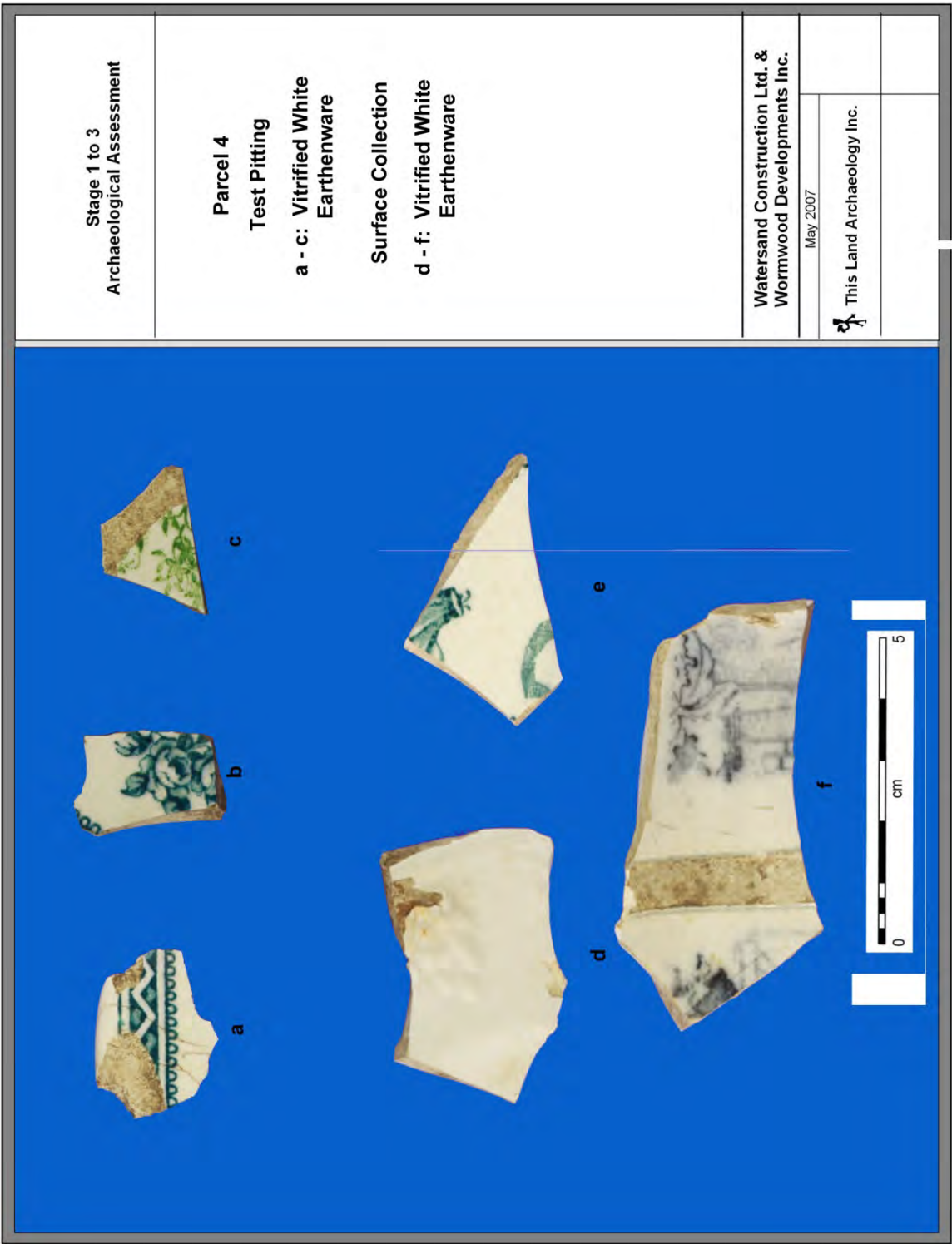


Plate 7: Sample of Artifacts recovered from the Test Pit Assessment of Parcel 4F;
and the Stage 3 CSP of Parcel 4C

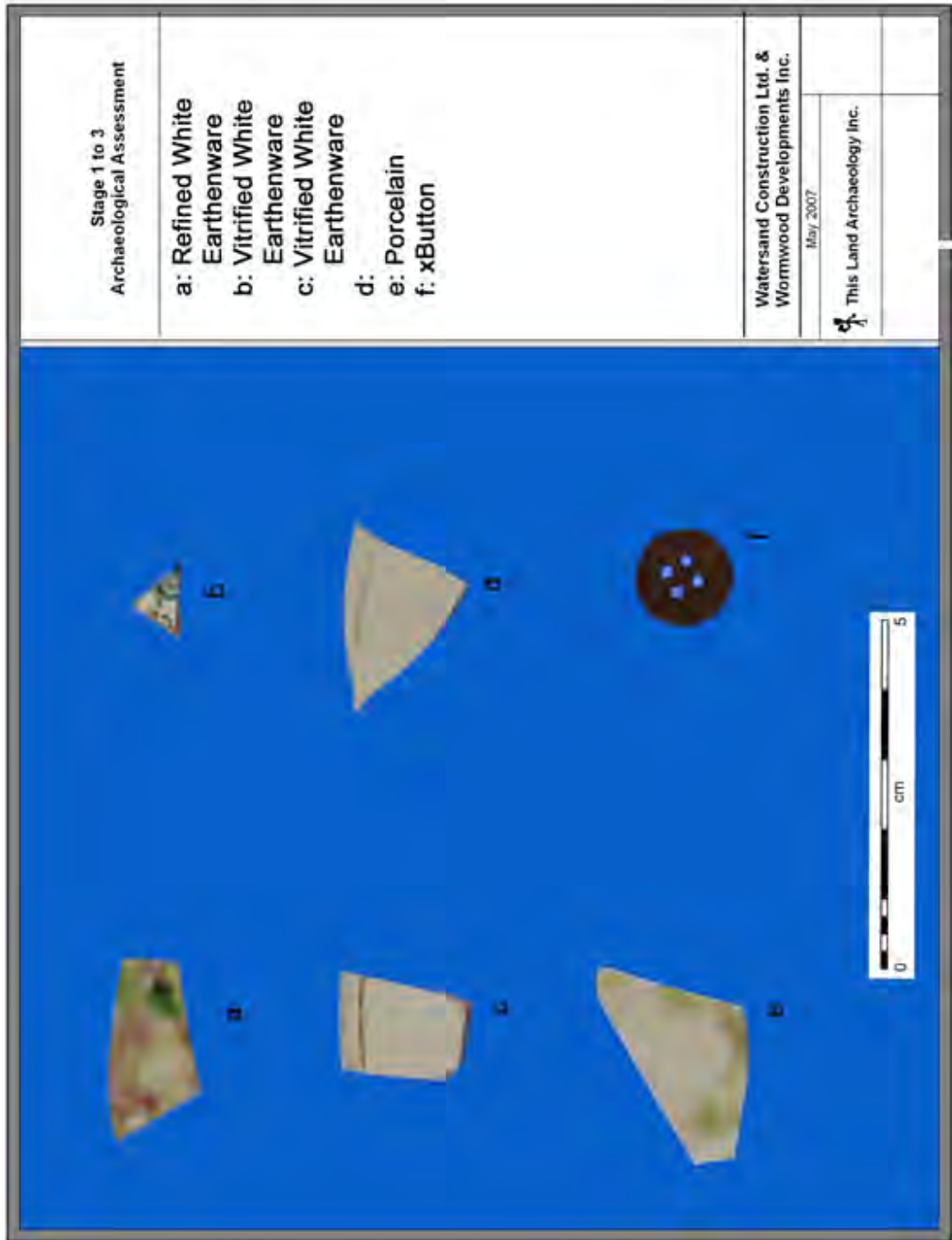


Plate 8: Sample of Artifacts recovered from the Test Pit Assessment of Parcel 8

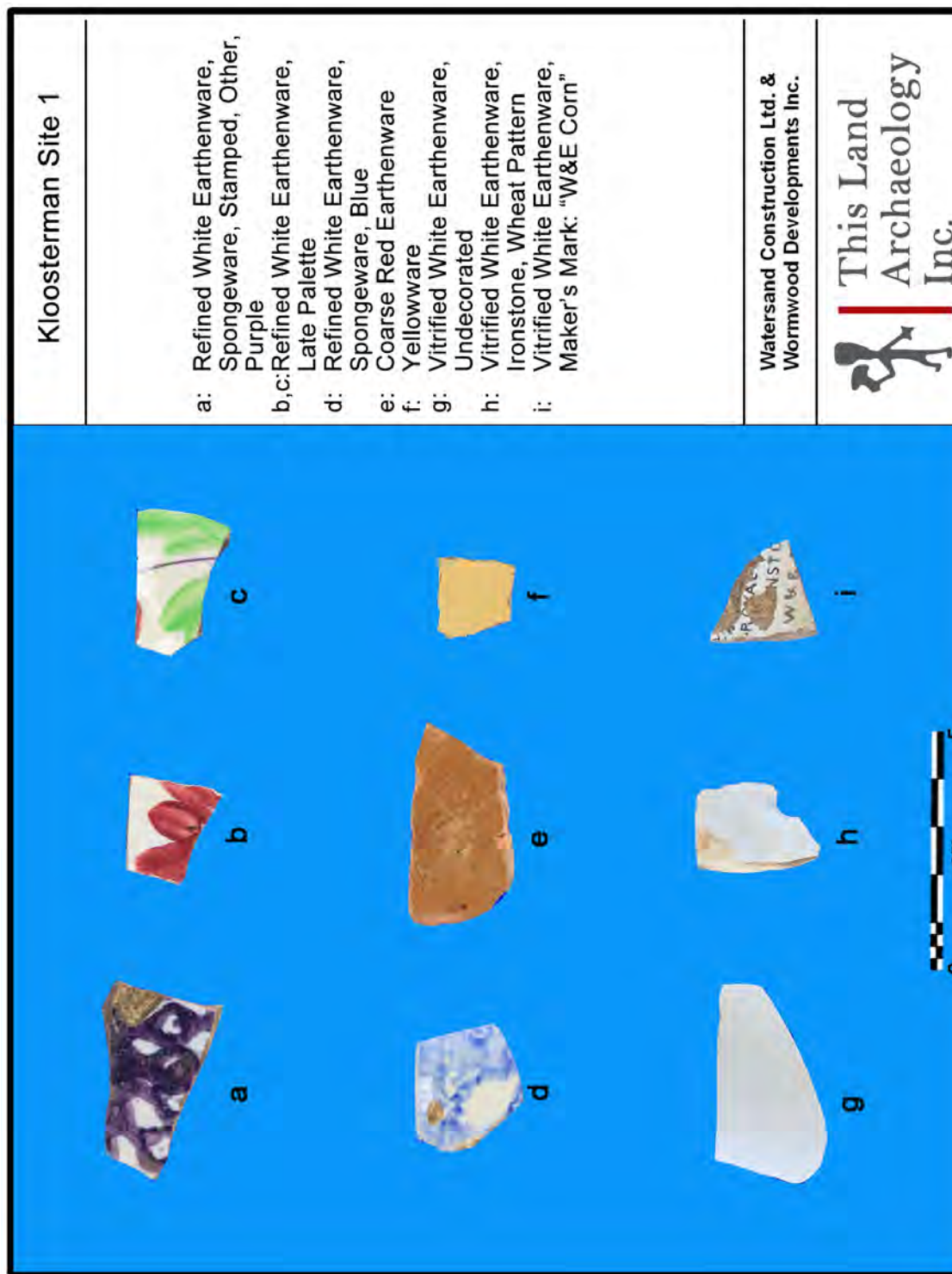


Plate 10: Sample of Artifacts recovered from the Stage 3 CSP of the Kloosterman 1 Site

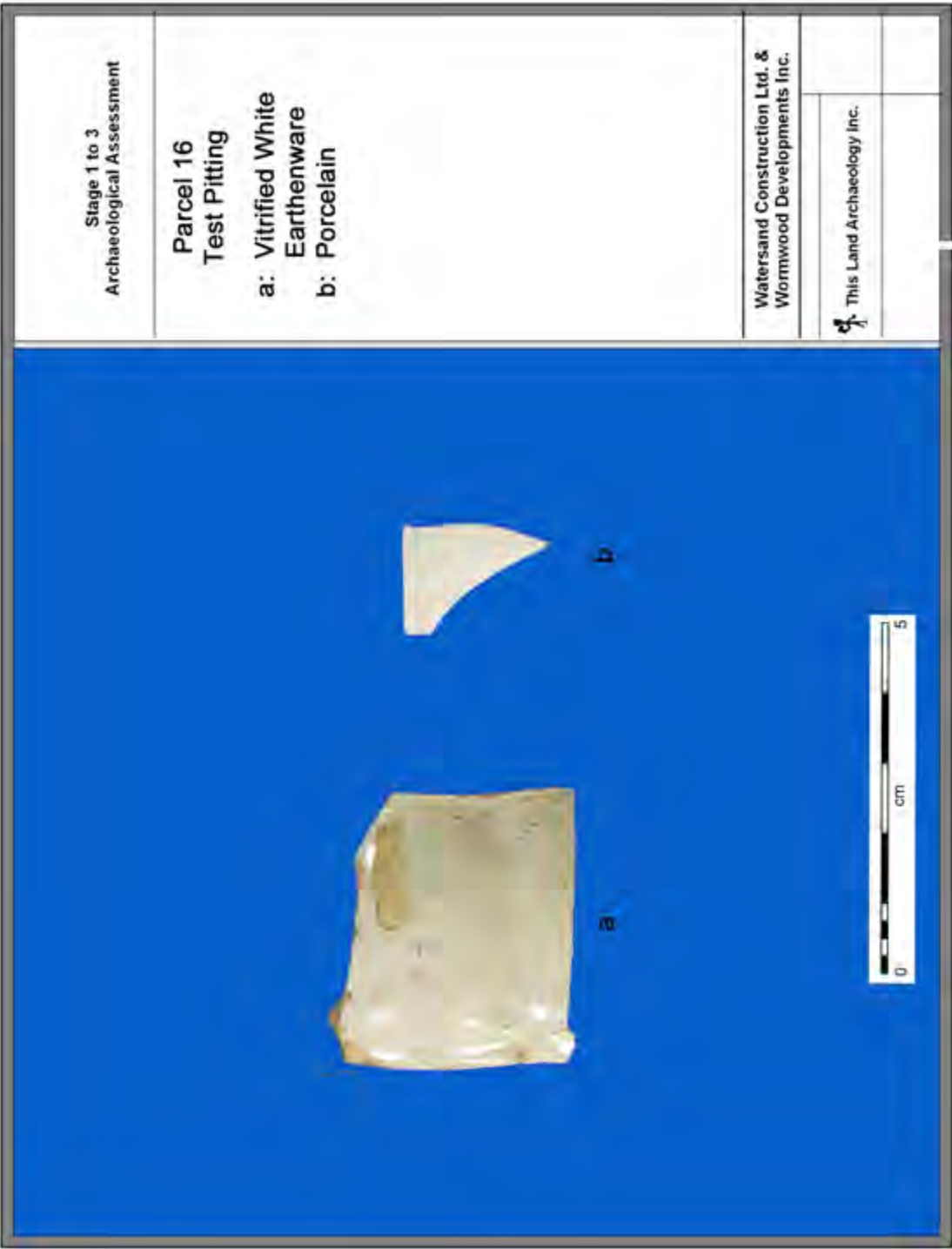


Plate 12: Sample of Artifacts recovered from the Test Pit Assessment of
Parcel 16

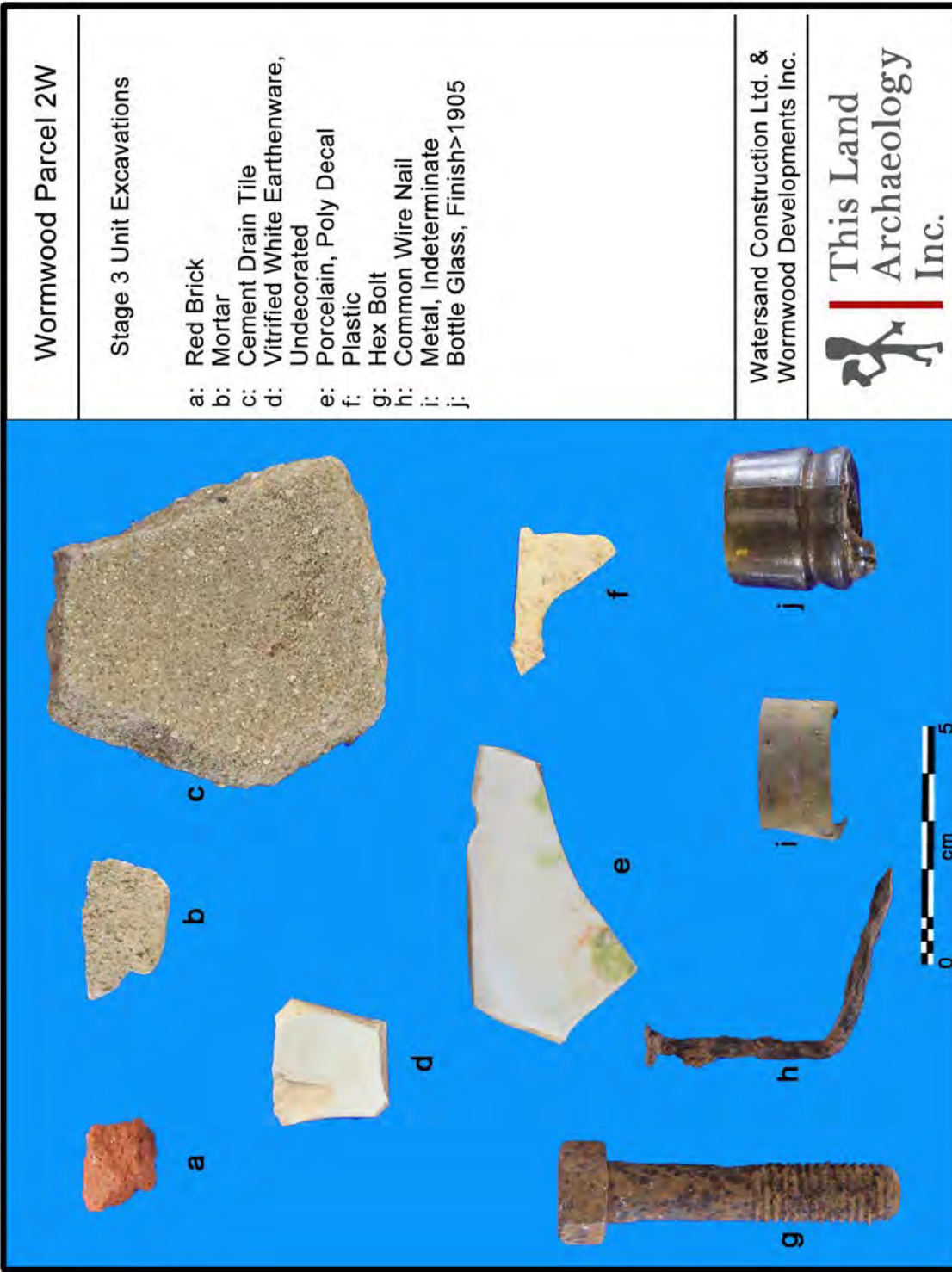


Plate 13: Sample of Artifacts recovered from the Stage 3 Unit Excavation of the 2W site

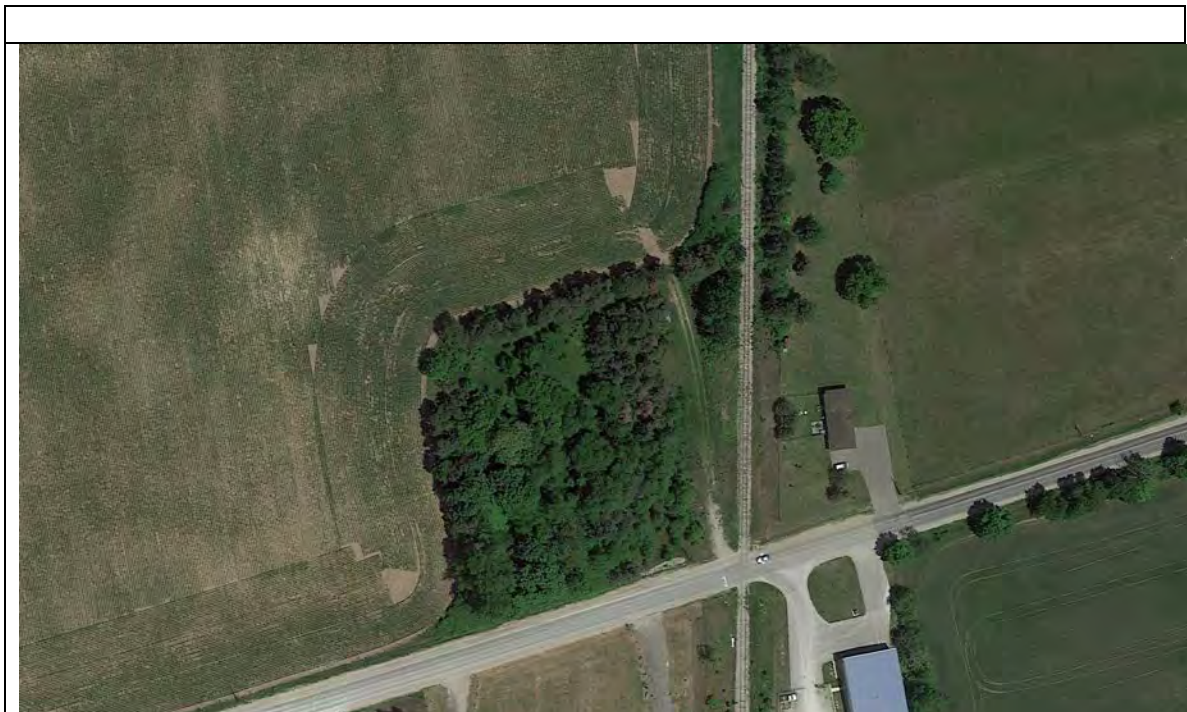


Plate 16: Areas of Low / No potential – farmstead and outbuildings on Parcel 16B
