Schedule 'C' Municipal Class Environmental Assessment

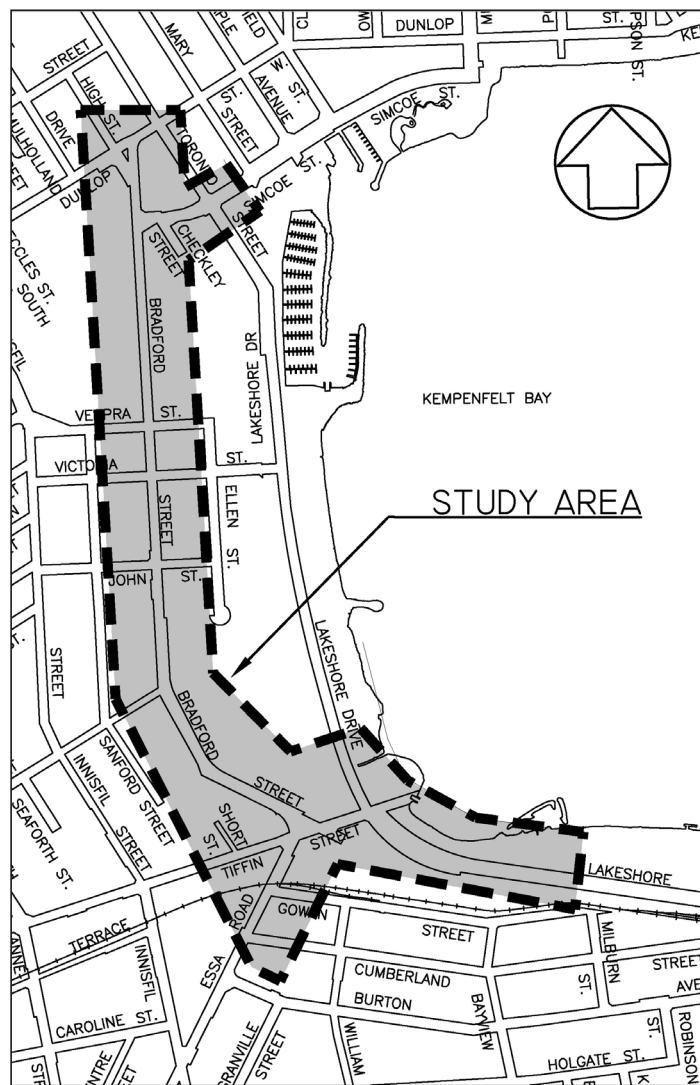
The City of Barrie is undertaking a Schedule 'C' Municipal Class Environmental Assessment to identify long-range multi-modal transportation and streetscape improvements to support planned growth. The study is focusing on two specific areas: the Bradford Street corridor and the intersections of Tiffin Street / Bradford Street and Tiffin Street / Lakeshore Drive (see study area map).

Public Information Centre No. 2

The second Public Information Centre (PIC 2) is being held on **Wednesday, June 22, 2022**, to present community feedback received to date, an assessment of alternative solutions and identification of the preferred solution(s) for the corridor, a preliminary assessment of the Tiffin Street intersection alternative design concepts, and next steps. An information package will be posted at barrie.ca/Eastudies on **Tuesday, June 21, 2022**. Hard copies of the package will be made available at City Hall (1st Floor, Planning Reception) for two weeks following PIC 2.
