VISIBLE LOCATION (7) SEVEN CALENDAR DAYS PRIOR TO INJURING OR DESTROYING VEGETATION. A CONSPICUOUS PLACE ON THE PRIVATE LAND THAT IS ADJACENT TO A PUBLIC ROAD. AN ADDITIONAL IN PUBLIC ROAD FRONTAGE. LACE FOR A PERIOD OF NO LESS THAN (2) TWO MONTHS FOLLOWING THE COMPLETION OF VEGETATION


TREE PRESERVATION NOTES


No alteration or disturbance to existing grades, storage of construction materials or equipment, storage of soil, construction waste or debris, disposal of any deleterious materials, or movement of vehicles, equipment or pedestrians is permitted within the minimum Tree Protection Zone.

Bi-monthly Tree Preservation Fencing inspections must be conducted and reports submitted to the City of Barrie during the period of active construction on the site.

It is the applicants' responsibility to discuss potential impacts to trees located near or wholly on adjacent properties or on shared boundary lines with their neighbours. Should such trees be injured to the point of instability or death, the application may be held responsible through civil action.

Prior to site disturbance, the owner must confirm that no migratory birds are making use of the site for nesting. The owner must ensure that the works are in conformance with the Migratory Bird Convention Act and no migratory bird nests will be impacts by the proposed work.
