

REMOVE AT TIME OF PLANTING ANY DEAD, BROKEN O REMOVE ALL LABELS AND TAGS AT TIME OF PLANTING BINDING AND TIES MUST BE REMOVED IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING THE INSTALLATION OF THE TREE TREE HEIGHT IS MEASURED FROM THE FIRST WHORL AND NOT THE TOP OF LEADER TREES ARE TO BE PLANTED PLUM AND HAVE BOTH FULL FORM AND HEALTHY CANOPY STRUCTURE. AN TREES WHICH DO NOT MEET THIS CRITERIA AND/OR HAVE WEAK BRANCHING STRUCTURE, DO NOT HAVE STRAIGHT TRUNKS OR HAVE UNBALANCED CROWNS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED TREES ARE TO BE STAKED WITH (2) TWO SOFTWOOD STAKES (38x38x2400mm) EXTENDING 300mm INTO FIRM GROUND AT AN ANGLE AND SECURED VERTICAL PRIOR TO BACKFILLING THE TREE PIT. 
