


Notice of the filing of a Complete Application and Notice of a Public Meeting pursuant to sections 34(10.4) And 34(12) of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, as amended, in respect to a Proposed Amendment to the Zoning By-law

Re: Amendment to the Zoning By-law – Innovative Planning Solutions Inc. on behalf of Pat and John Hargreaves – 19 Dundonald Street, Barrie – FILE REF.: D30-026-2021

TAKE NOTICE that the Corporation of the City of Barrie is in receipt of a complete application as of March 24, 2022, submitted by Innovative Planning Solutions, on behalf of Pat and John Hargreaves, for an Amendment to the Zoning By-law for lands located at 19 Dundonald Street, Barrie. The subject lands are legally described as Part Lot 24, Concession 4 in the former Township of Vespra and Parts 1 to 4 on Plan 51R-39870.

TAKE NOTICE that the Planning Committee of the Council of the Corporation of the City of Barrie will hold a public meeting on **Tuesday, June 07, 2022 at 7 p.m.** to review an application for an Amendment to the Zoning By-law submitted by Innovative Planning Solutions Inc. on behalf of Pat and John Hargreaves for 19 Dundonald Street.

The applicant is proposing to rezone the subject lands from 'Residential Single Detached Dwelling Second Density' (R2) to 'Residential Apartment Dwelling First Density-3 – Special Provision No. XXX' (RA1-3)(SP-XXX) with site-specific provisions.



The purpose of the proposed Zoning By-law Amendment Application is to permit the development of a nine (9) storey multi-residential building containing 58 units and two (2) levels of underground parking. The applicant is requesting a site-specific provision to permit a gross floor area (GFA) of 115 percent of the lot area, whereas Zoning By-law 2009-141, as amended, permits a maximum GFA of 100 percent.

This public meeting will be held in a virtual forum with electronic participation and in person at City Hall. The meeting will be televised on Rogers TV and will be livestreamed at youtube.com/citybarrie.

If you would like to participate virtually, you will need access to a computer with internet service or a telephone. If you wish to provide oral comments at the virtual public meeting, please register in advance by emailing: cityclerks@barrie.ca or calling 705-730-4220 x5500 during regular office hours prior to **Monday, June 6, 2022 at 12:00 p.m.** Once you register, you will be provided information from the Legislative Services Branch on how to make your submission at the virtual public meeting with electronic participation.

Any person may attend the meeting and make representation or present submissions respecting this matter. If you wish to make a written submission concerning this matter, please email or mail written comments to cityclerks@barrie.ca or City Hall, 70 Collier Street, PO Box 400, Barrie, ON L4M 4T5 (attention: City Clerk). Written comments must be received by **Monday, May 30, 2022 by 12:00 p.m.** Any person may make representation at the meeting however, written submissions and advance registration are encouraged.

Notification of the Amendment to the Zoning By-law if adopted by Council, will be provided upon written request to the undersigned file manager in the Development Services Department – Planning Division.

If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the Corporation of The City of Barrie before the Amendment to the Zoning By-law is passed:

- the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision of the Corporation of The City of Barrie to the Ontario Land Tribunal (OLT); and
- the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the OLT unless, in the opinion of the Tribunal, there are reasonable grounds to do so.

All information including opinions, presentations, reports, documentation, etc. provided for or at a Public Meeting are considered public records. This information may be posted on the City of Barrie website and/or made available to the public upon request. Questions about this collection should be directed to the undersigned.
